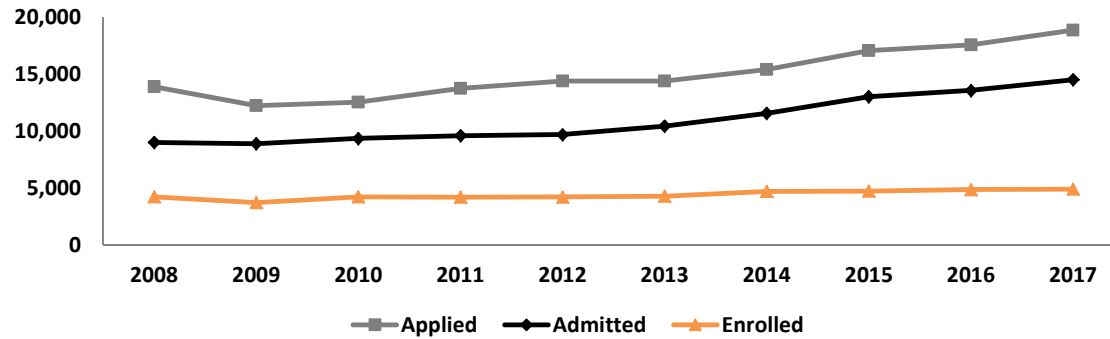

20 Year Trend of Average Test Scores, High School GPA, and Class Ranking First Time Freshmen Fall 1998-2017

