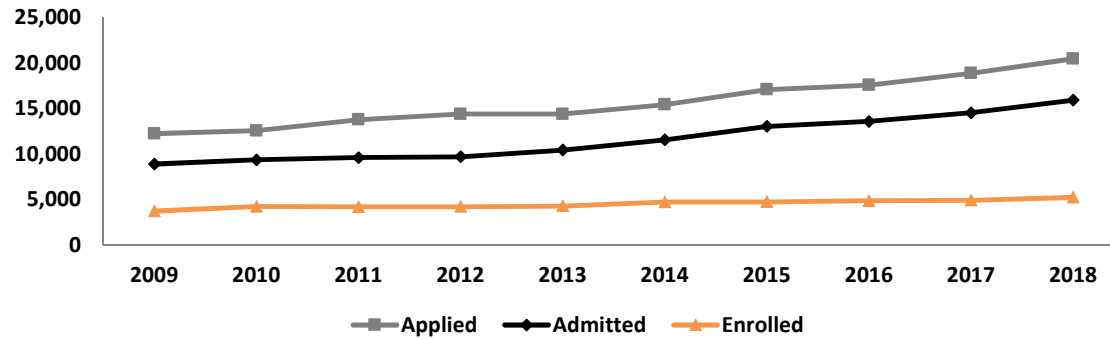

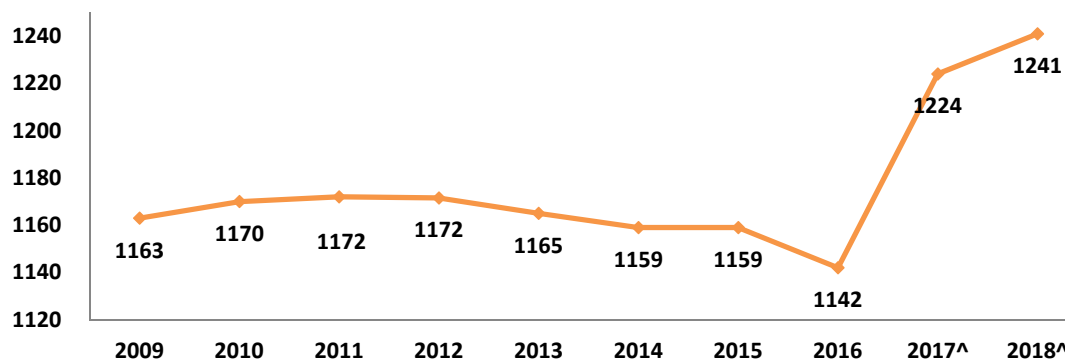

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## 10 Year Trend of First-Time Freshmen Average SAT Scores Fall 2009-2018



