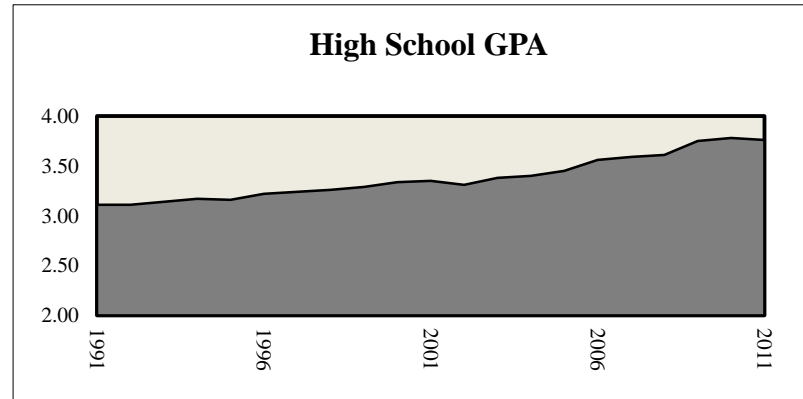
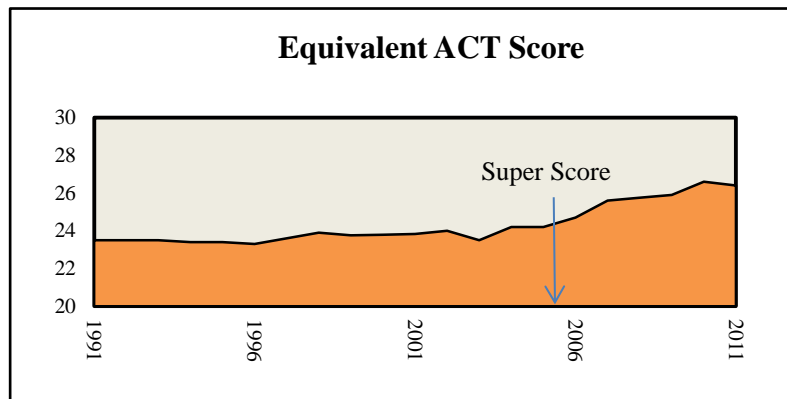

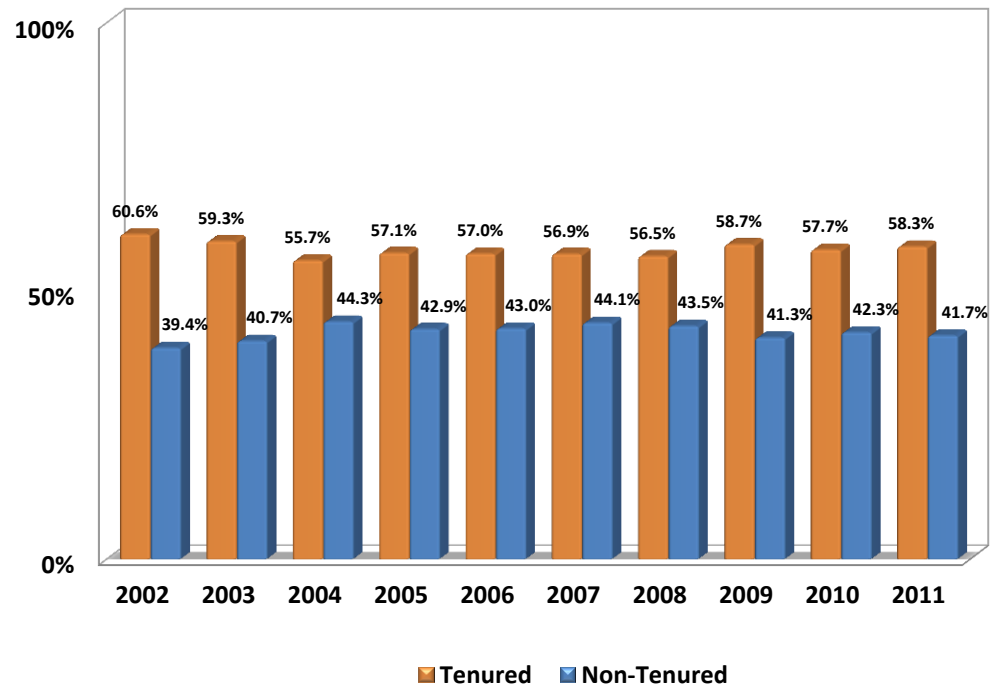

Tenured and Non-Tenured Full-Time Instructional Faculty University Total Fall 2002-2011



