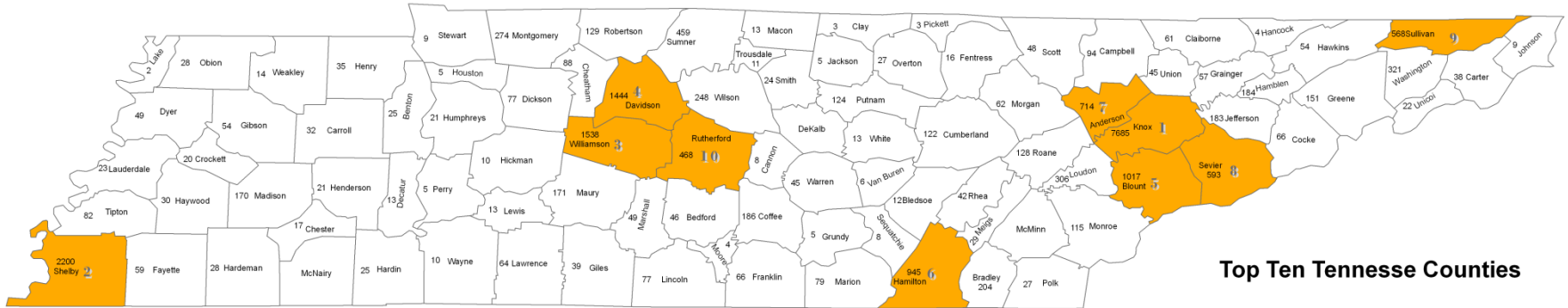

Enrollment By County Fall 2008