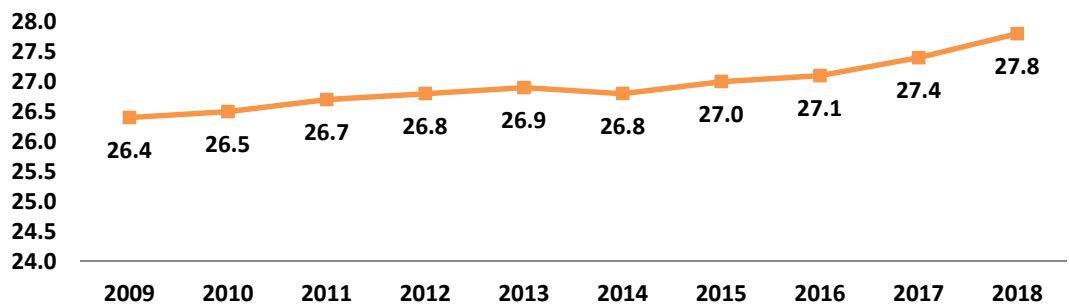

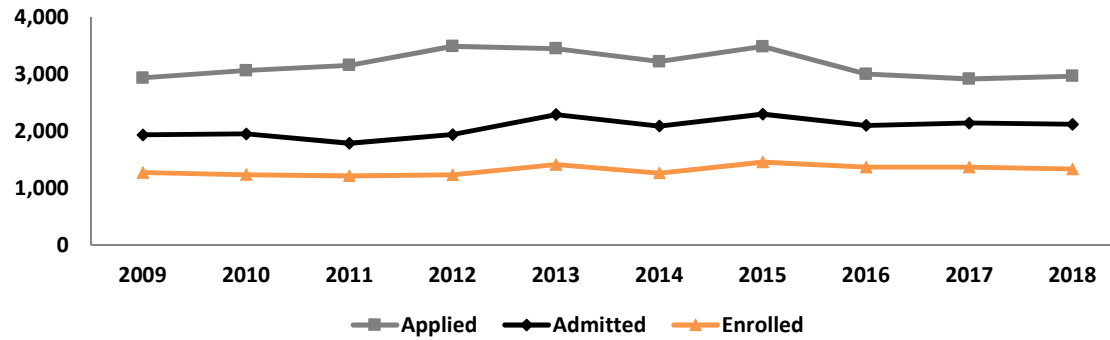

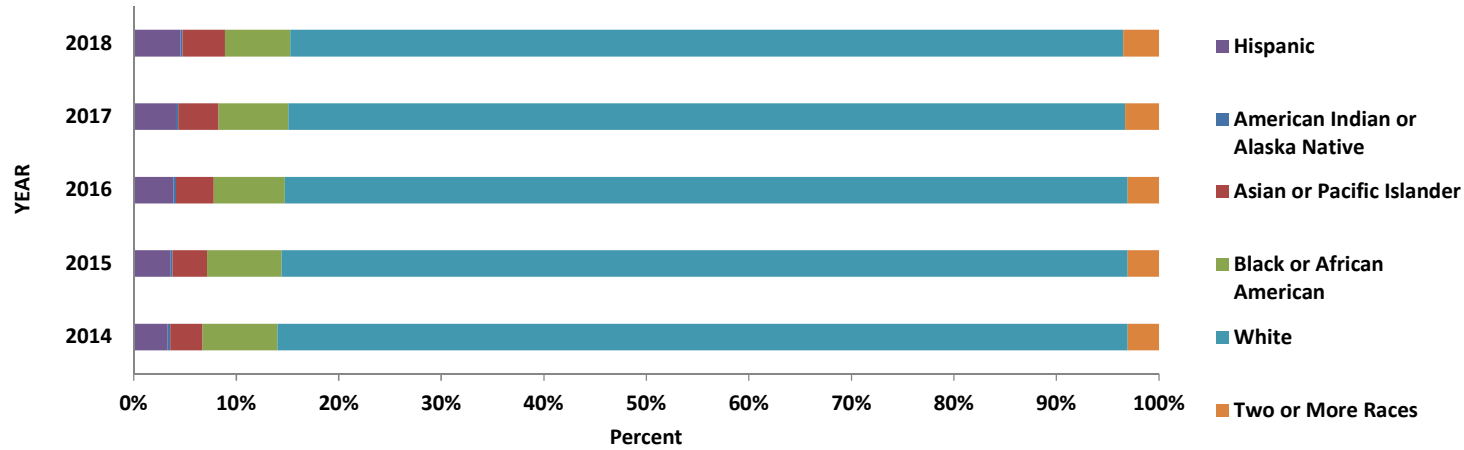

## 5 Year Trend of Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment By Race/Ethnicity (Excludes Nonresident Aliens) Fall 2014-2018



