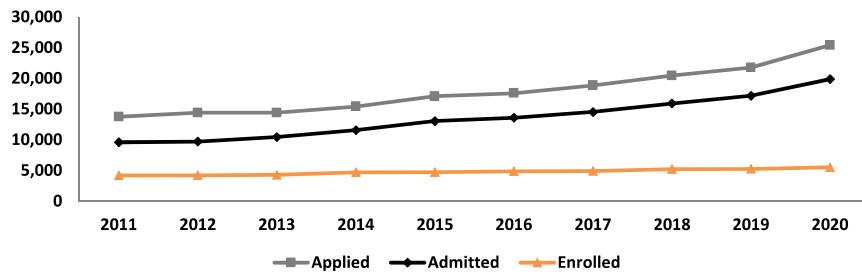

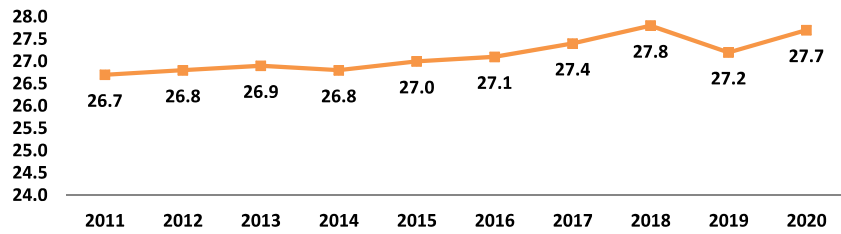

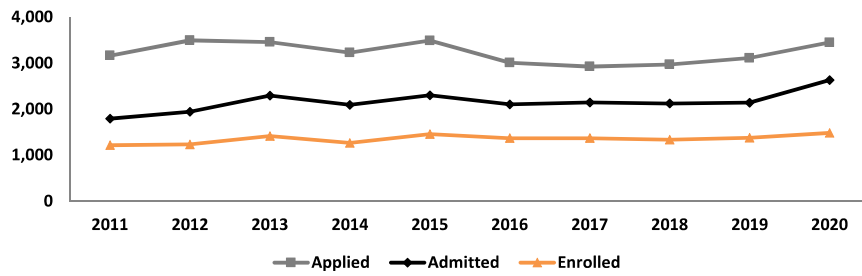

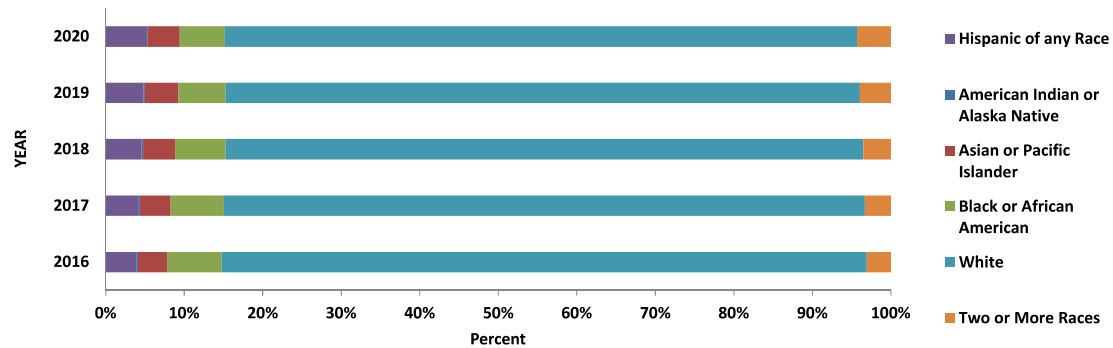

## 5 Year Trend of Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment By Race/Ethnicity (Excludes International) Fall 2016-2020



