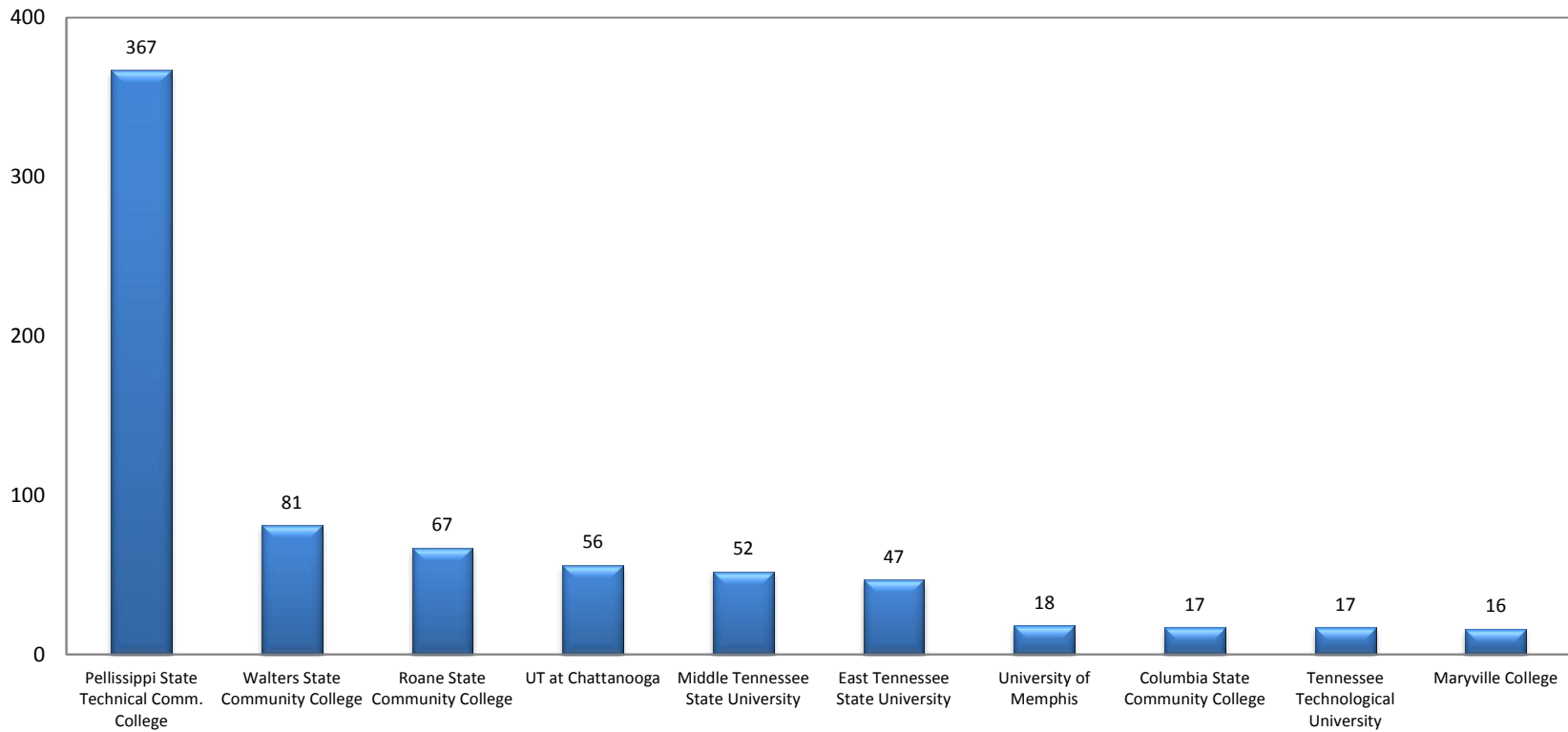

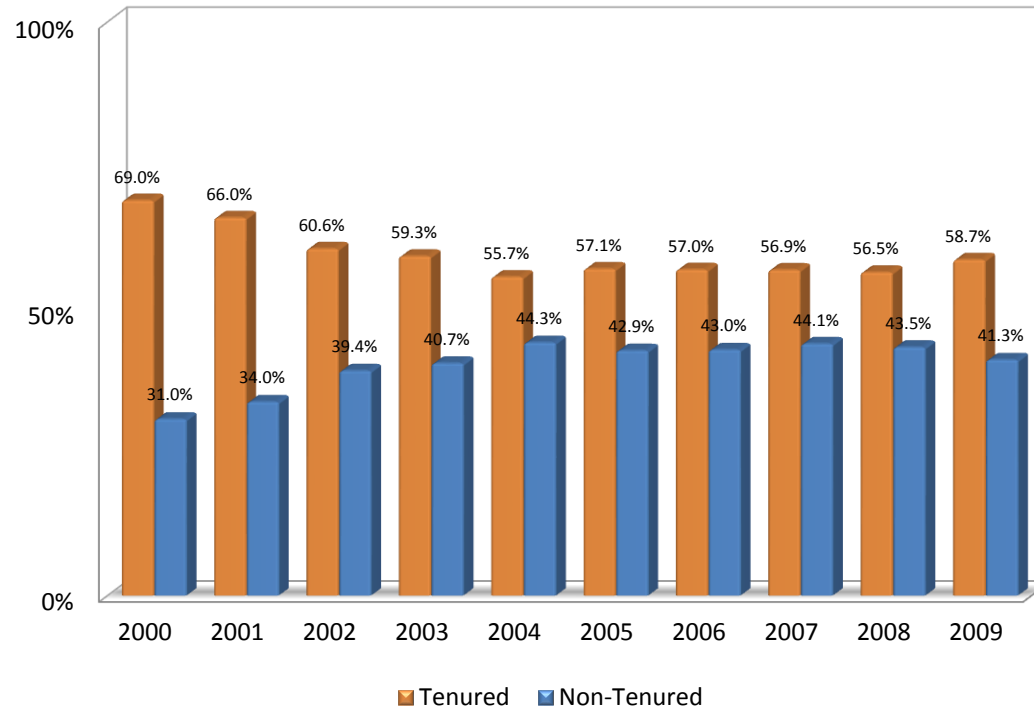