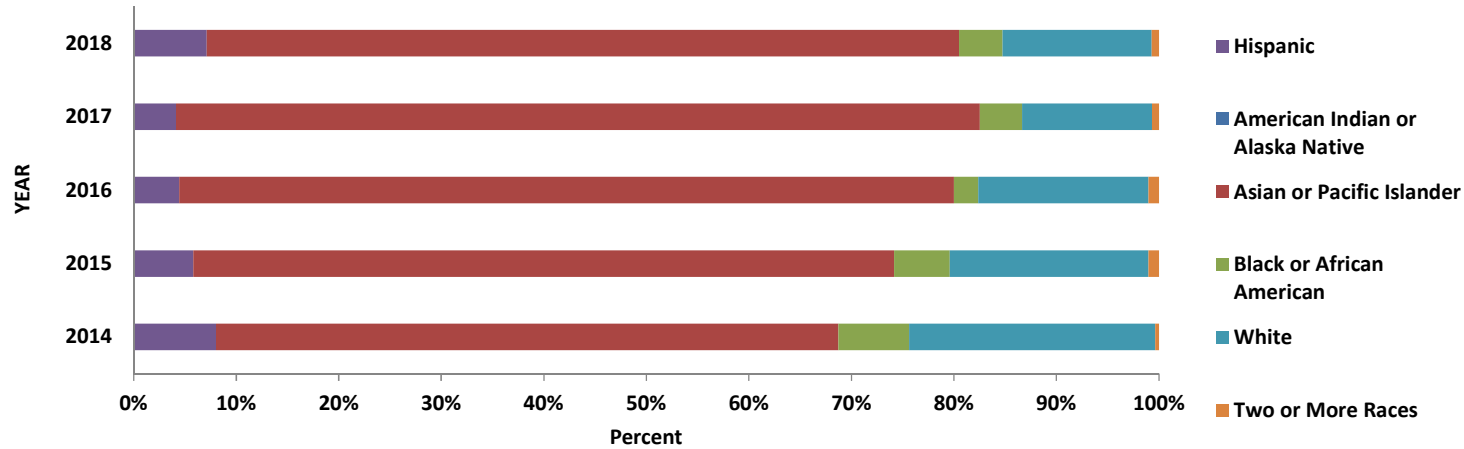

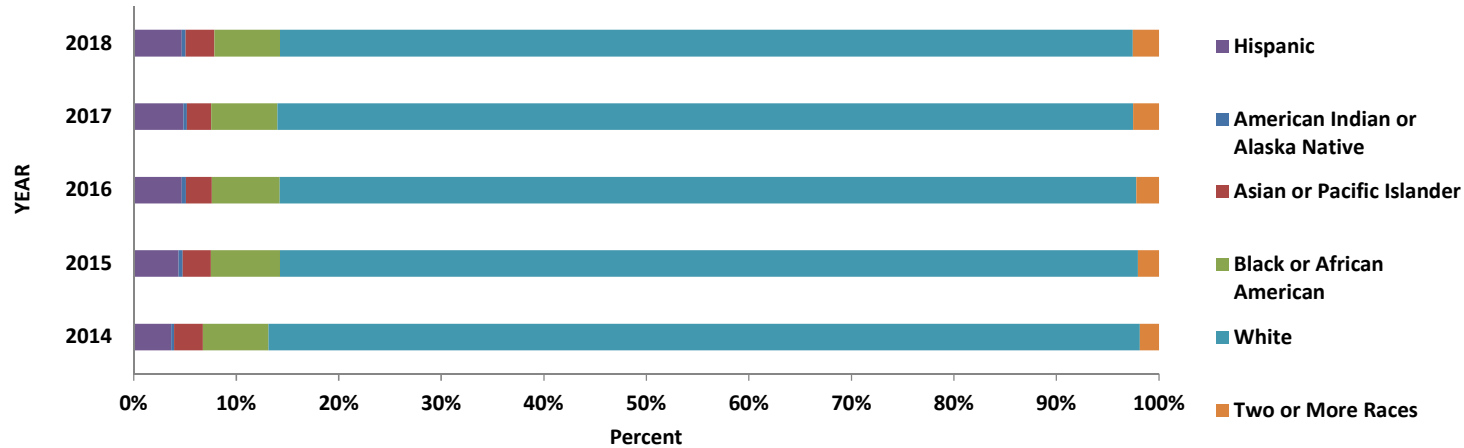

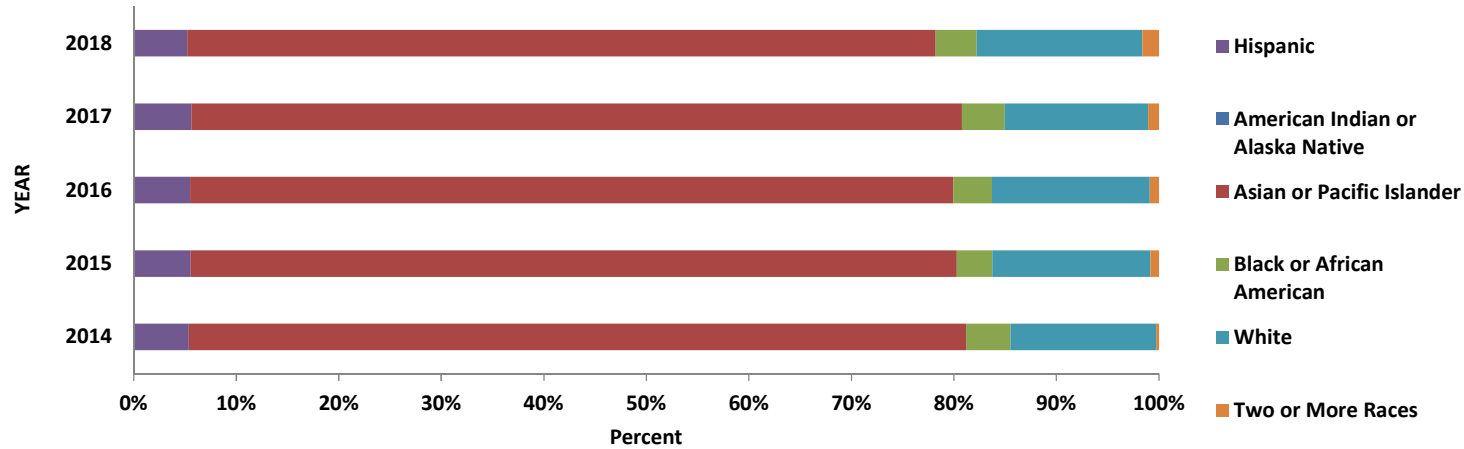

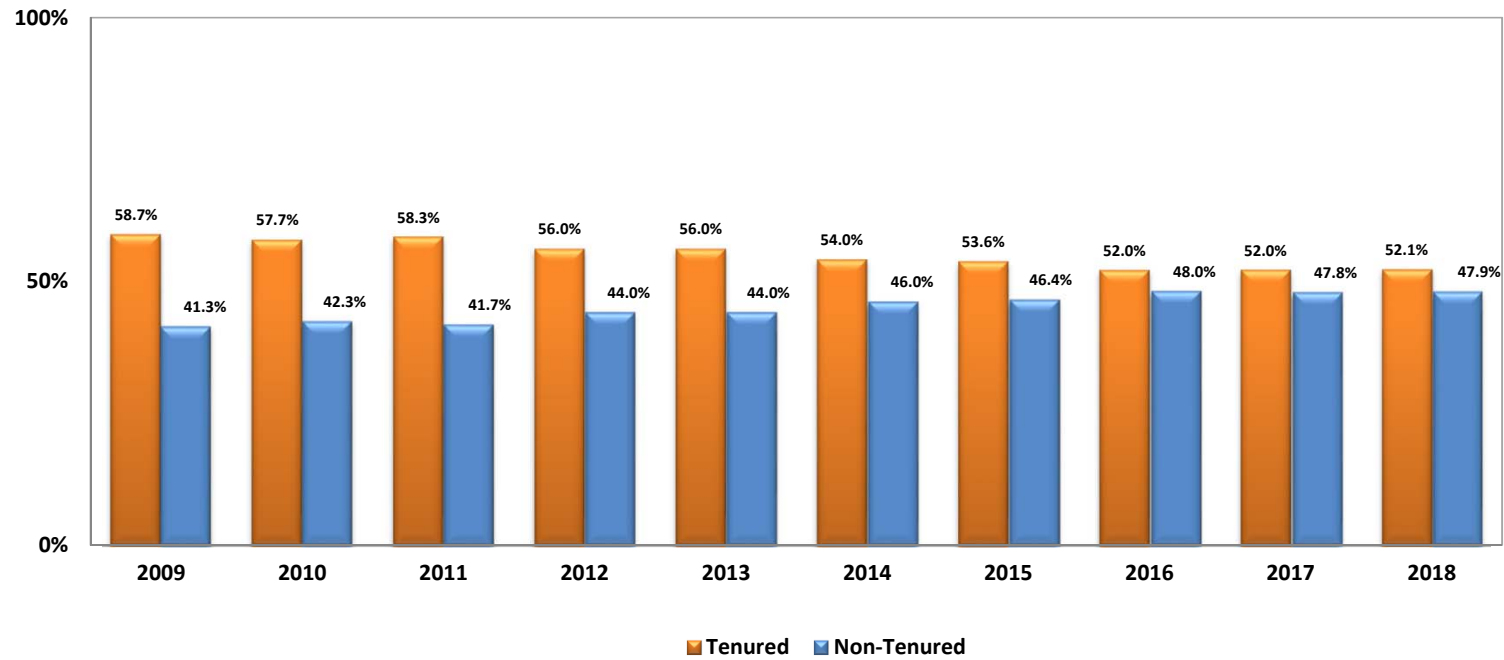

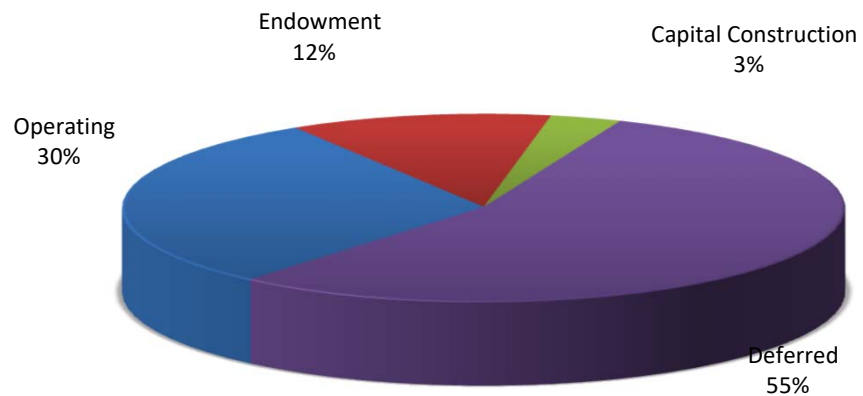


