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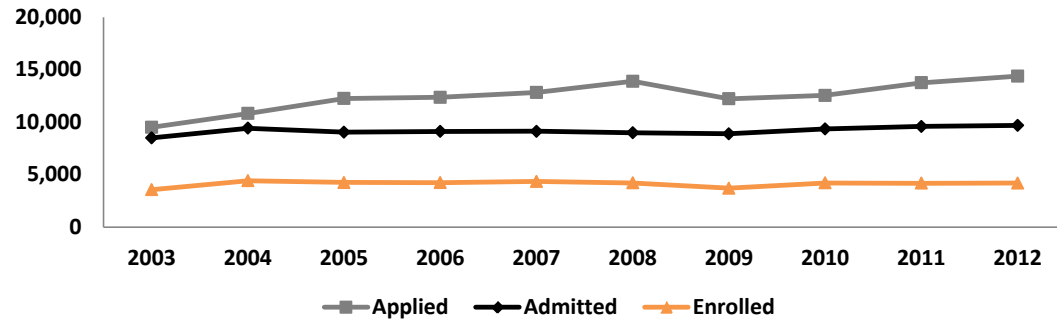

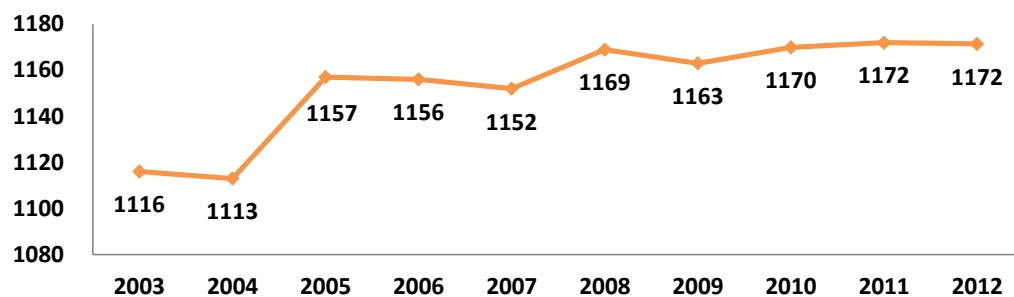

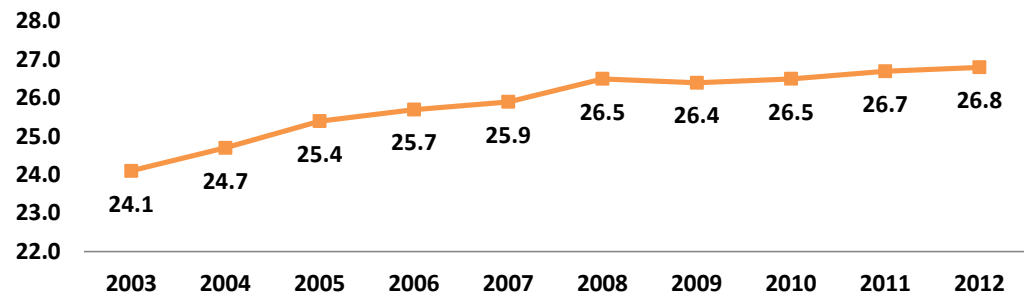
First-Time Freshmen Average SAT Scores Fall 2003-2012