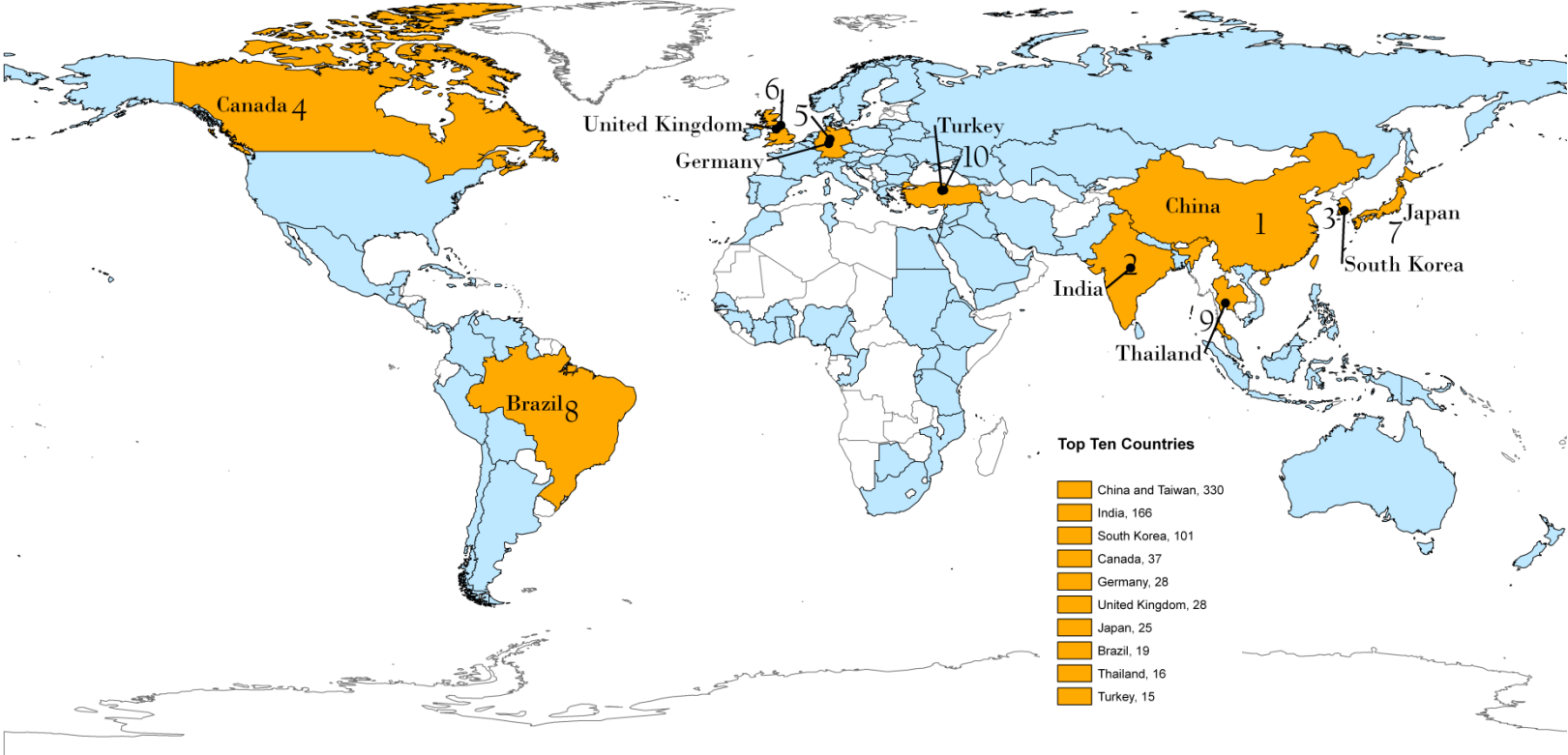

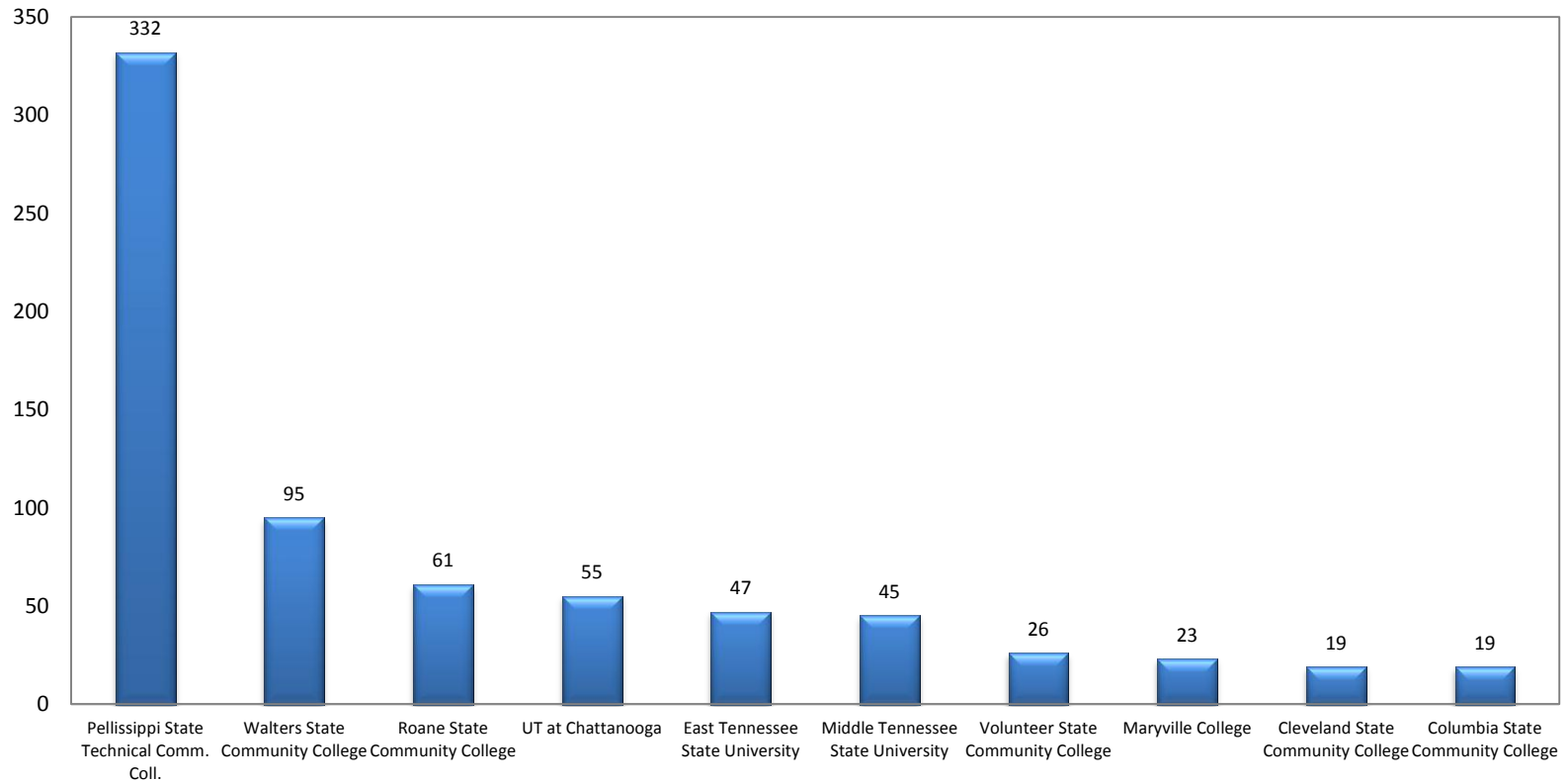