## UT Knoxville Analysis by Purpose

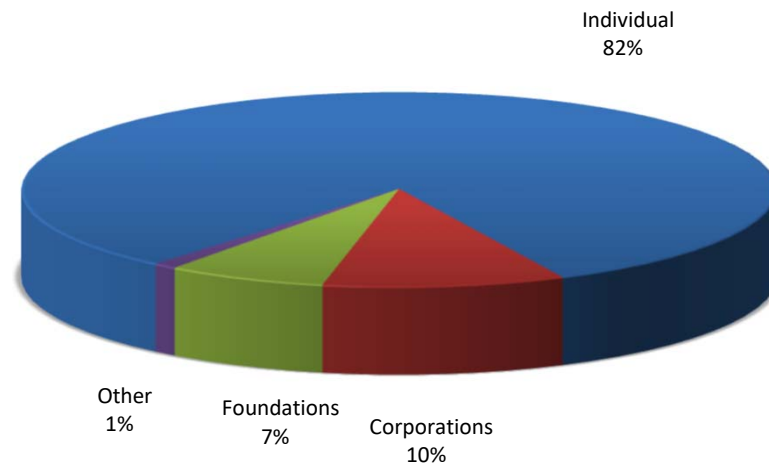


## UT Knoxville Analysis By Source

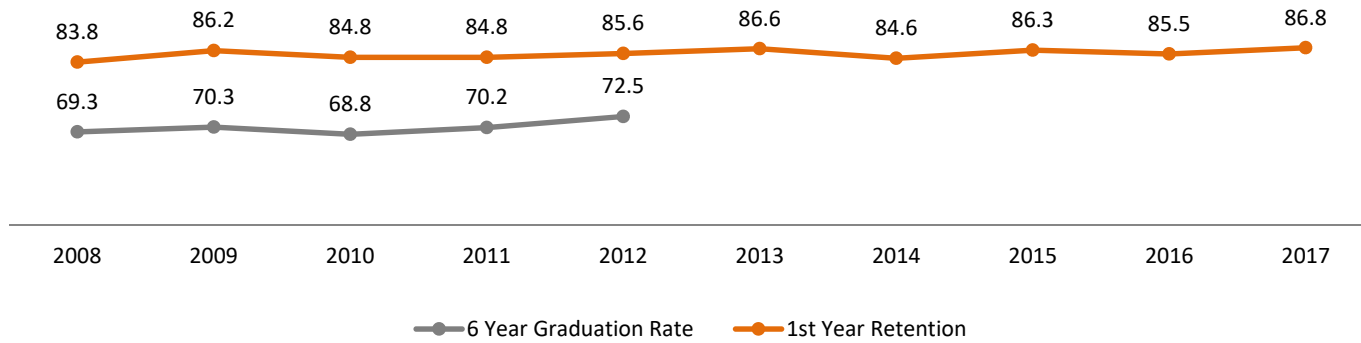

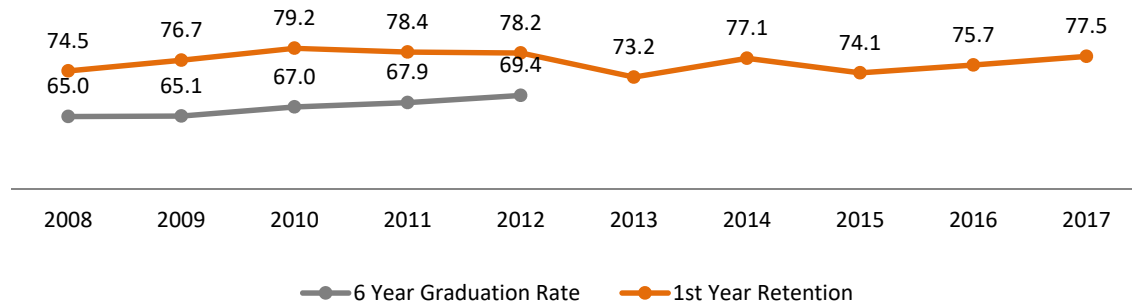