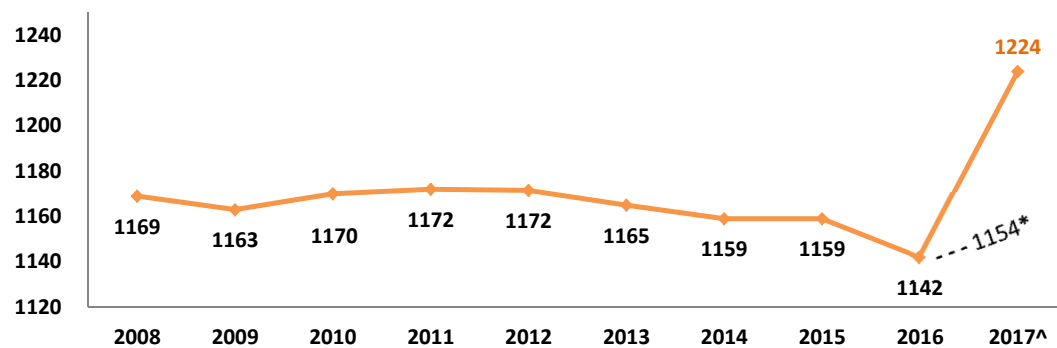

10 Year Trend of First-Time Freshmen Average SAT Scores Fall 2008-2017



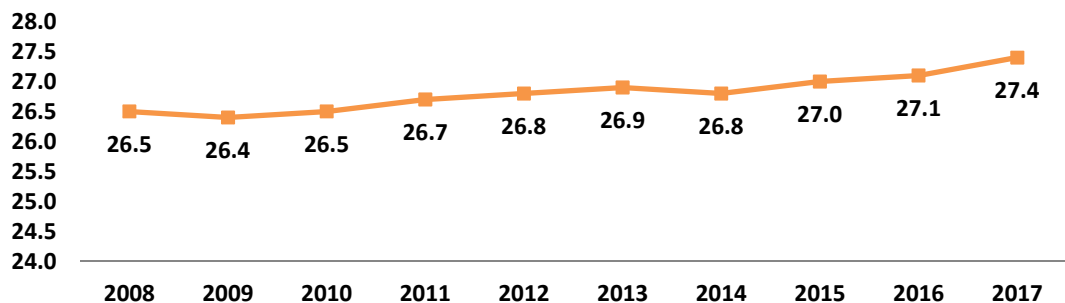