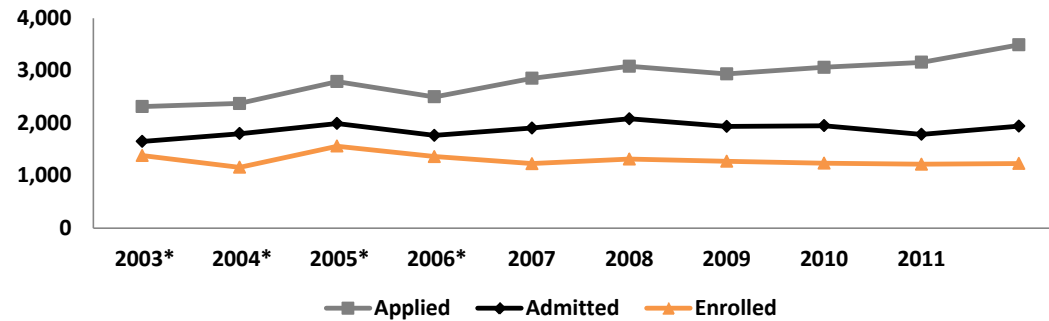

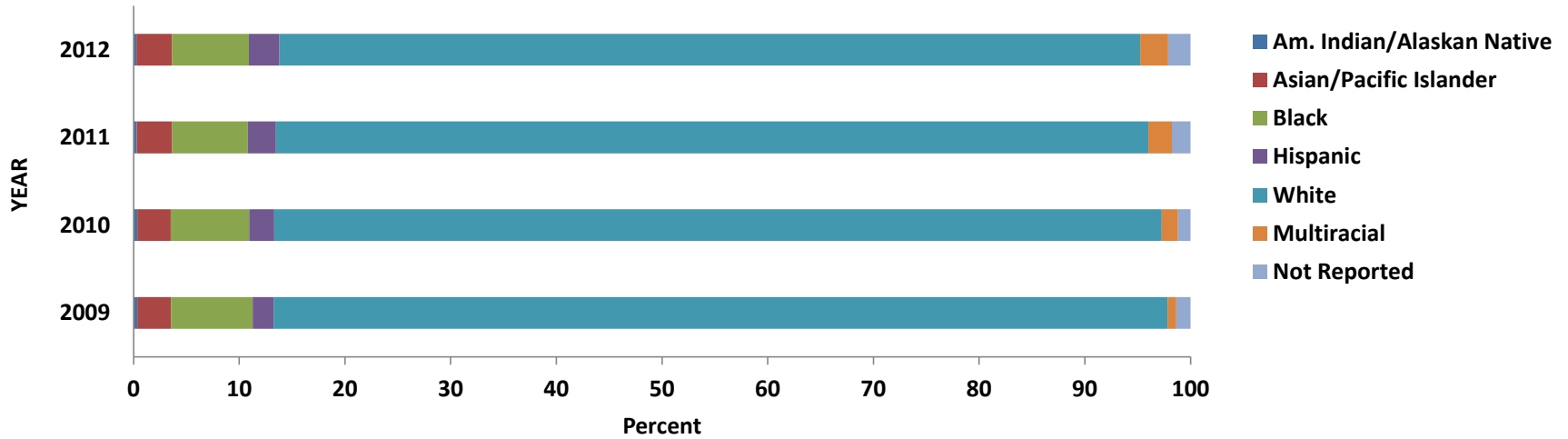