## 10 Year Trend of Retention and Graduation Rates First-time Full-time Freshman Fall Cohorts 2008-2017



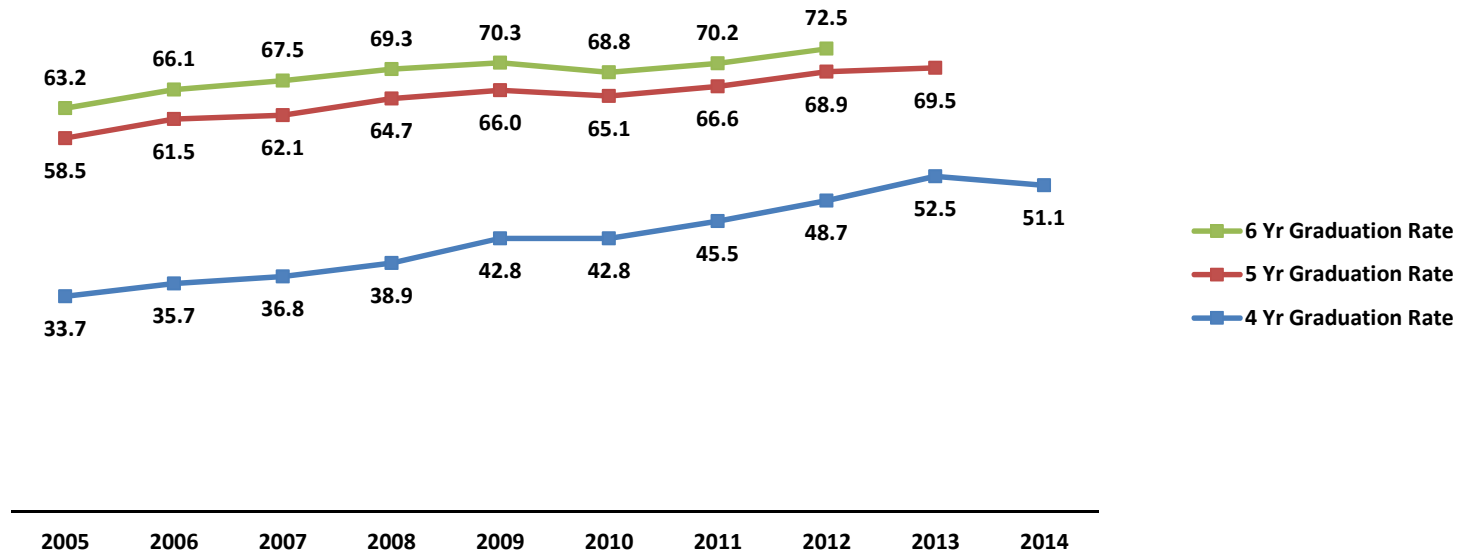

## 10 Year Trend of Retention and Graduation