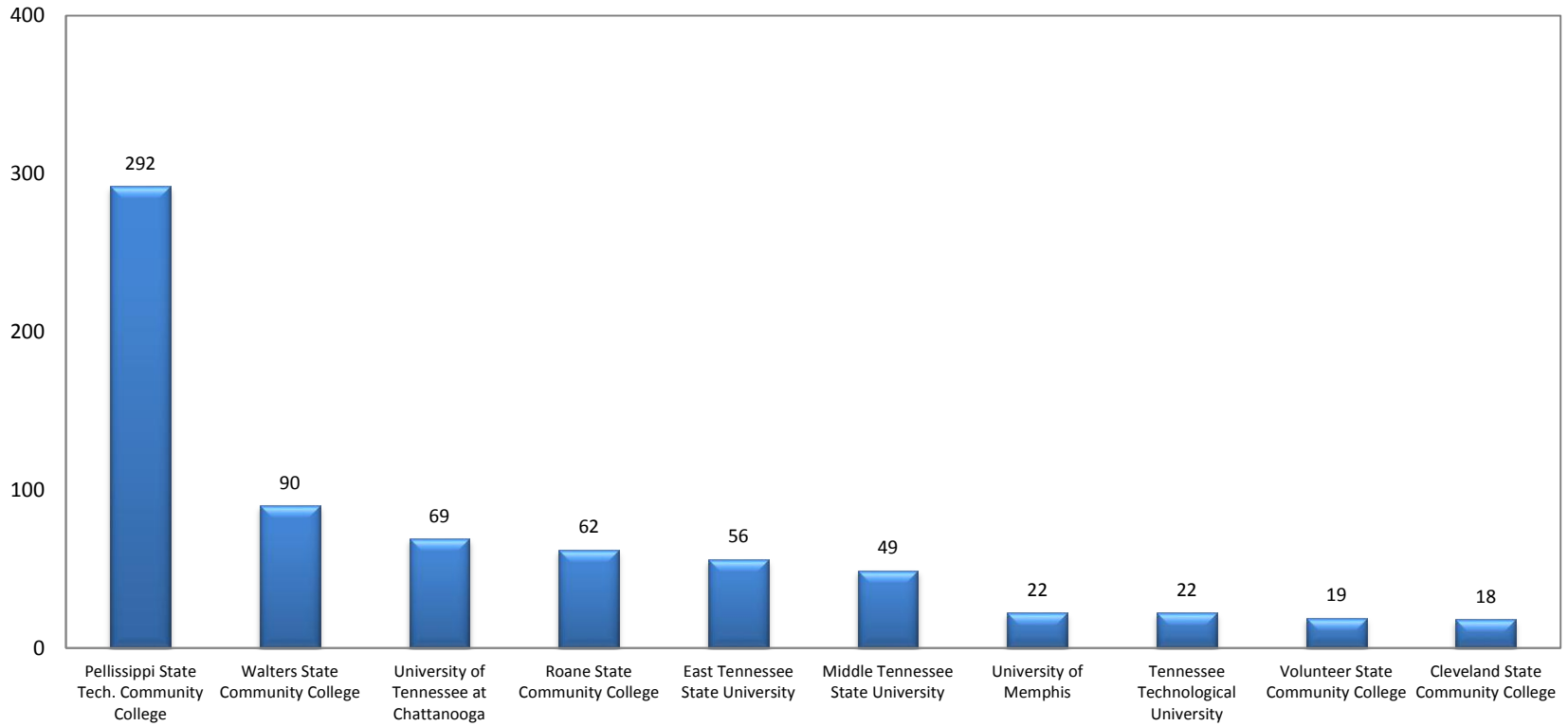

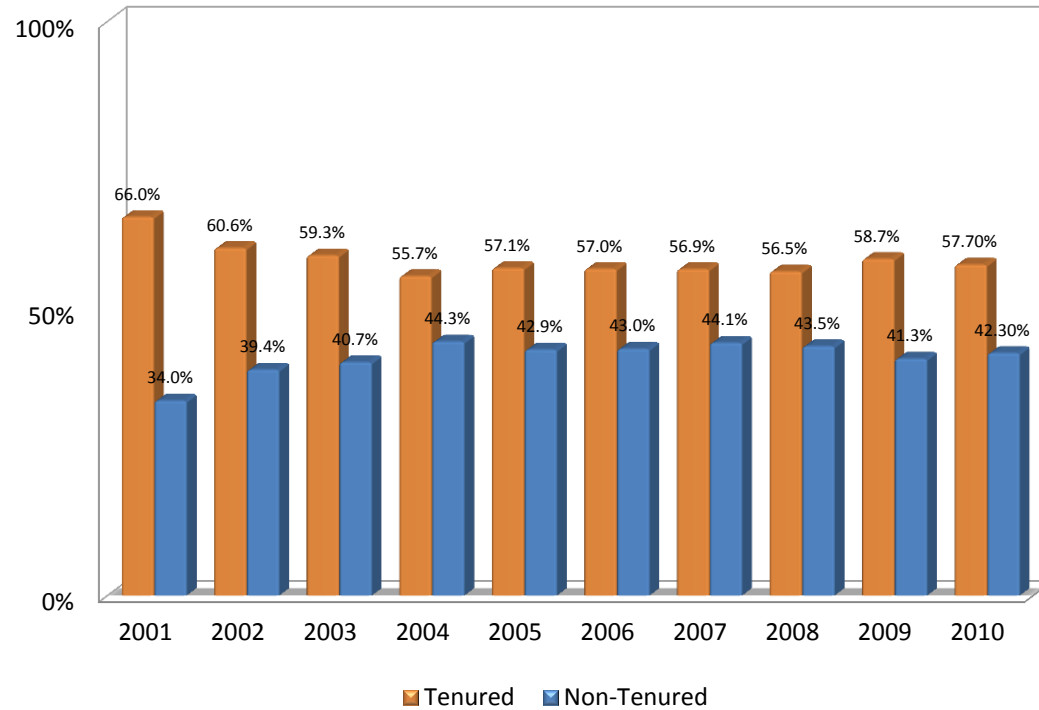