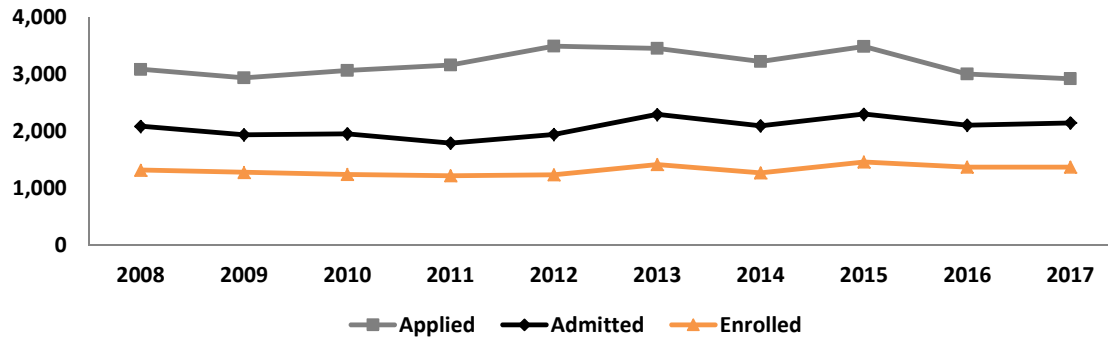

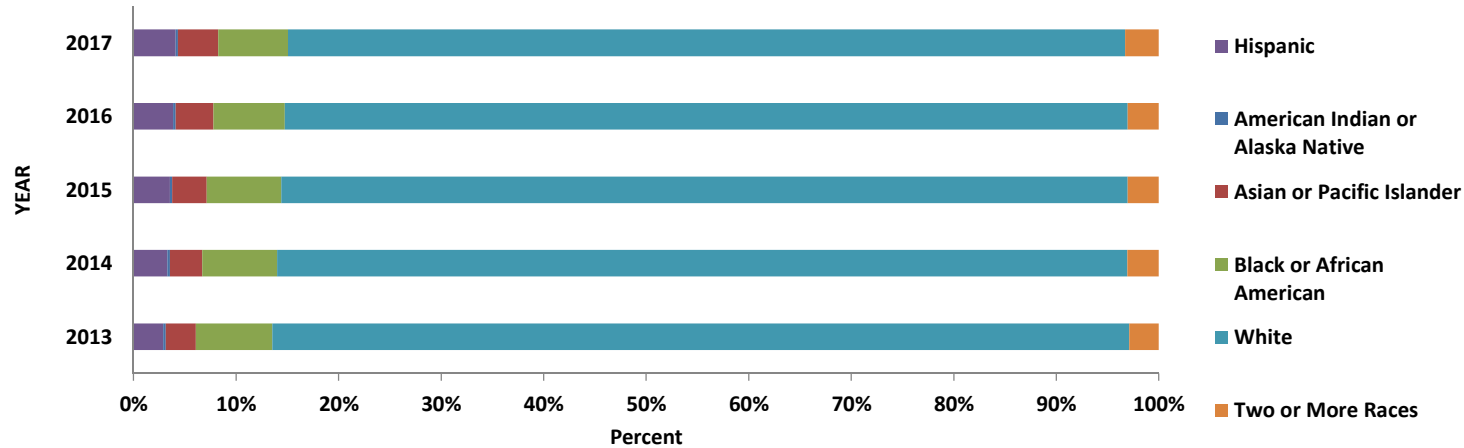

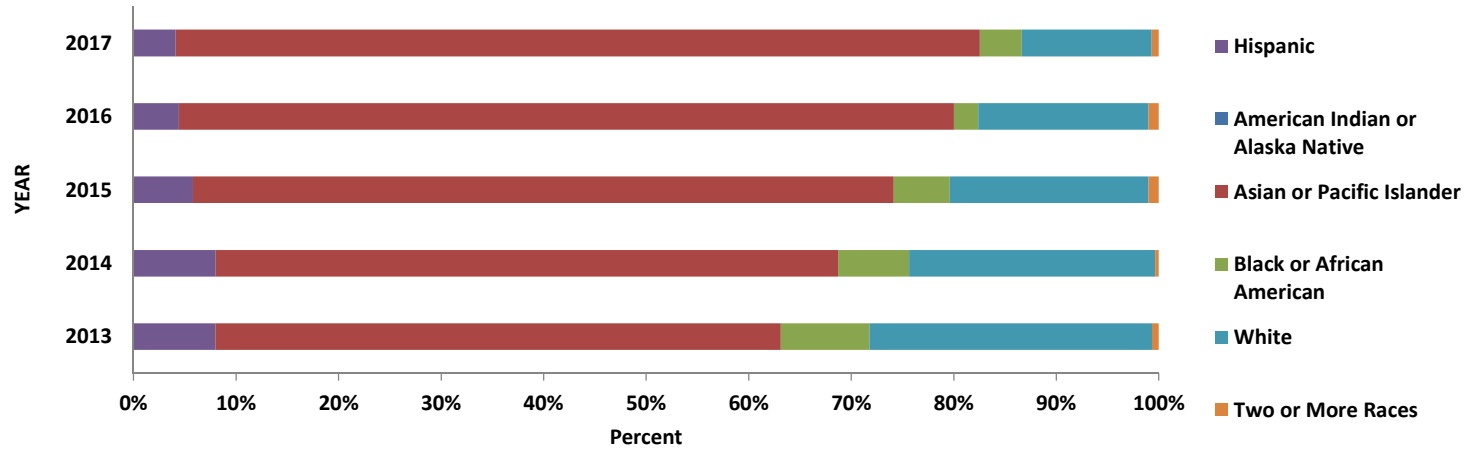