Rates First-time Transfer Students Fall Cohorts 2008-2017



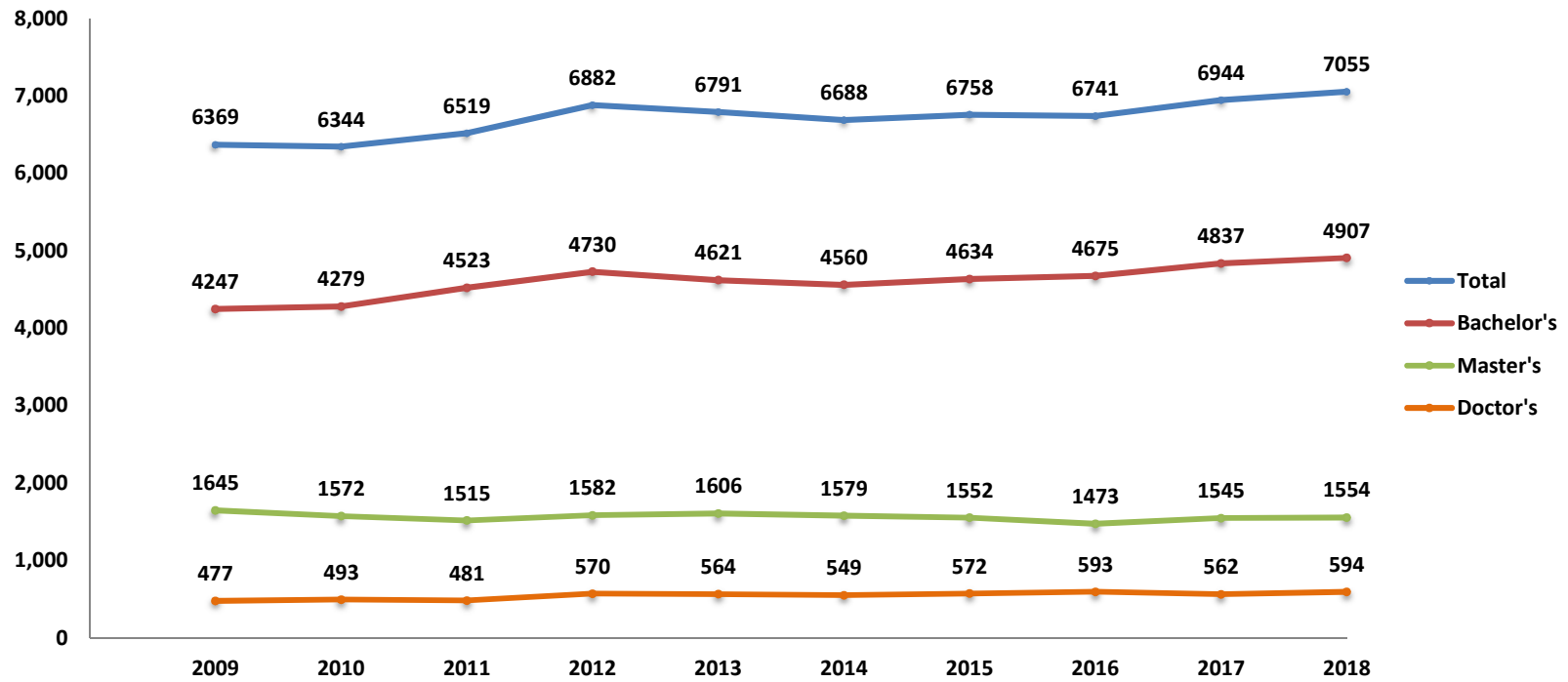

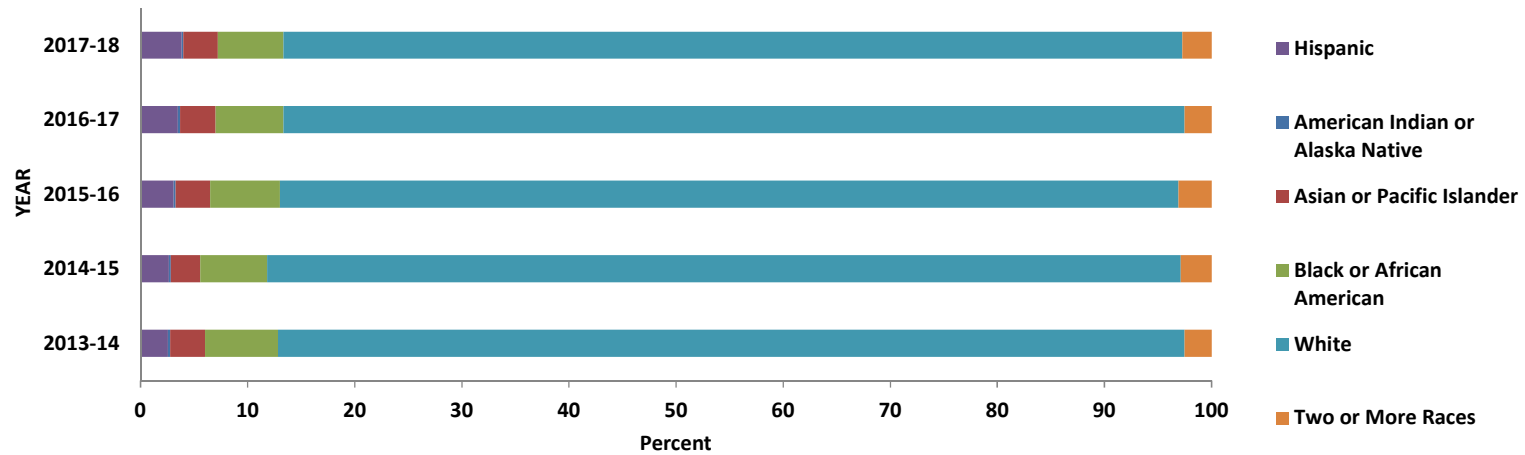

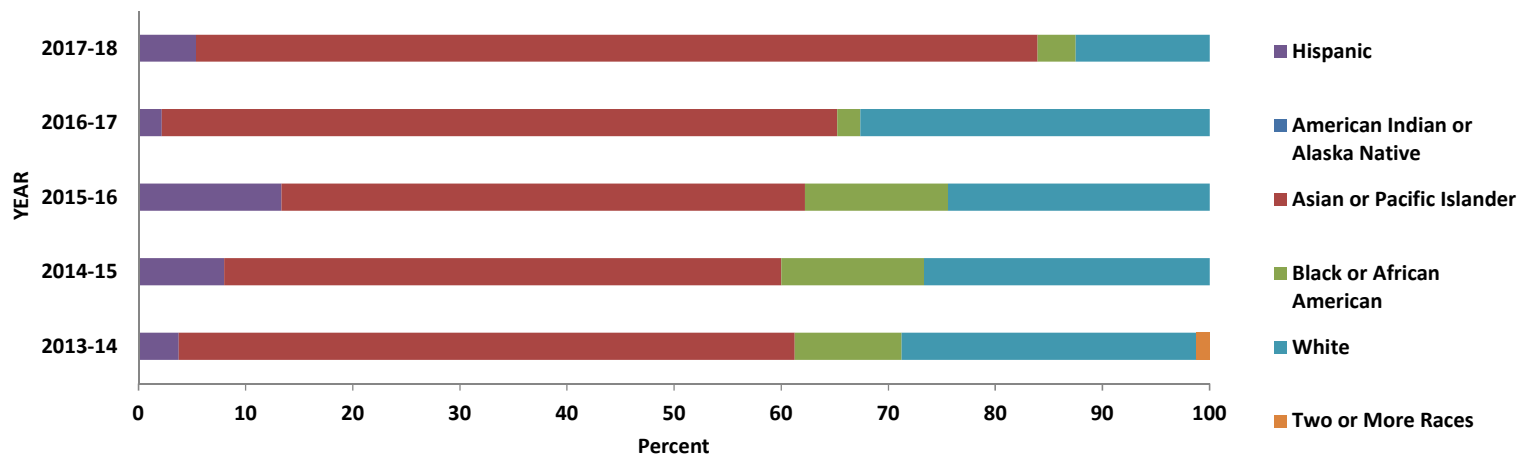