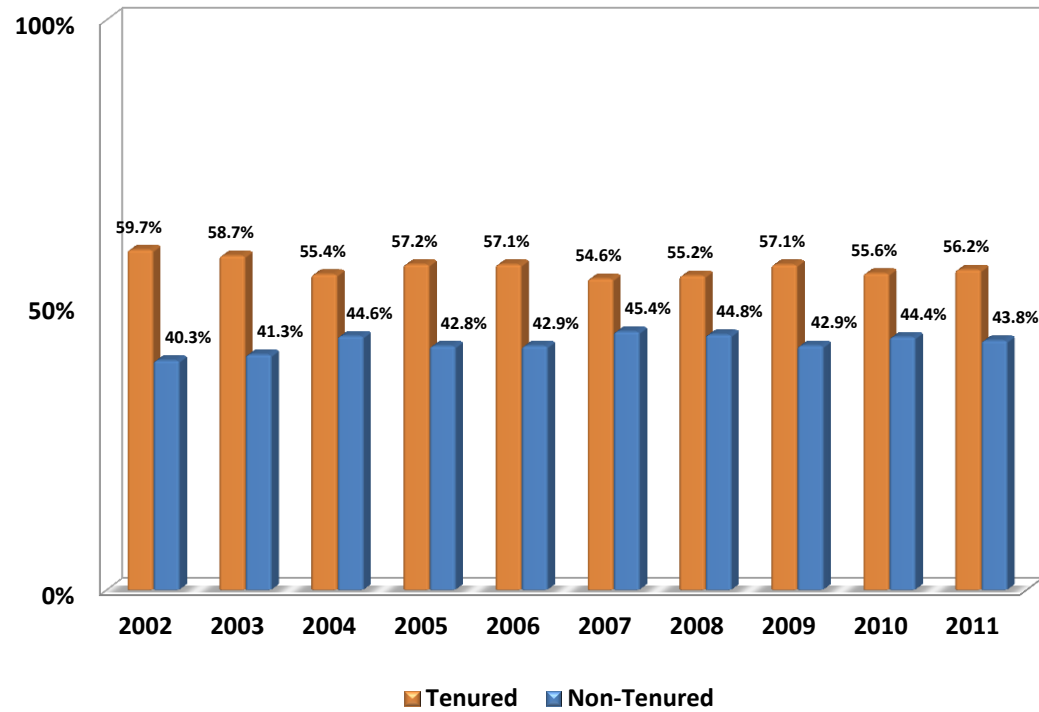