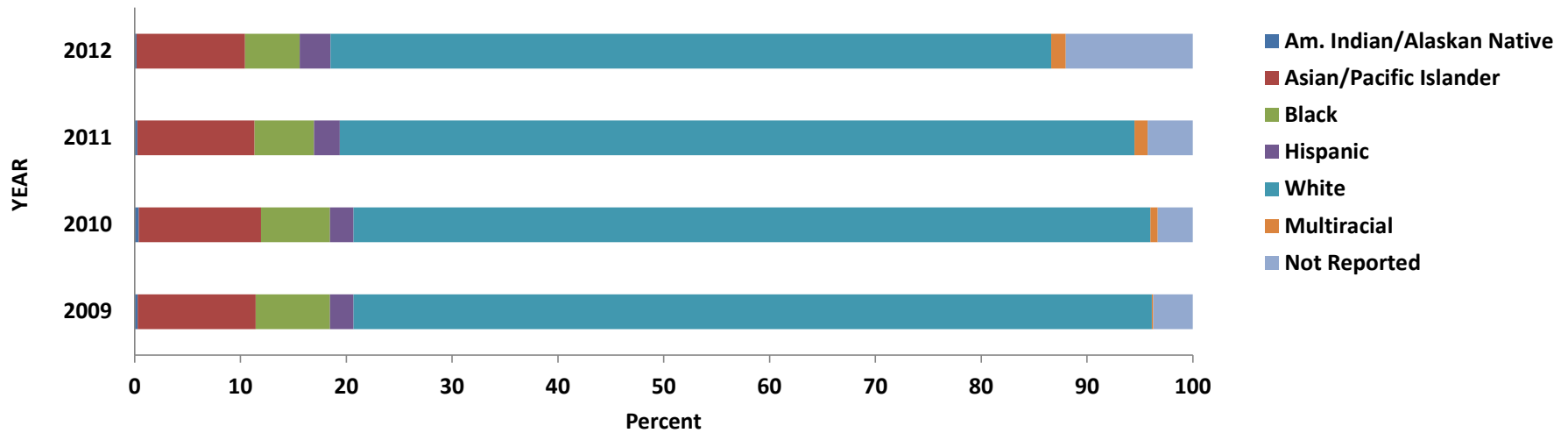