## 5 Year Trend of Bachelor's Degrees of Nonresident Aliens (International) By Race/Ethnicity Academic Year 2013-2017

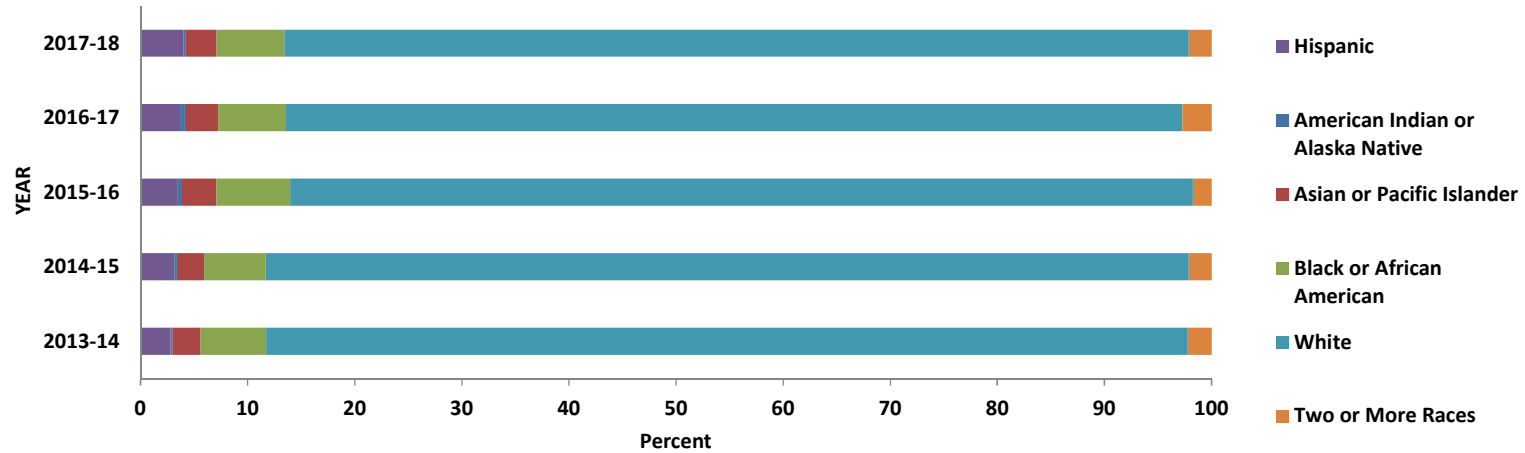

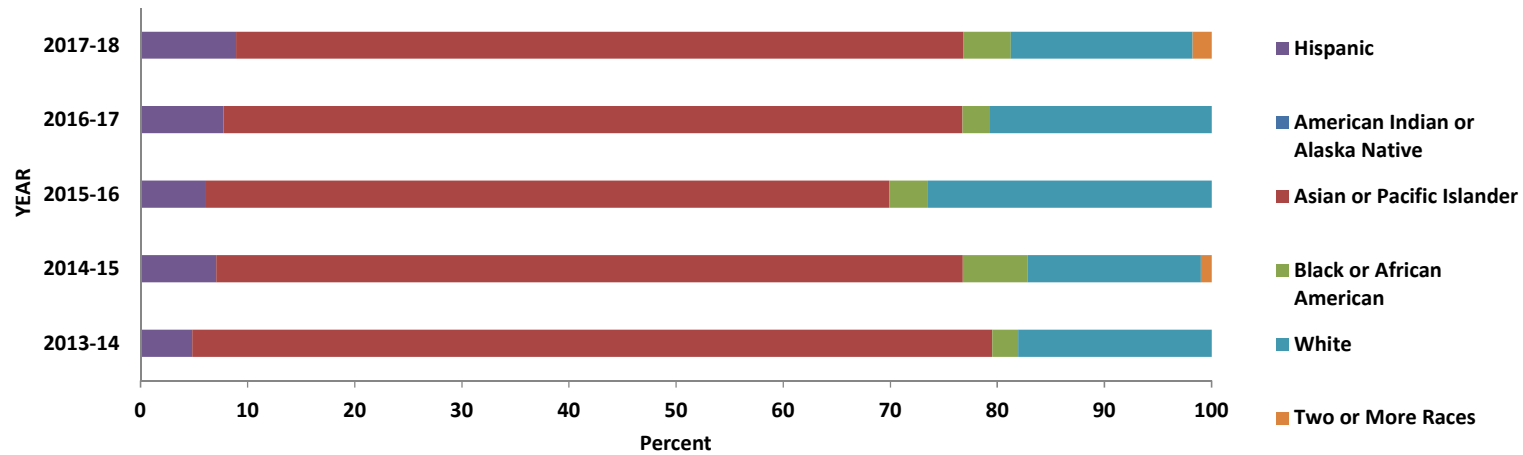