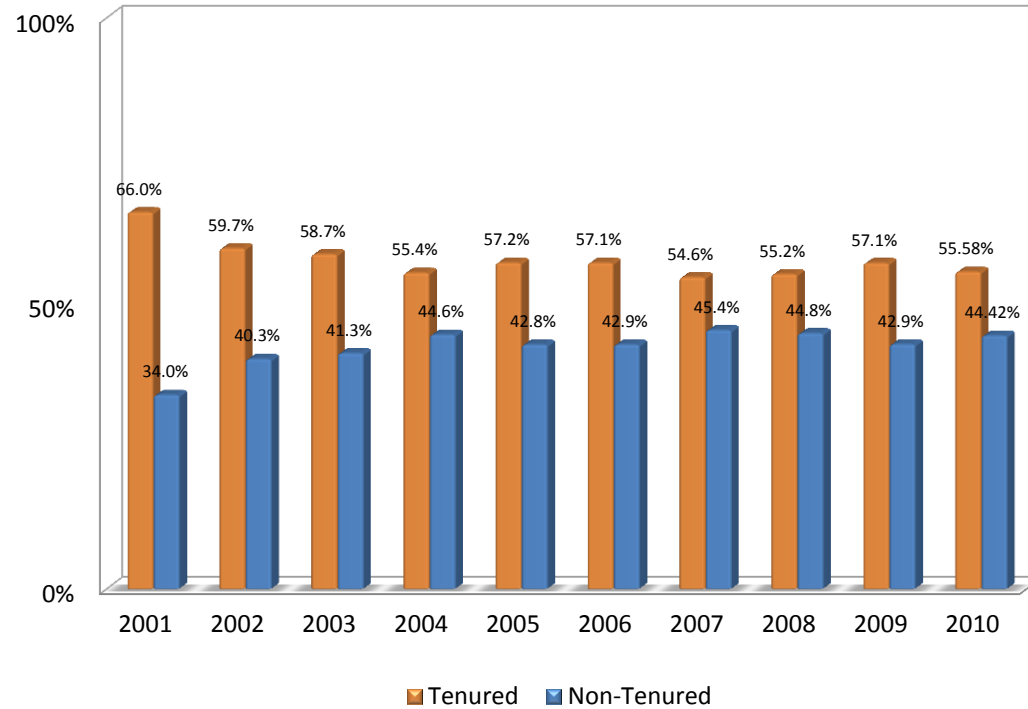

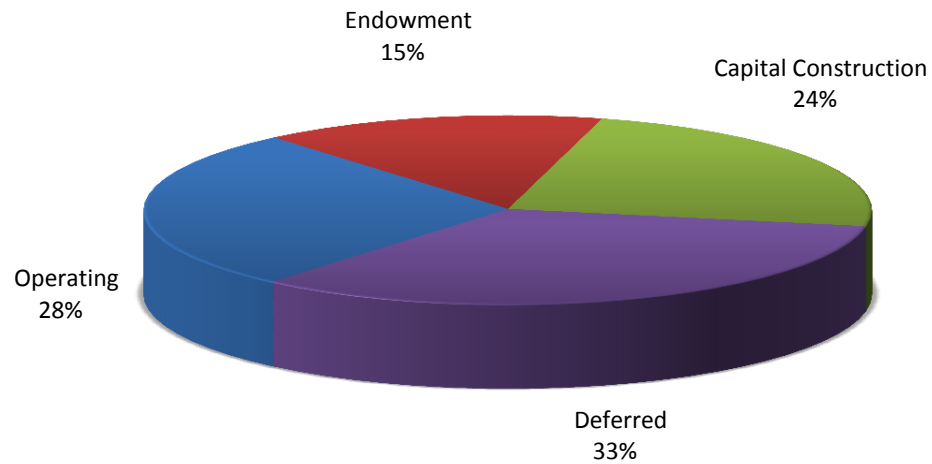