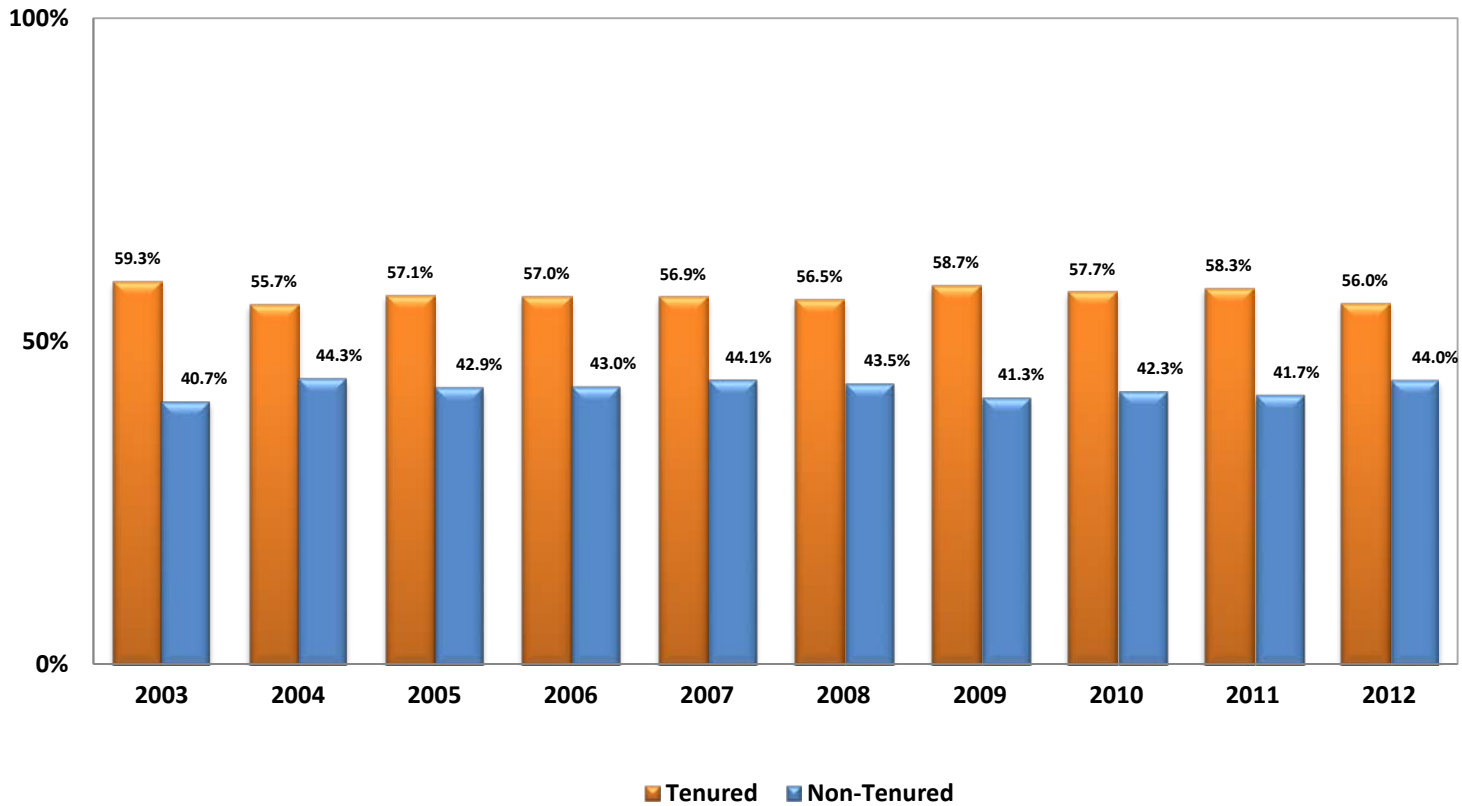

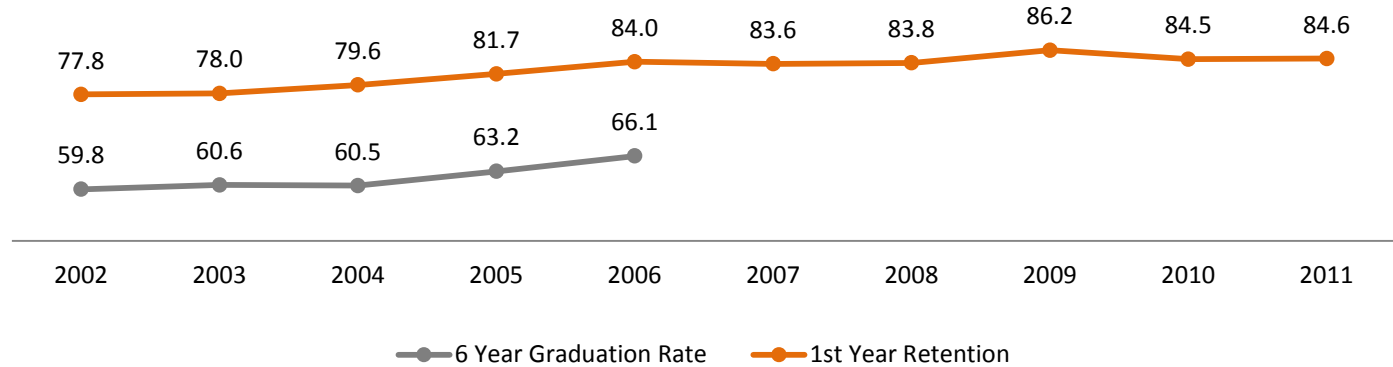