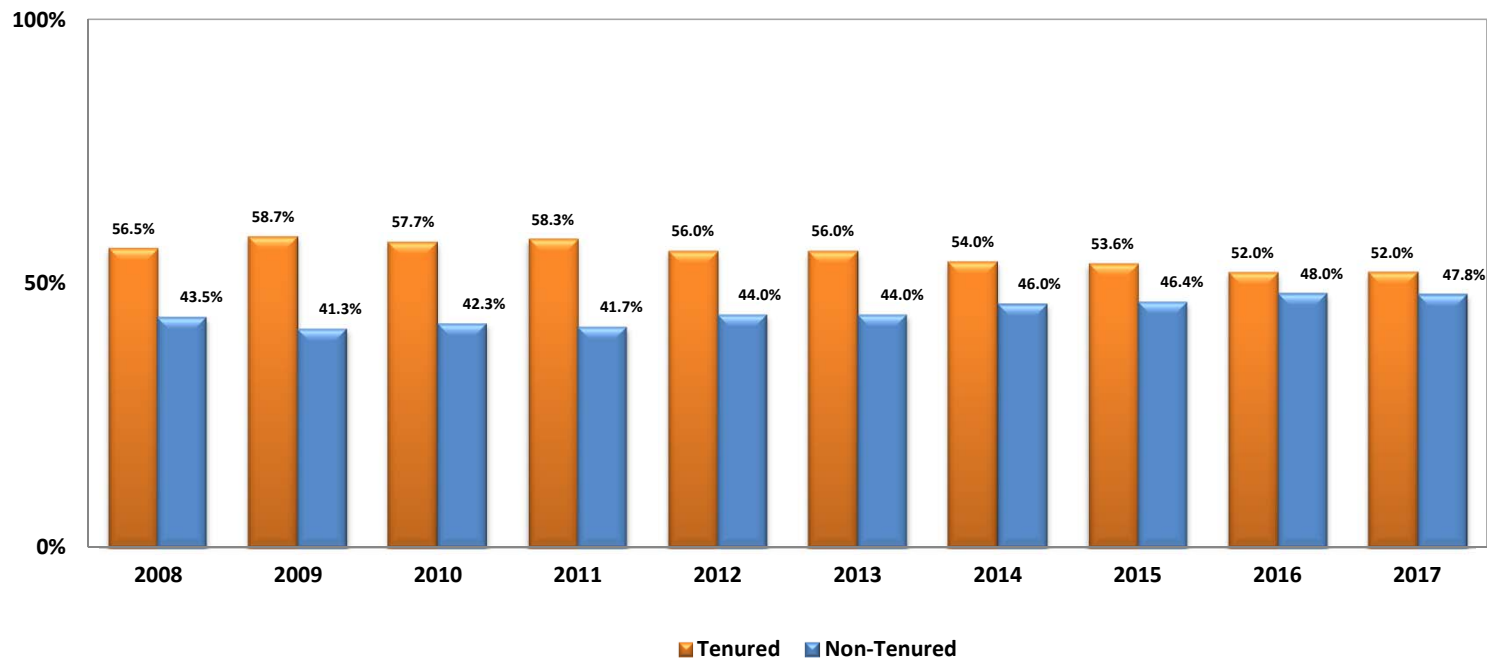

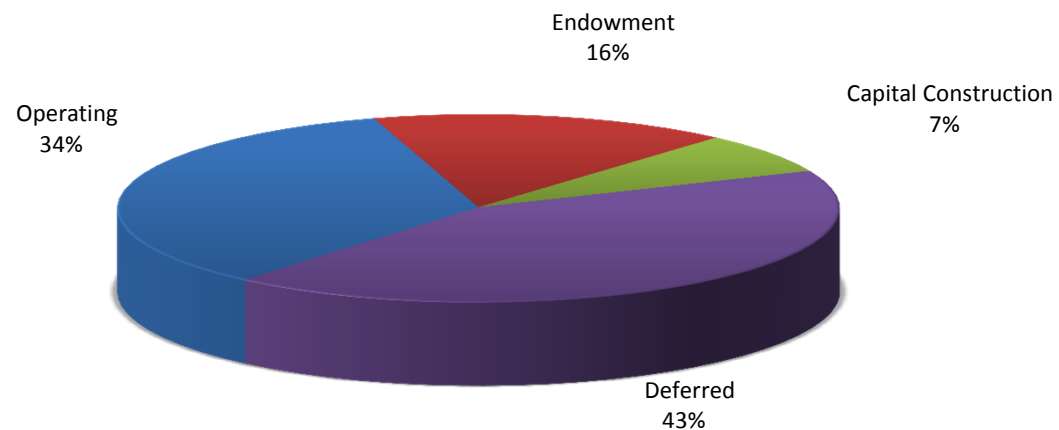


UT Knoxville Analysis by Purpose

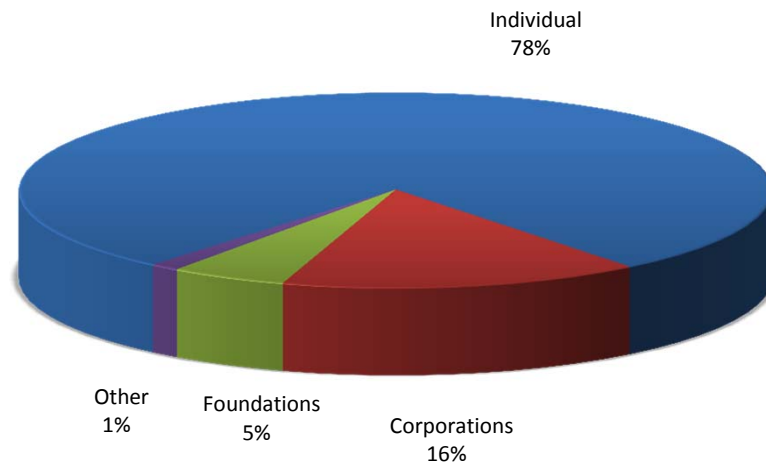