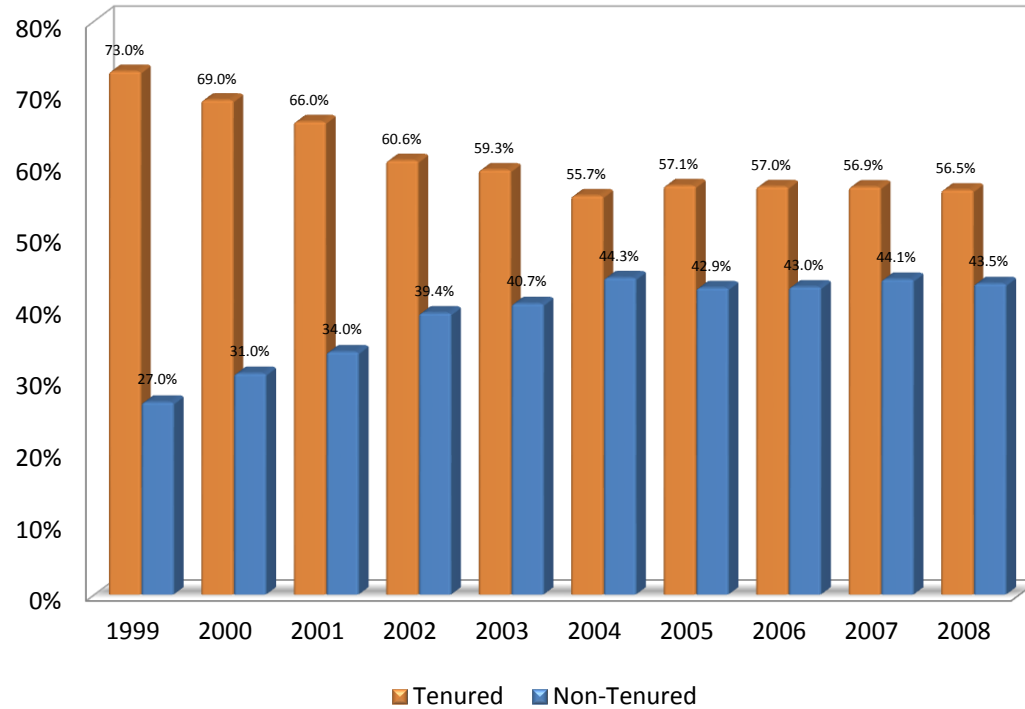