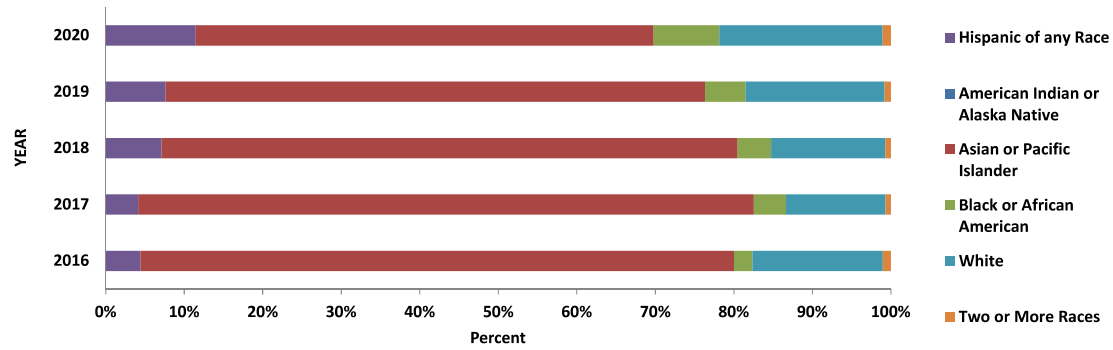

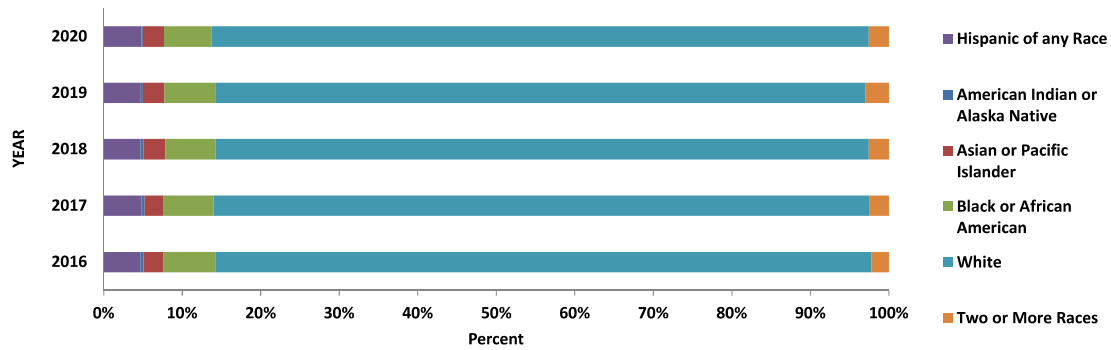

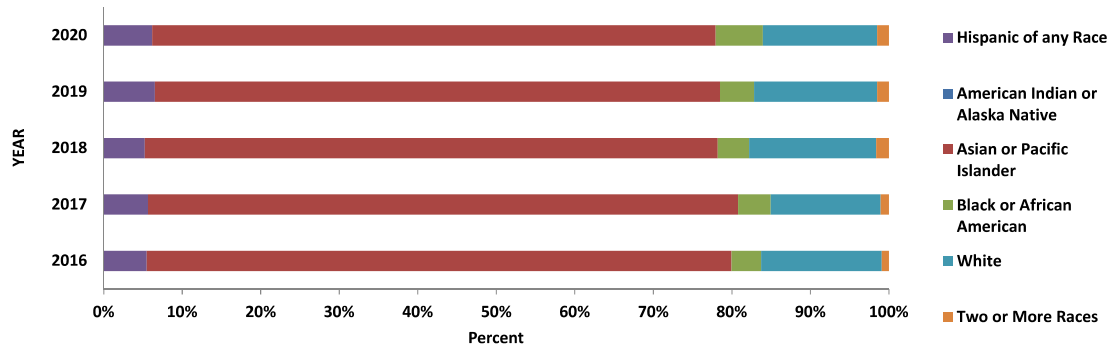

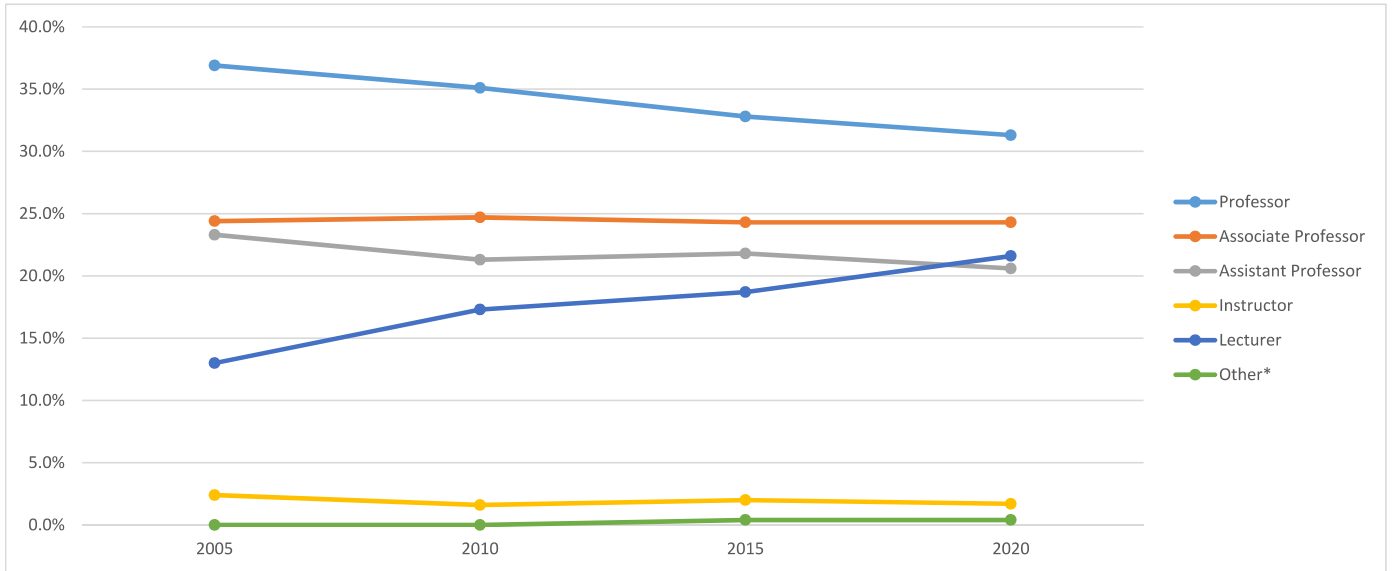