UT Knoxville Analysis By Source

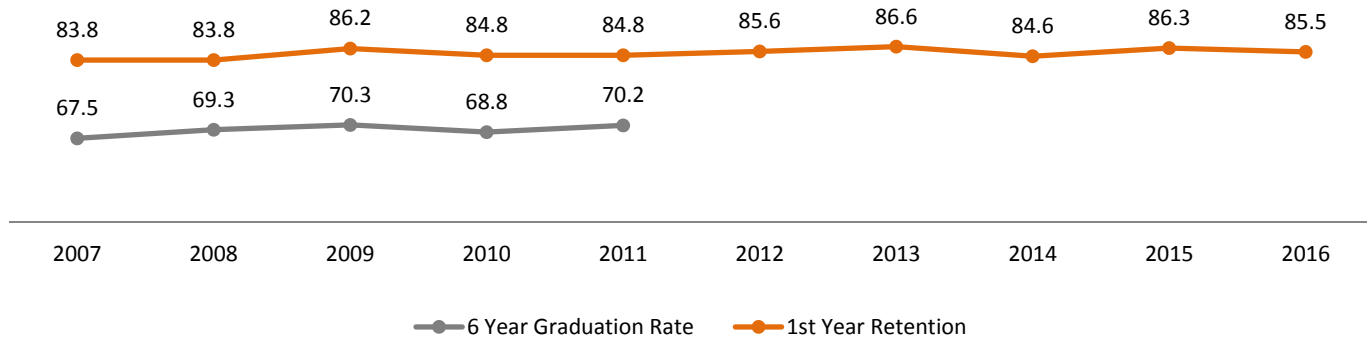

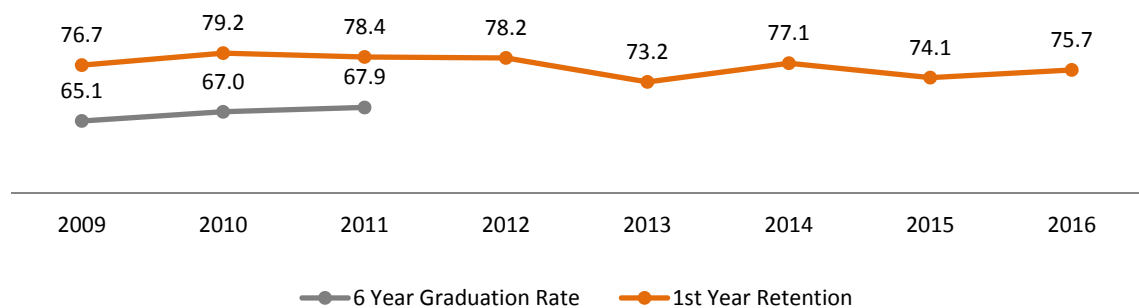

10 Year Trend of Retention and Graduation