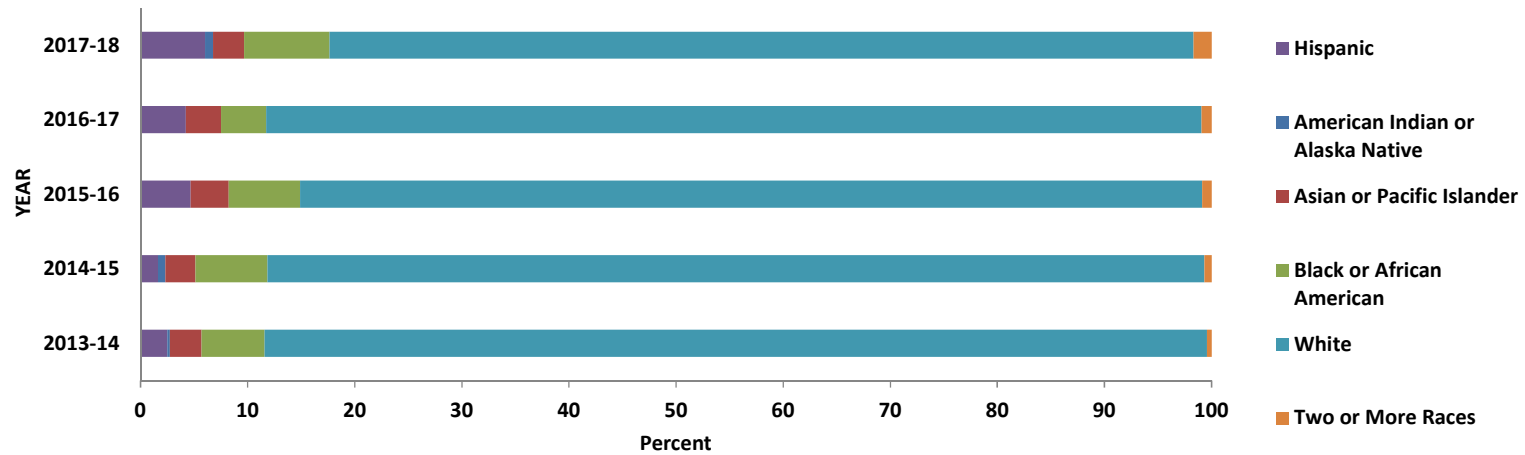
## 5 Year Trend of Master's Degrees of Nonresident Aliens (International) Enrollment By Race/Ethnicity Academic Year 2013-2017

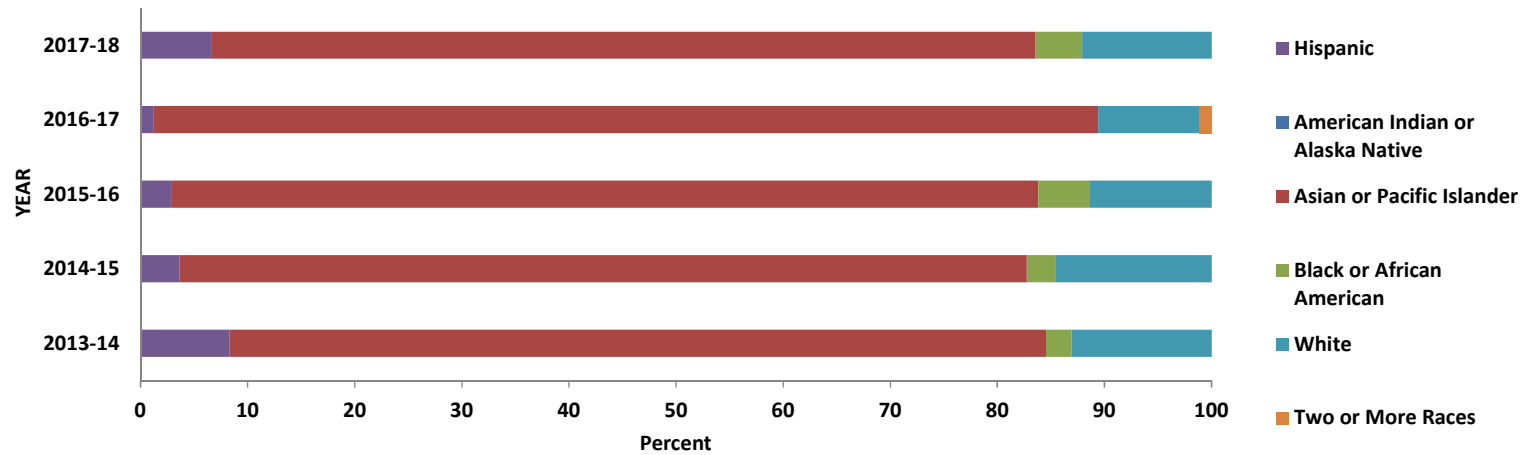