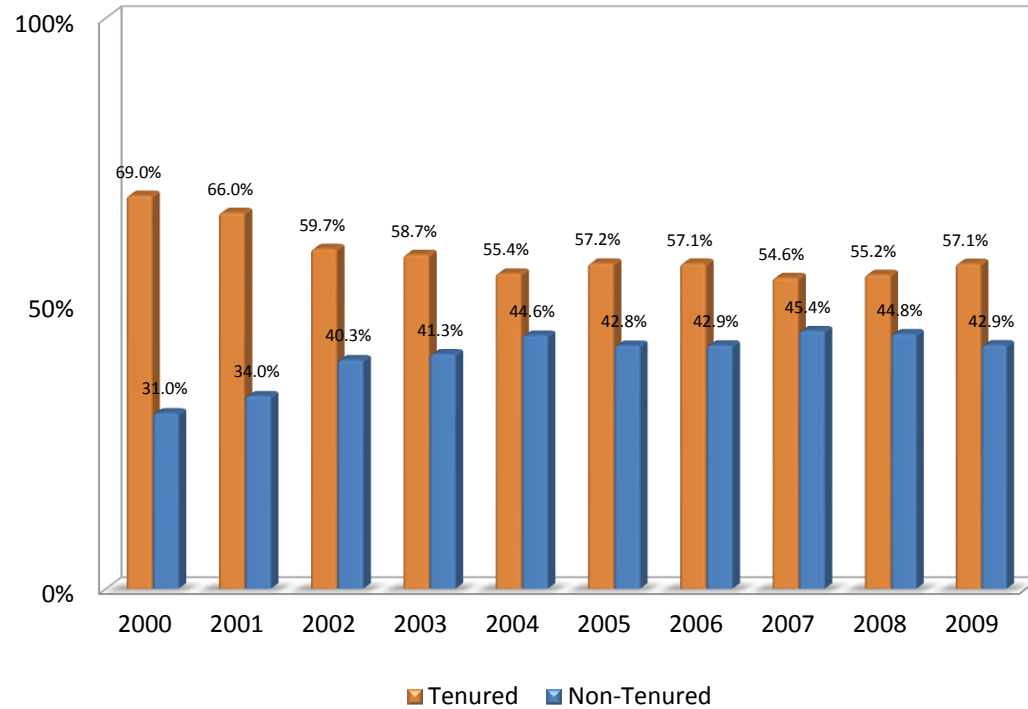

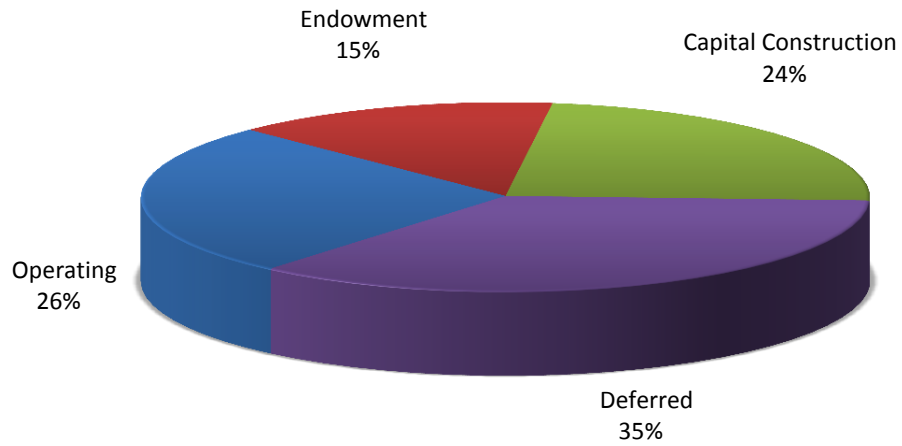

UT Knoxville