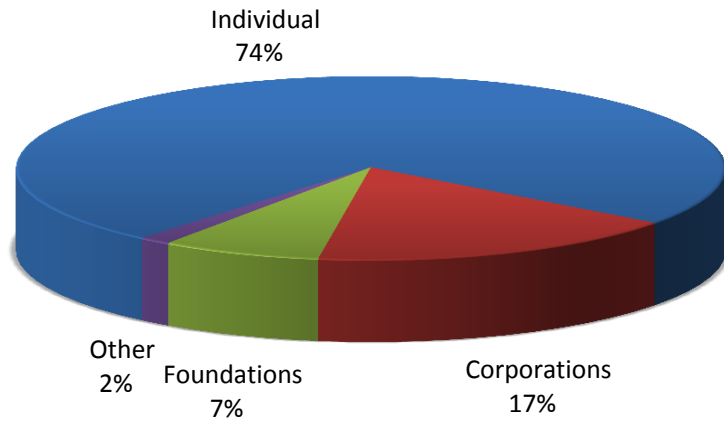

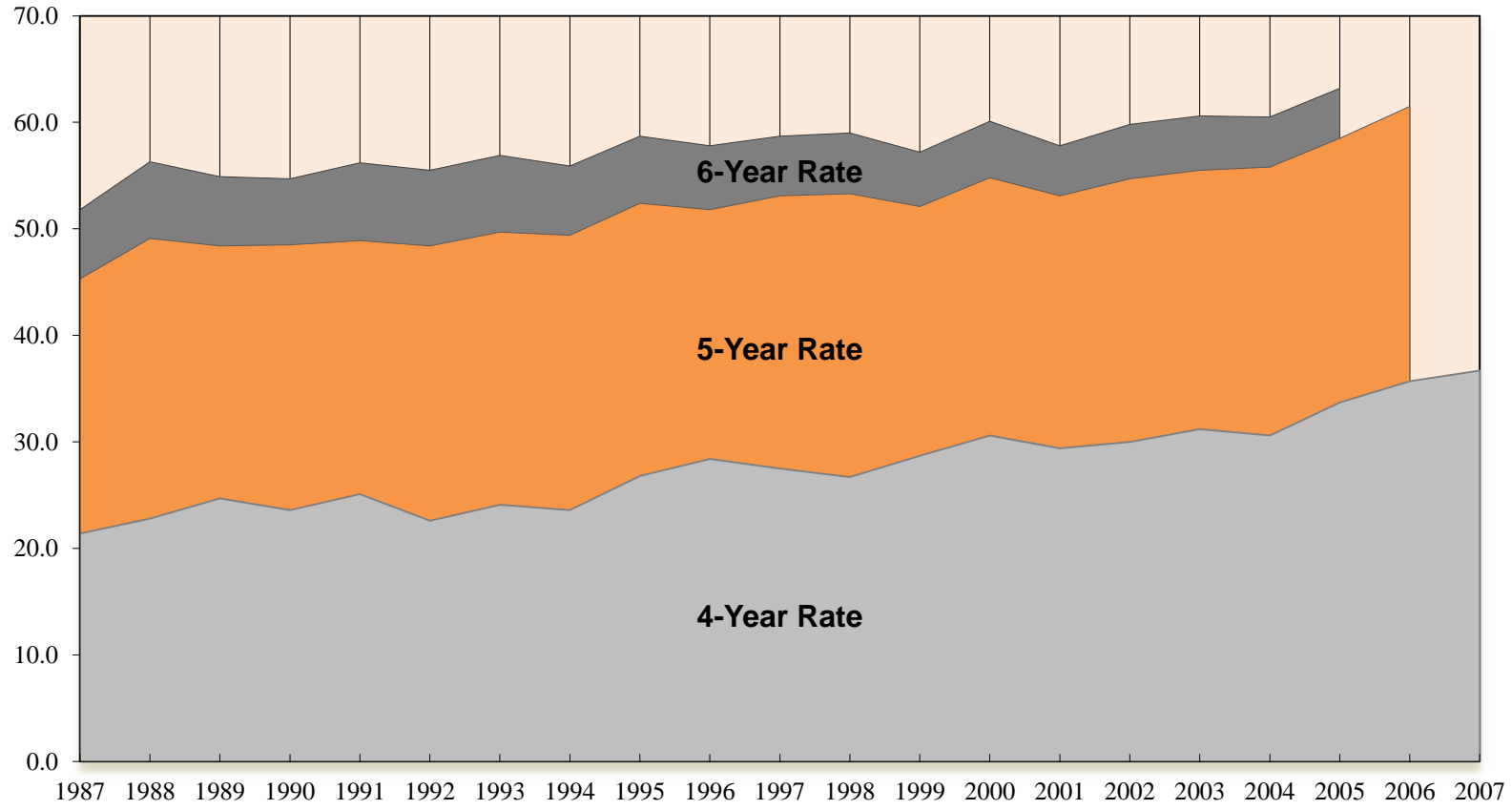