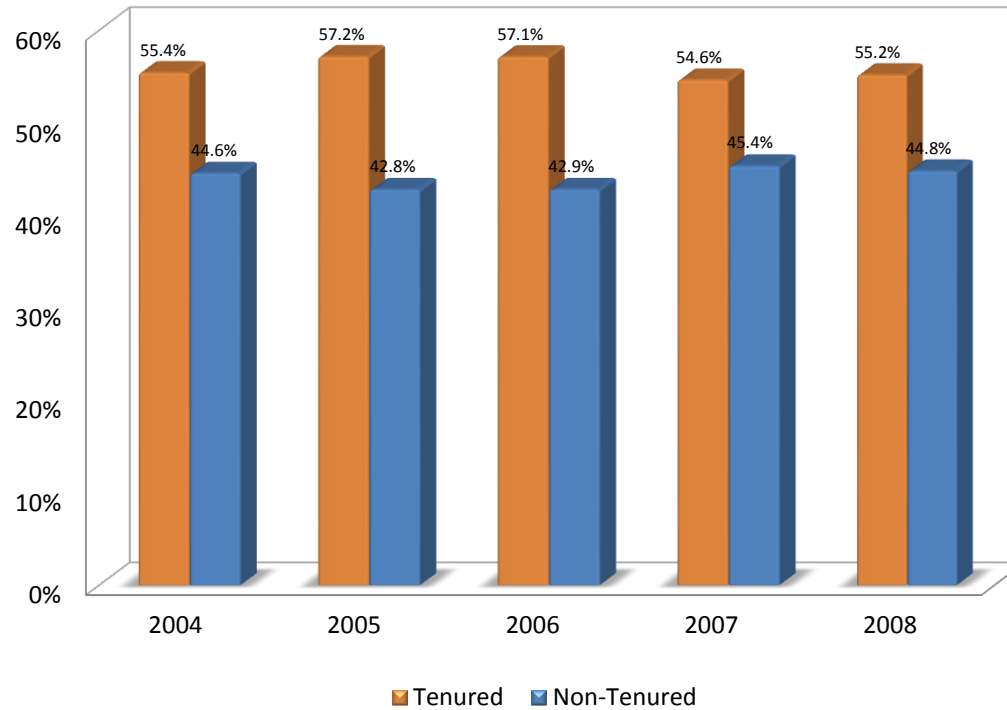

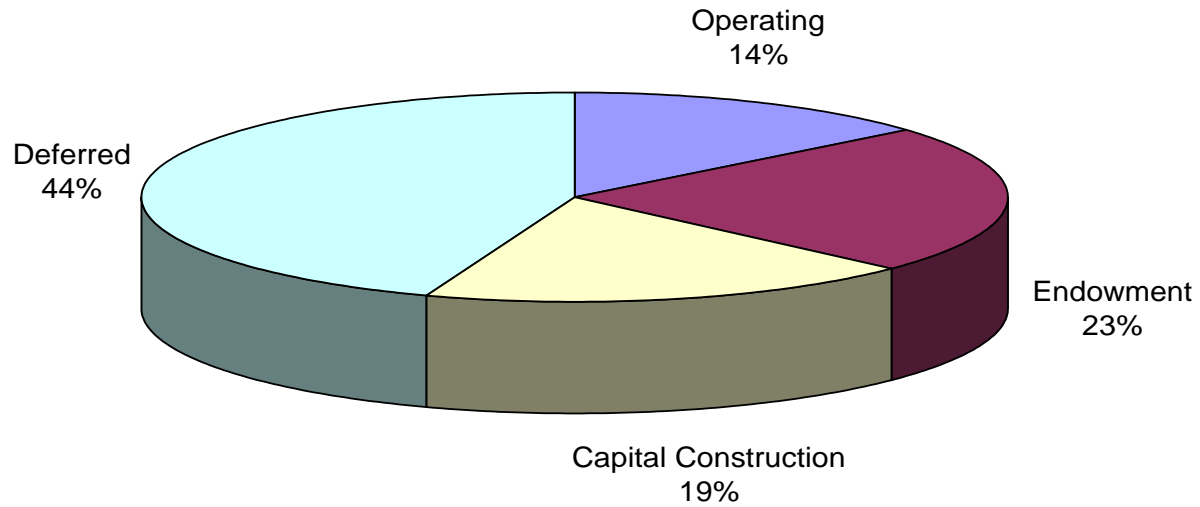