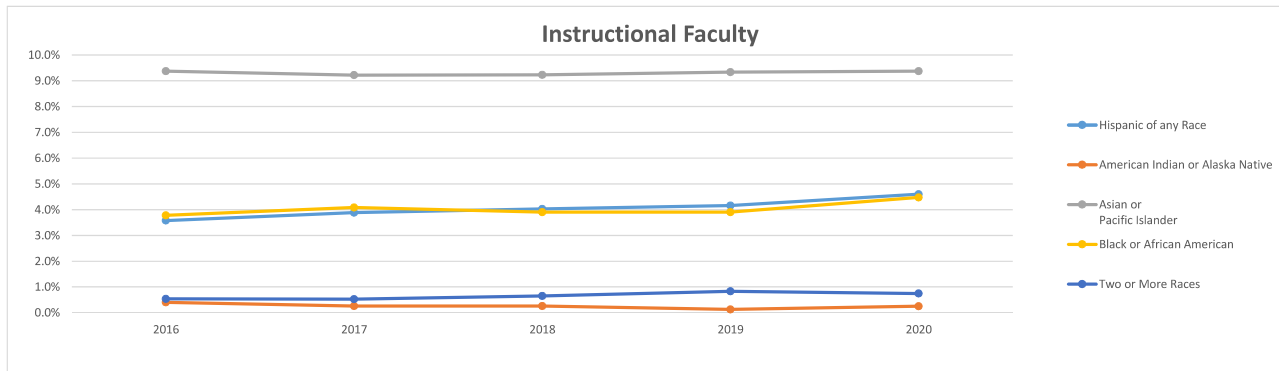

## 5 Year Trend of Full-time Instructional Faculty By Race/Ethnicity (Excludes International) Fall 2016-2020