### UT Knoxville Campaign Analysis by Purpose

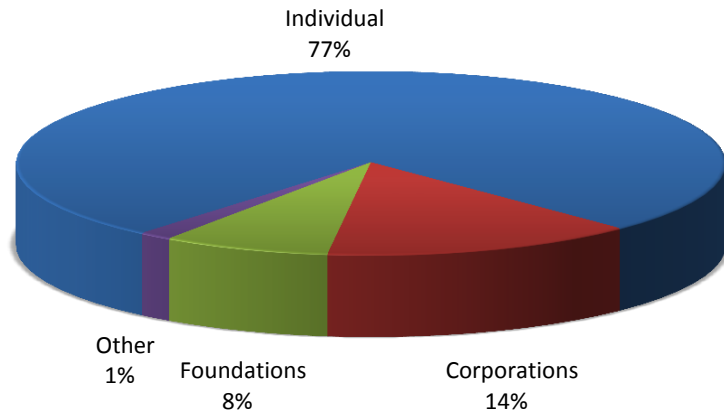

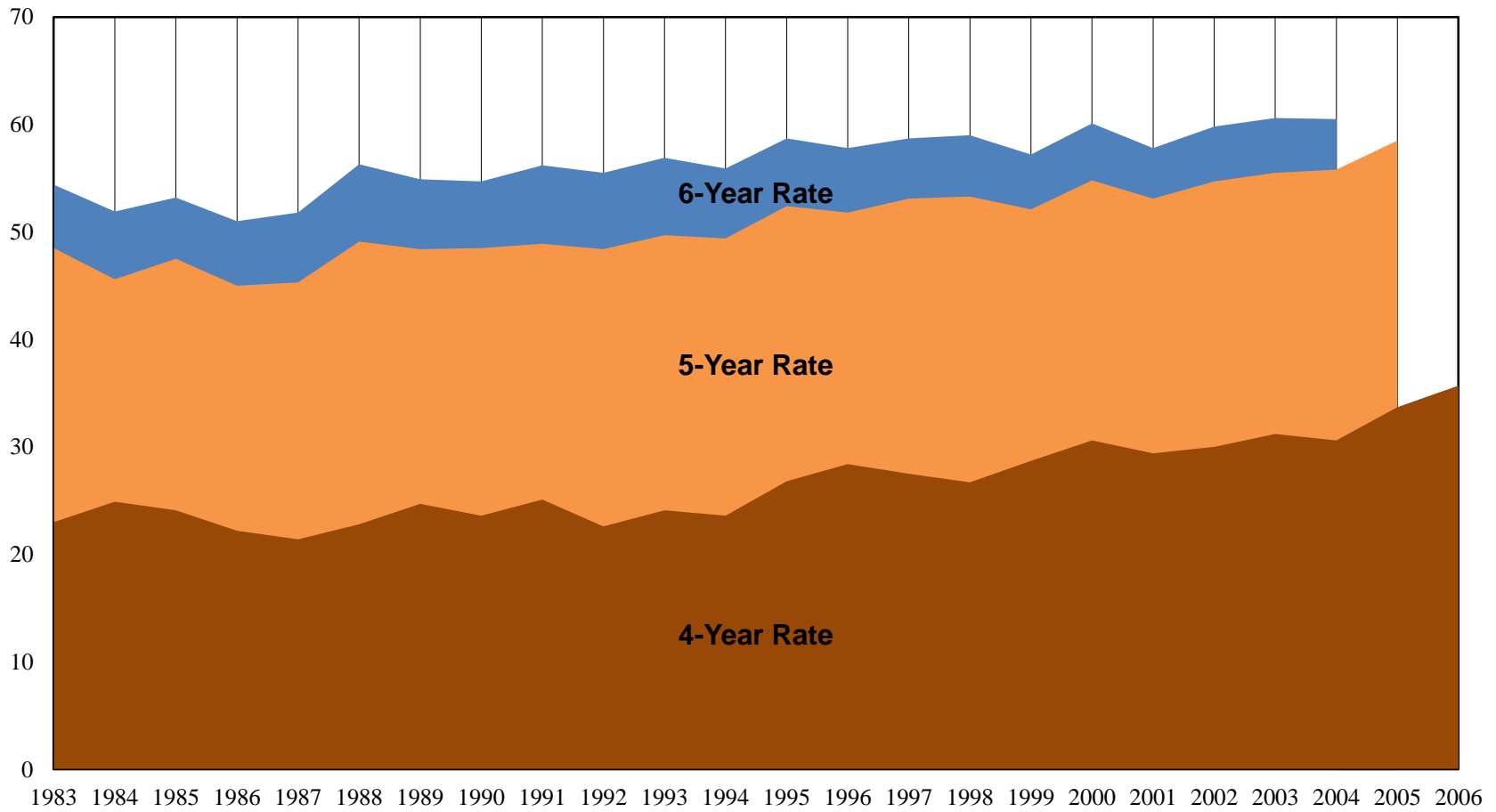

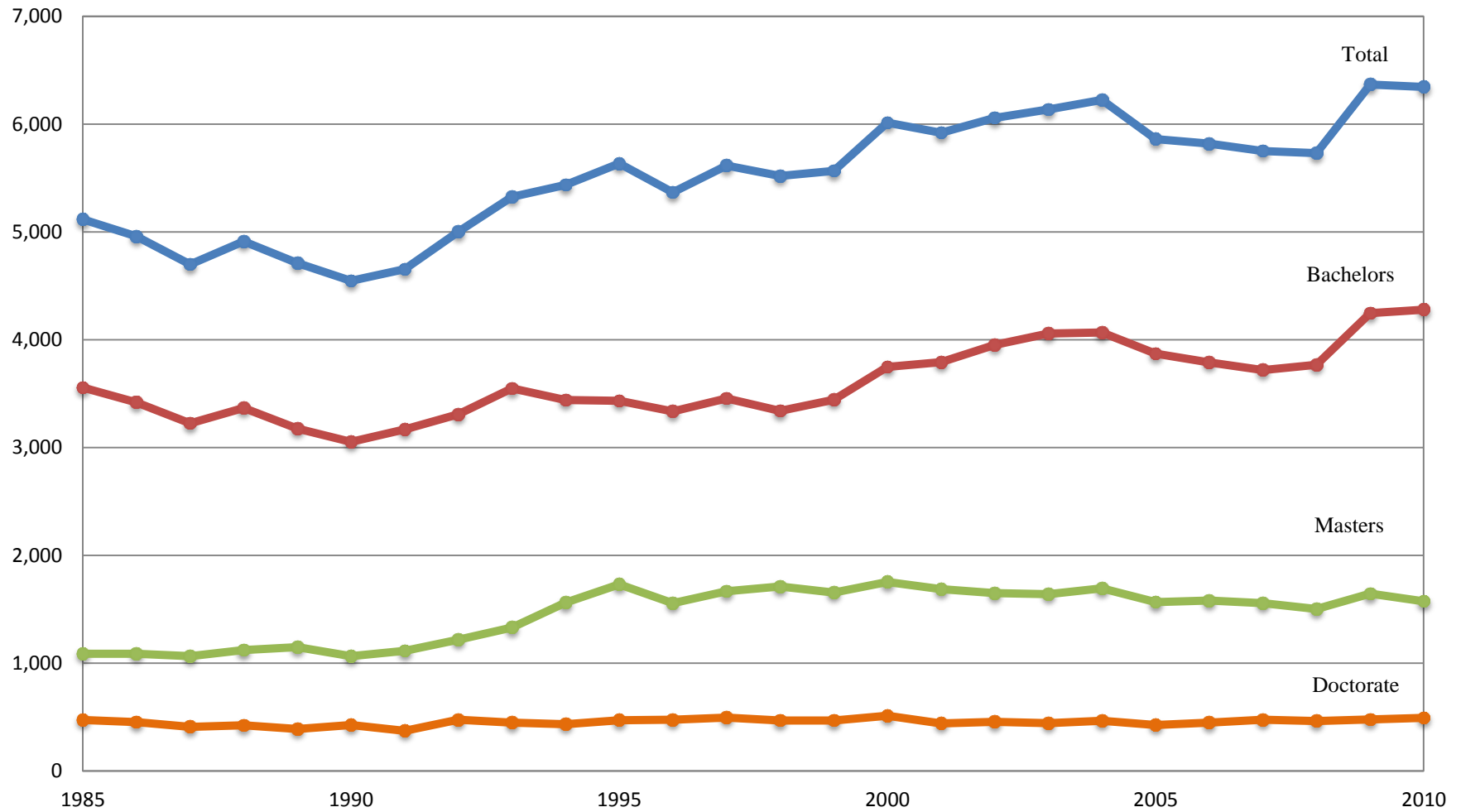


**Graduation Rates