UT Knoxville Campaign Analysis by Purpose

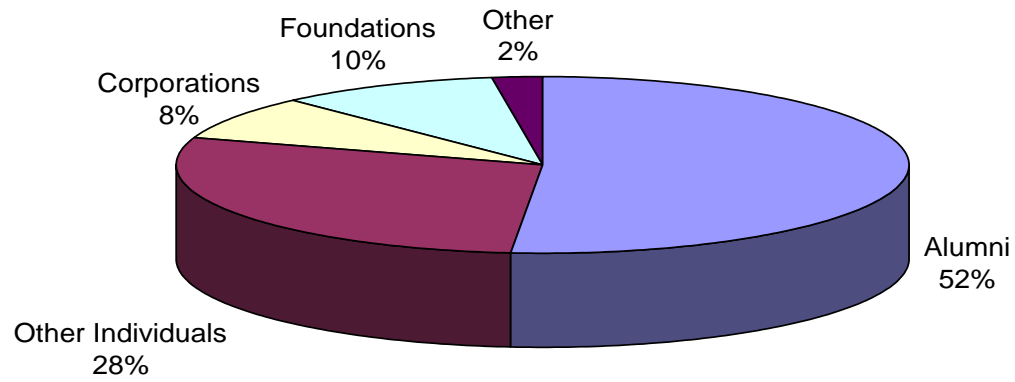