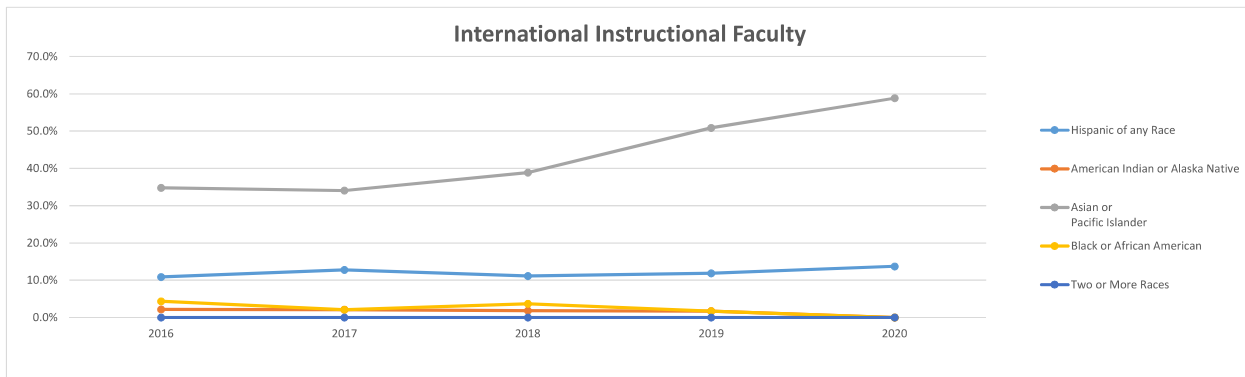

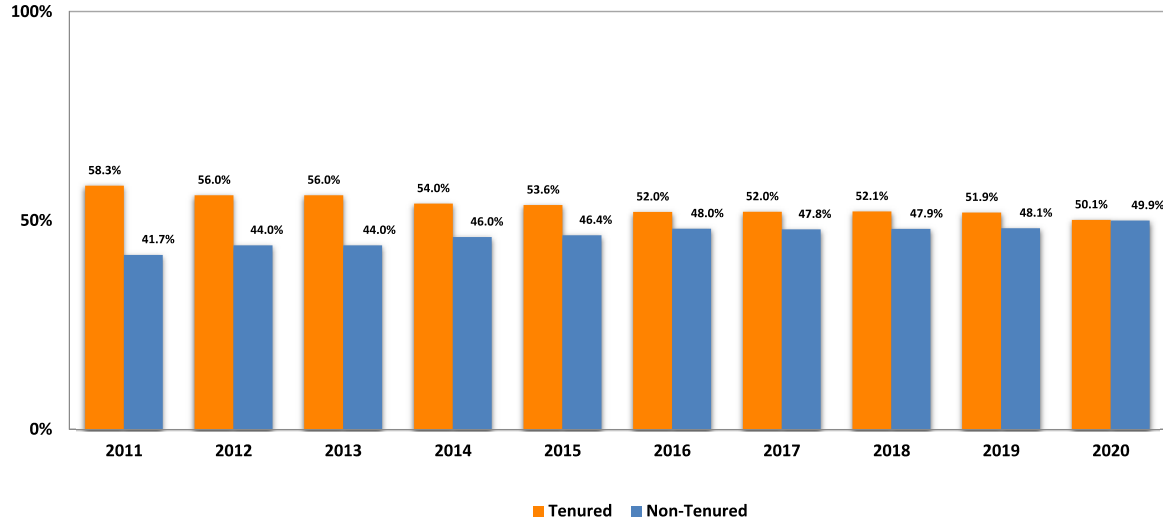

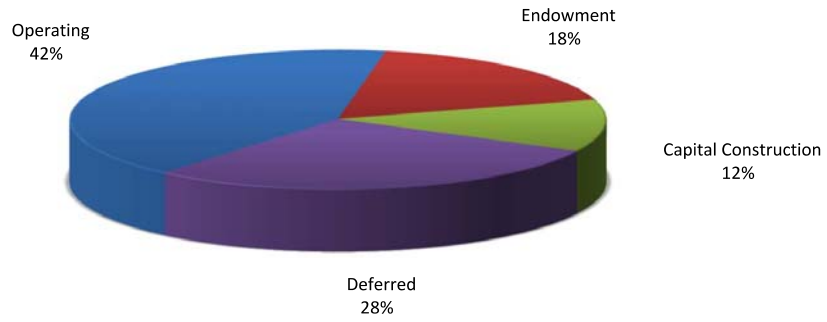


### UT Knoxville Analysis by Purpose