Campaign Analysis by Purpose

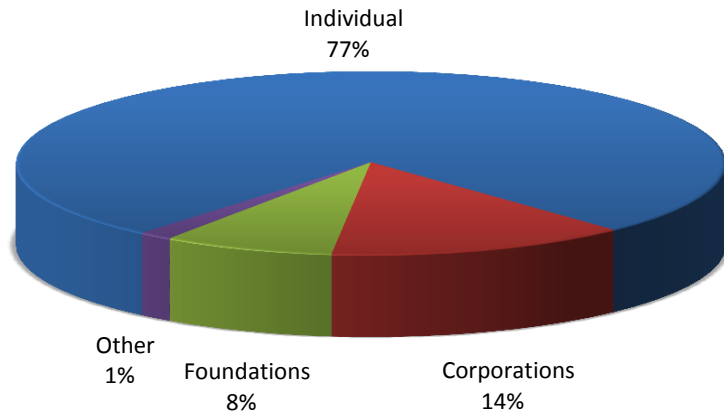

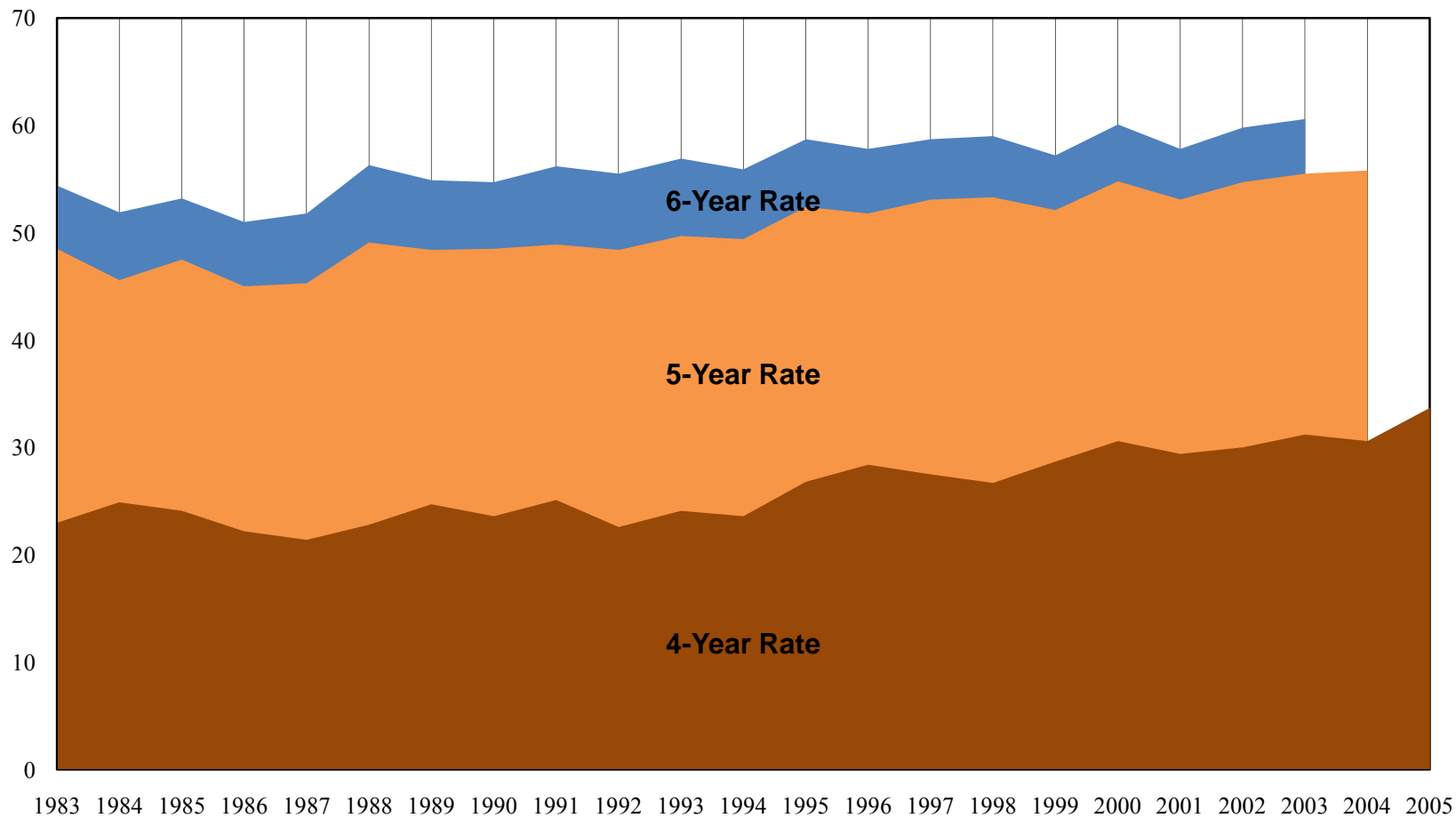

Fall Cohorts 1983-2005**



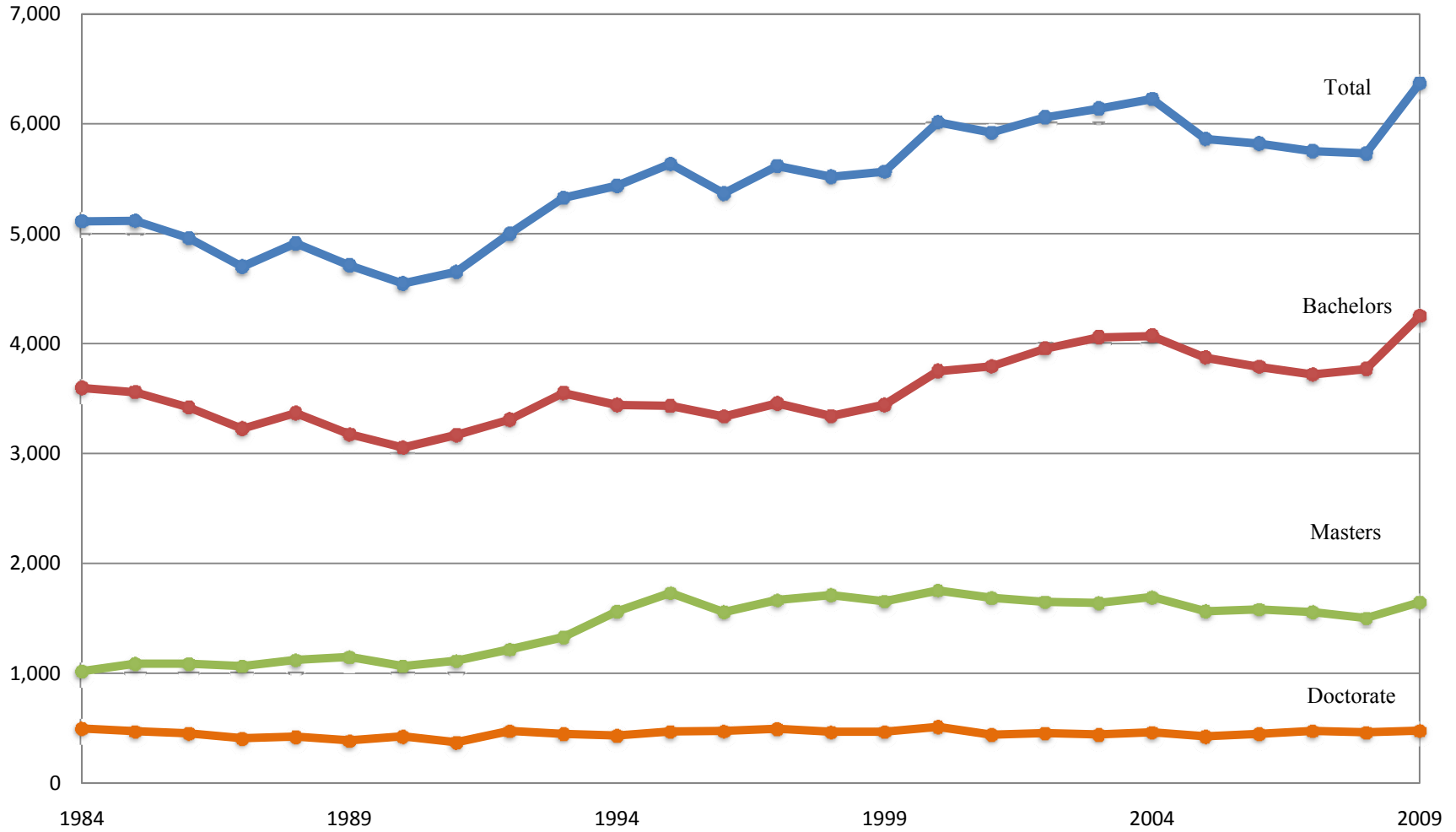