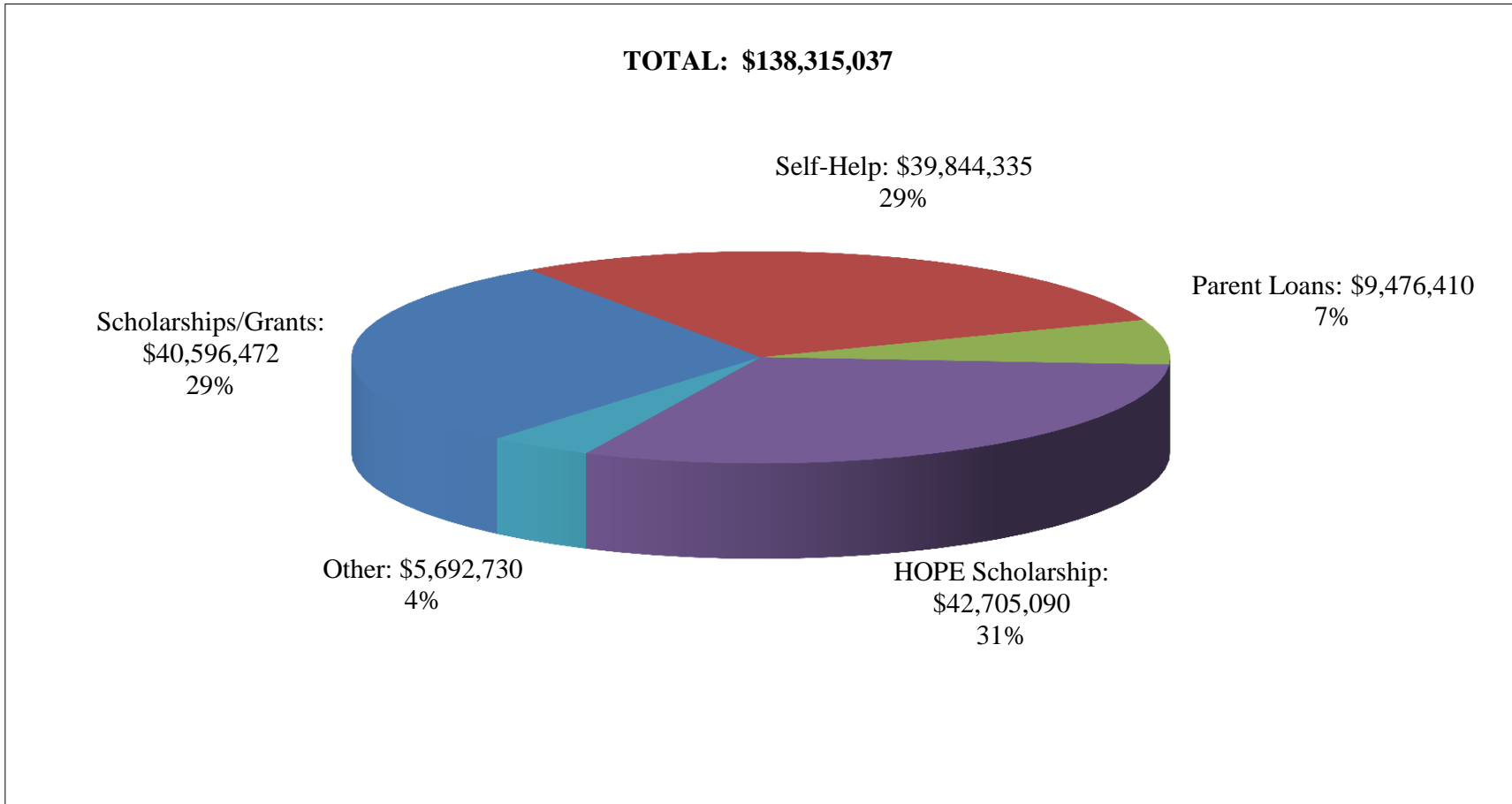