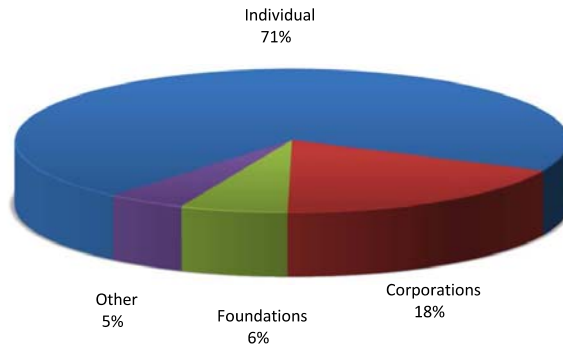


### UT Knoxville Analysis By Source

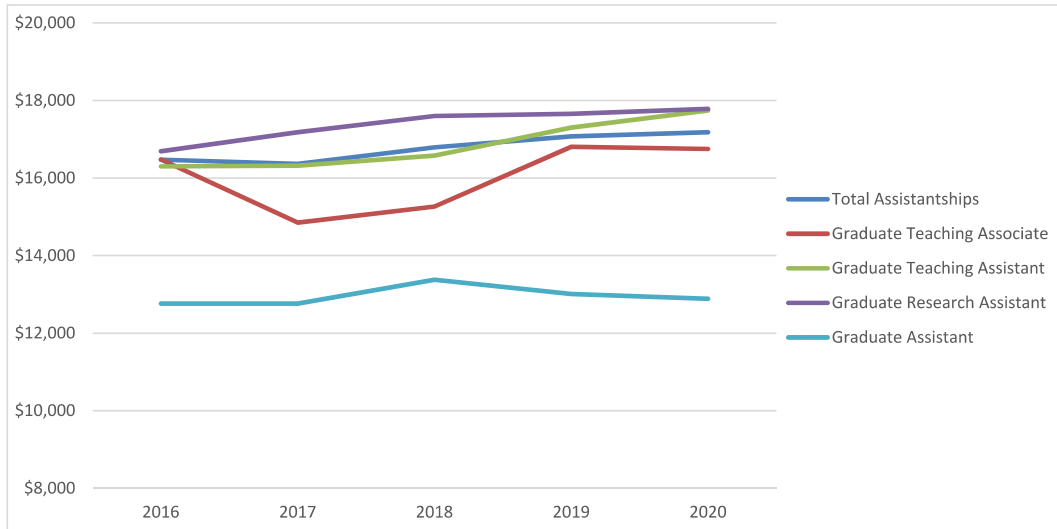

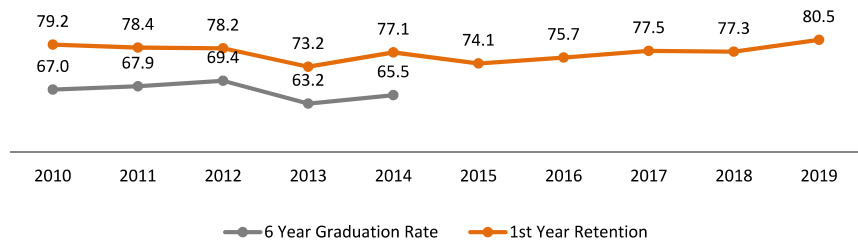