Rates First-time Full-time Freshman Fall Cohorts 2007-2016



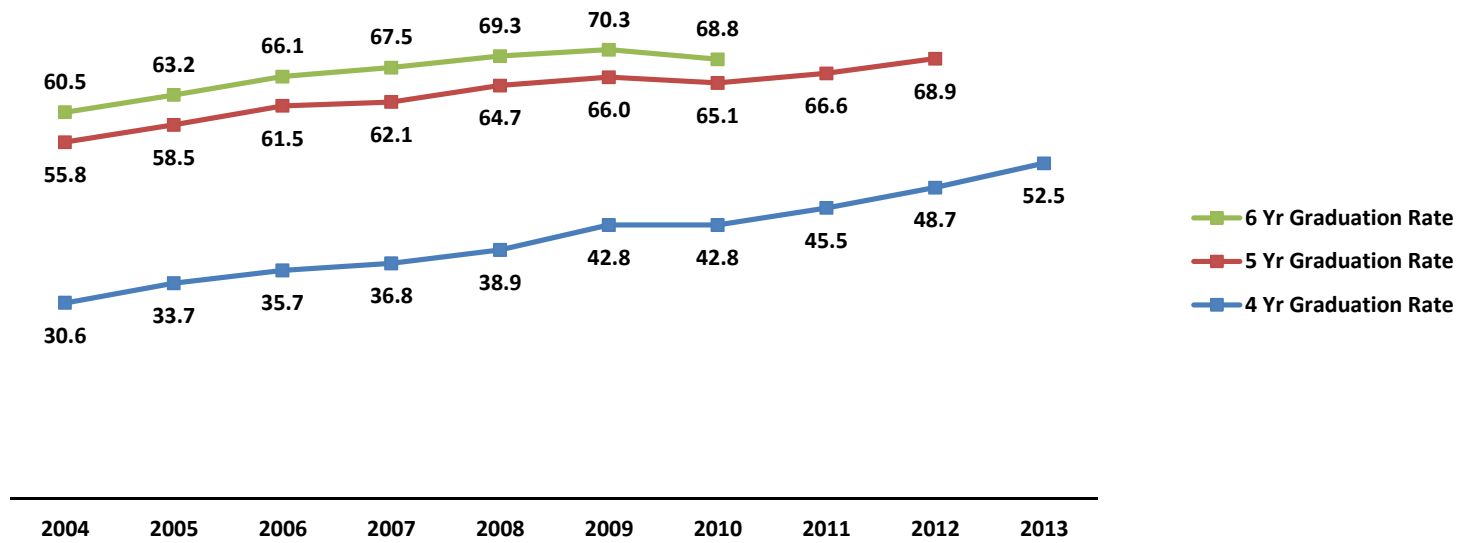

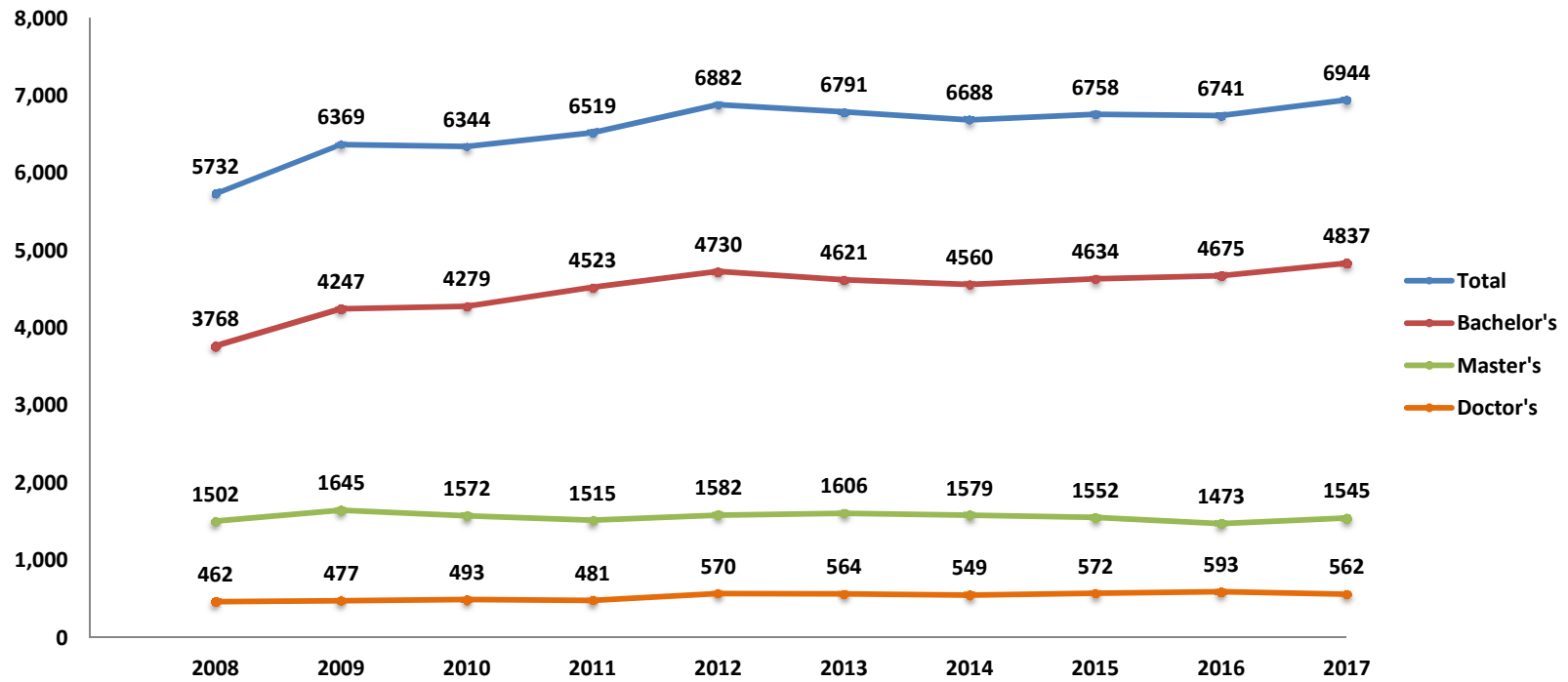