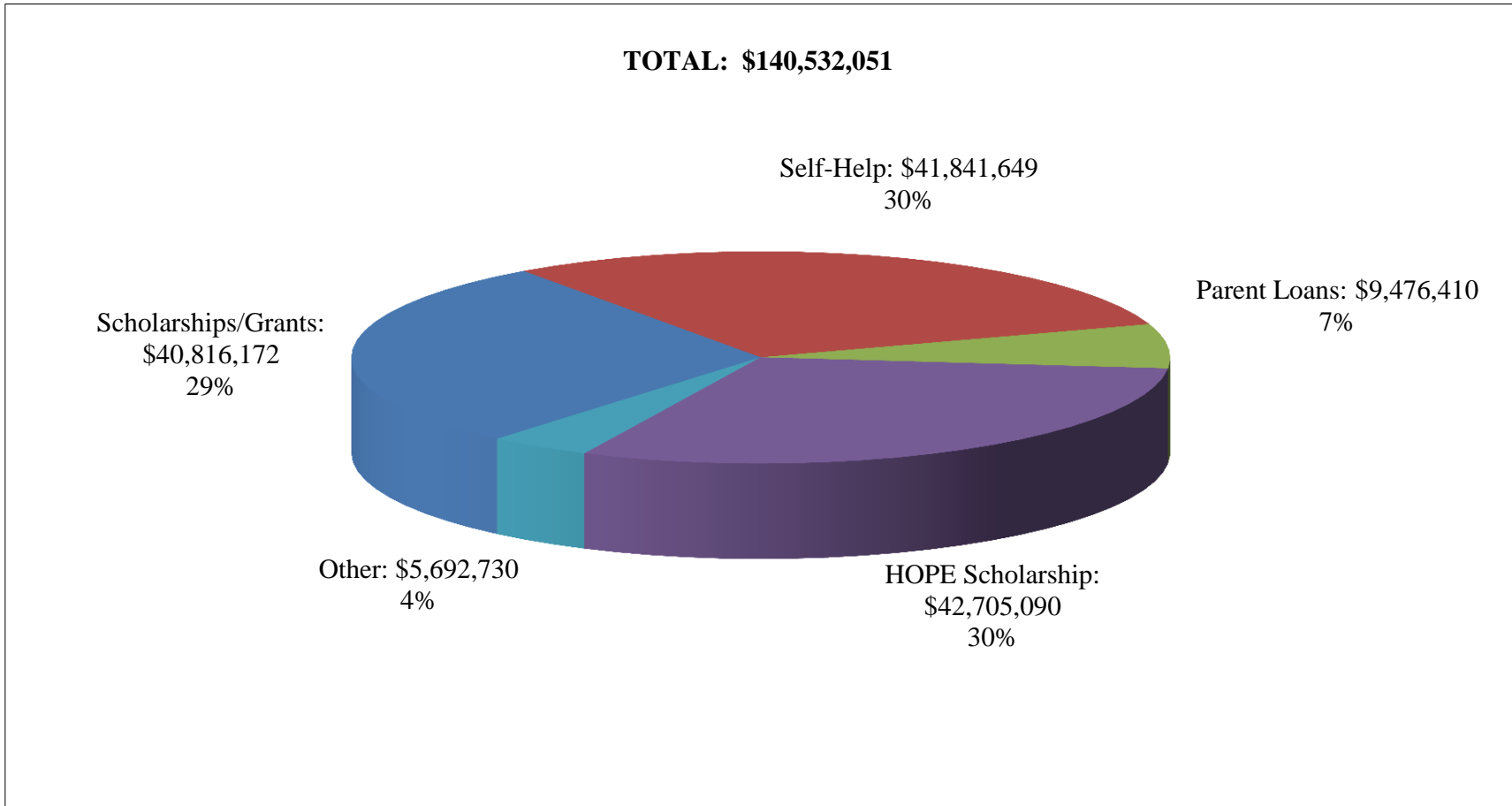

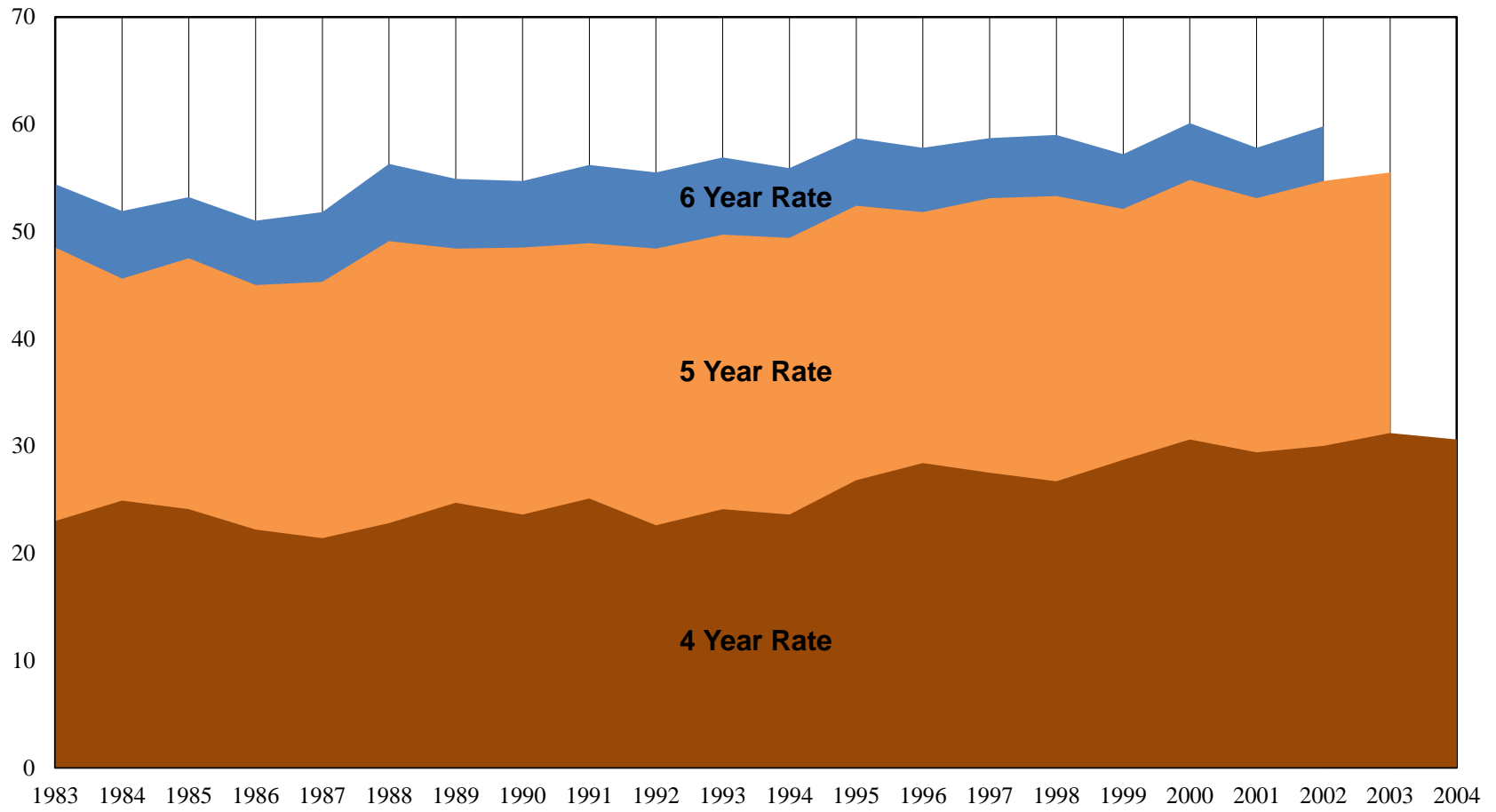