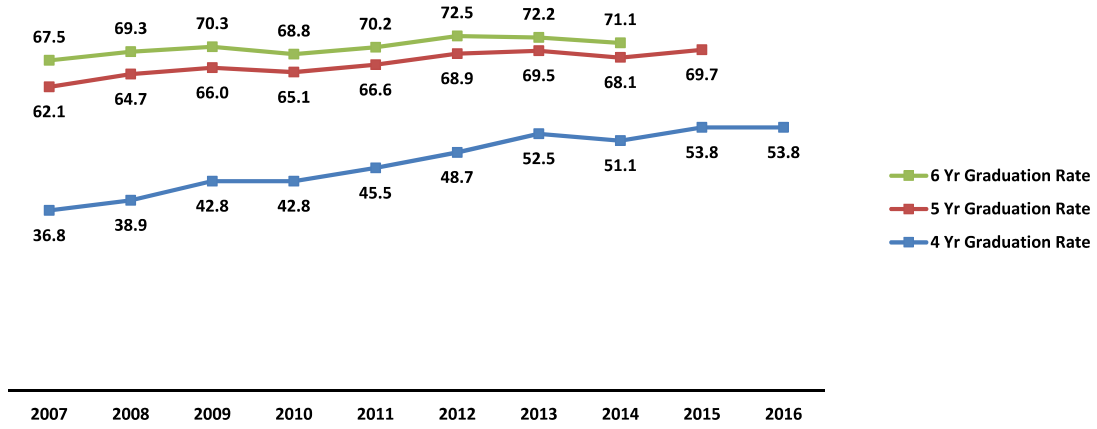

## 10 Year Trend of Retention and Graduation Rates First-time Transfer Students Fall Cohorts 2010-2019

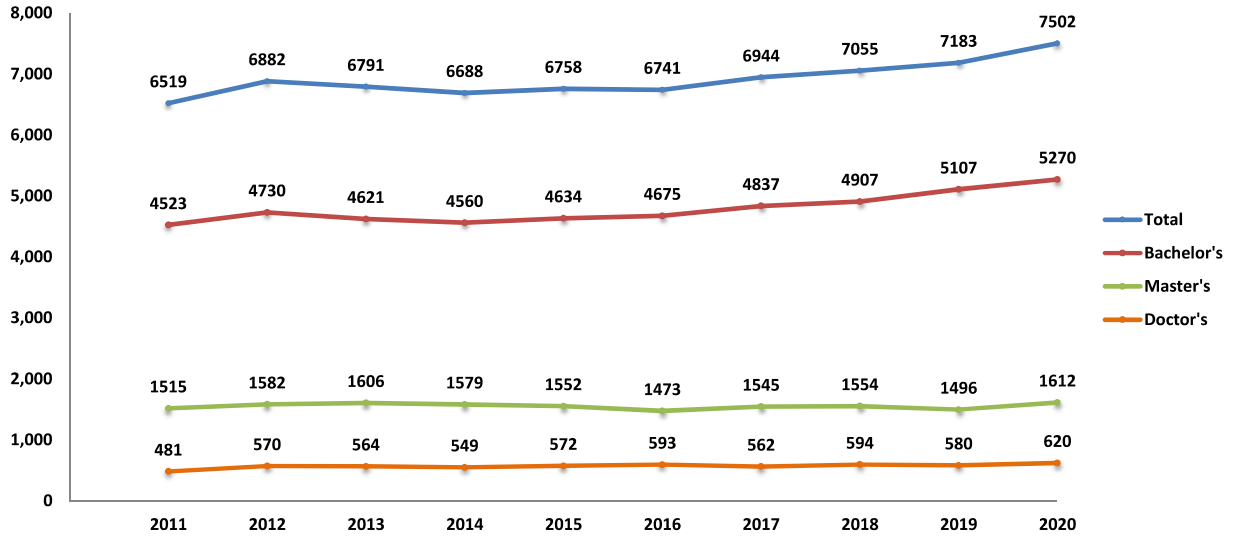