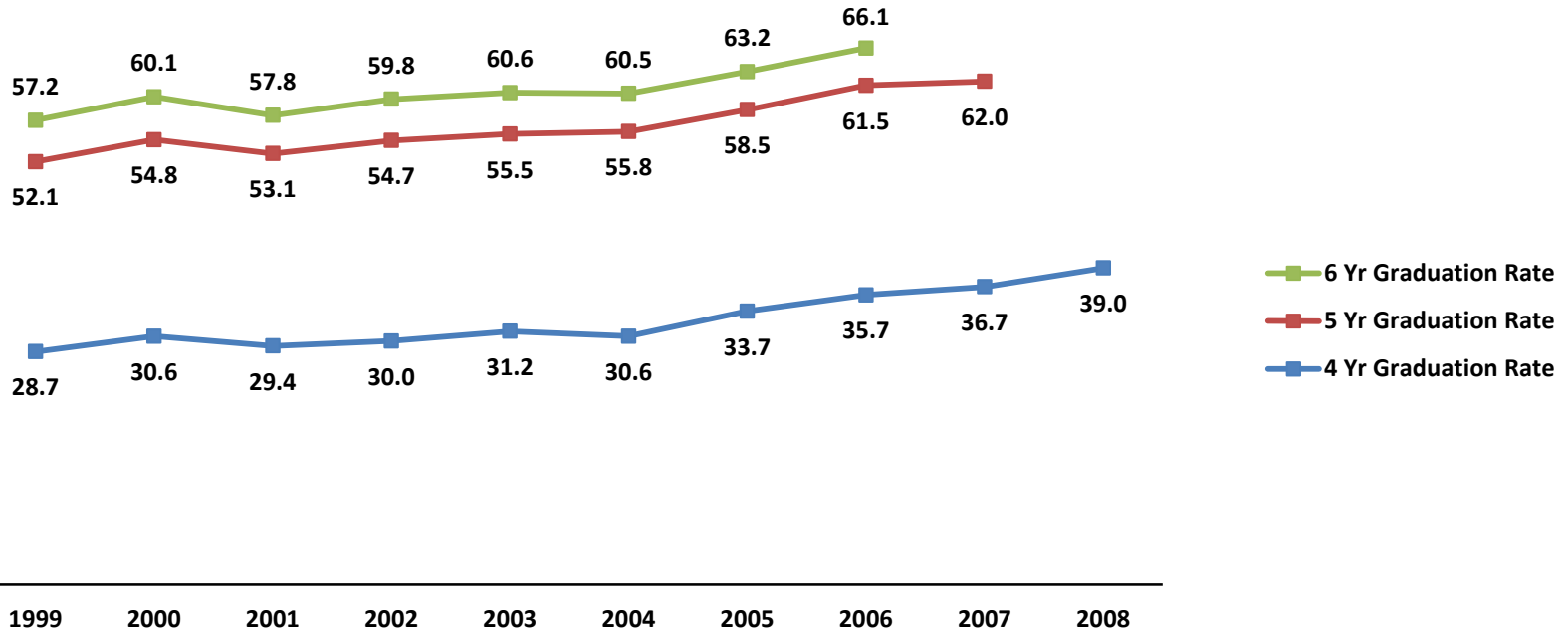

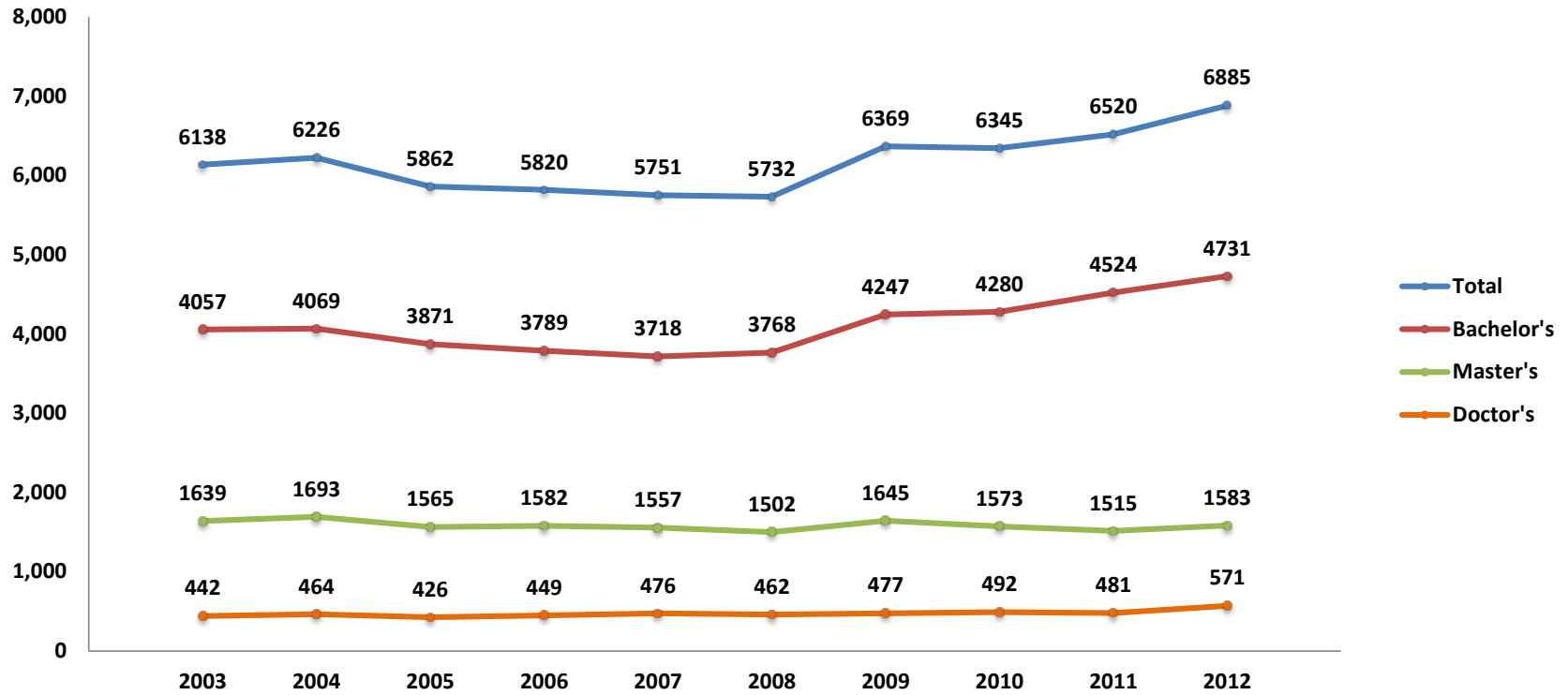