Fall Terms 1983-2004**



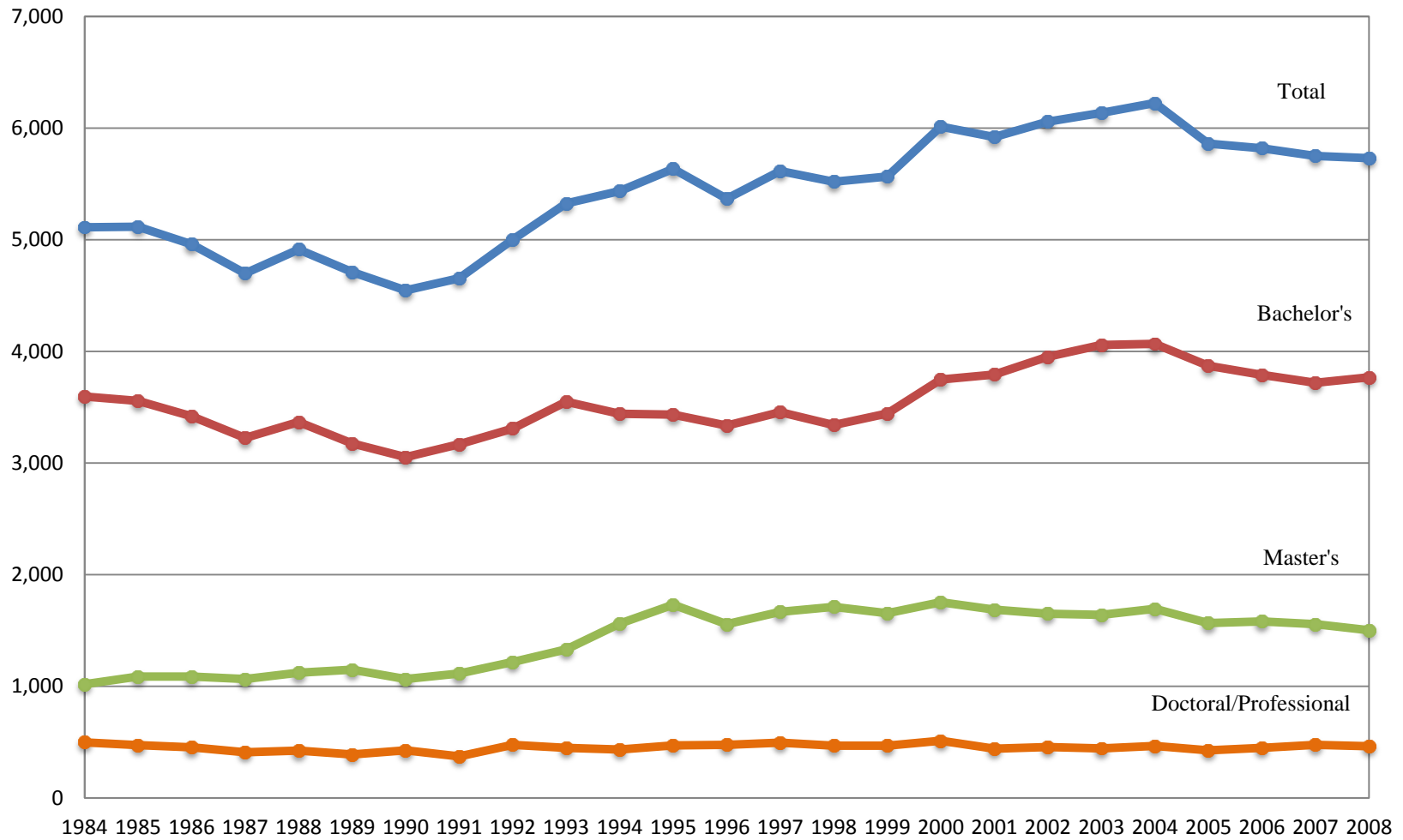