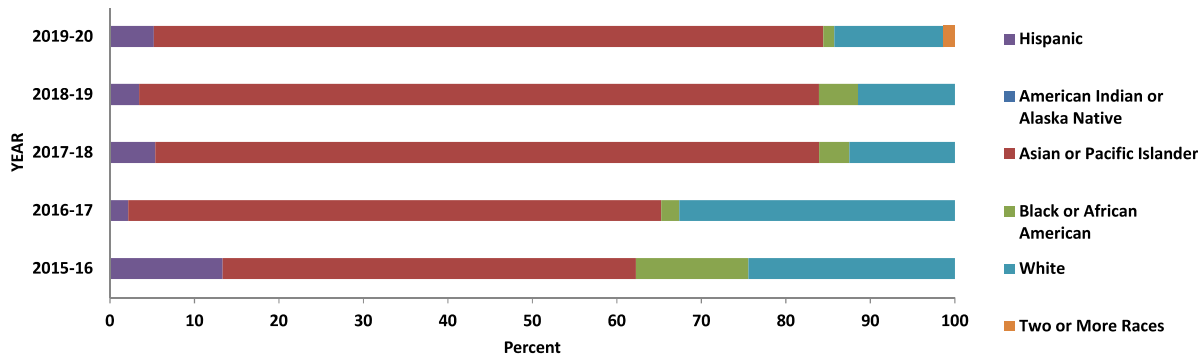

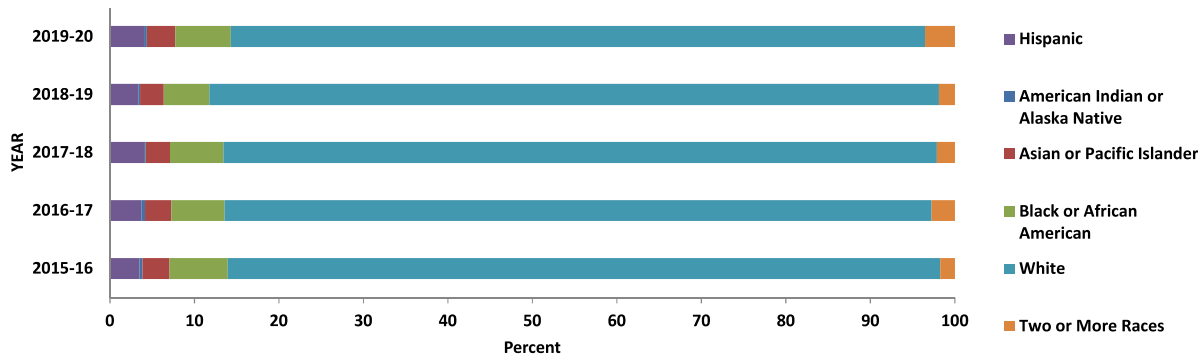

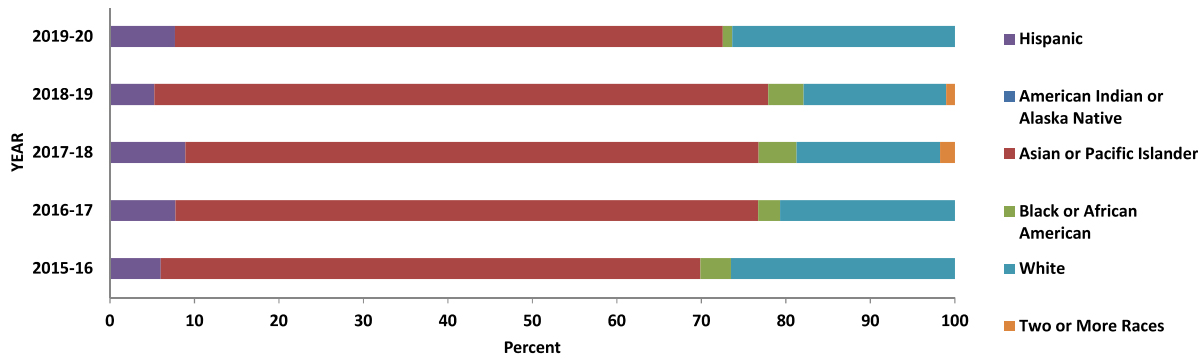

### 5 Year Trend of Master's Degrees of International Enrollment By Race/Ethnicity Academic Year 2015-2019

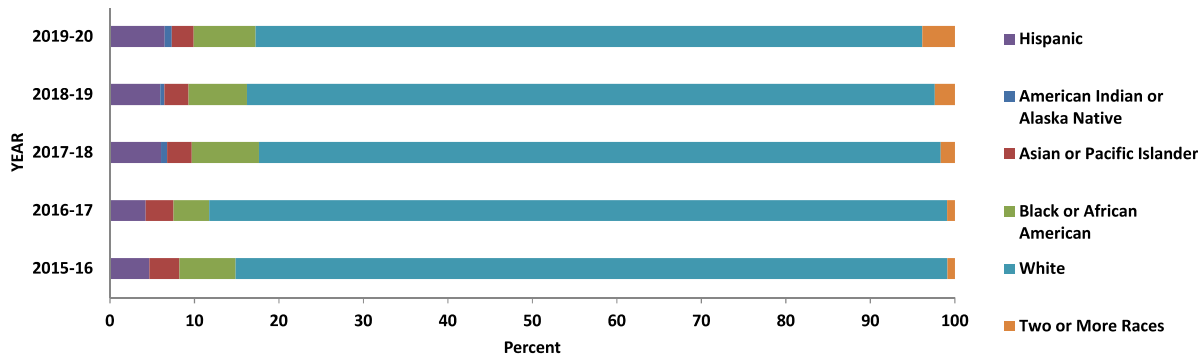

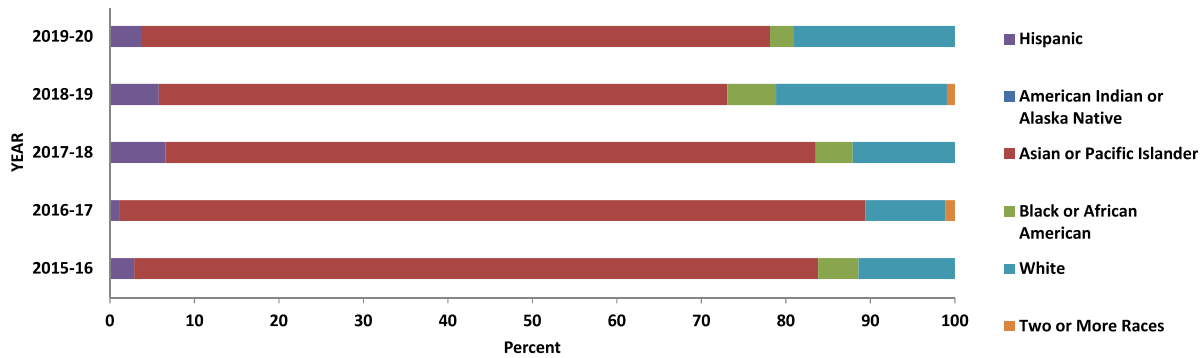
