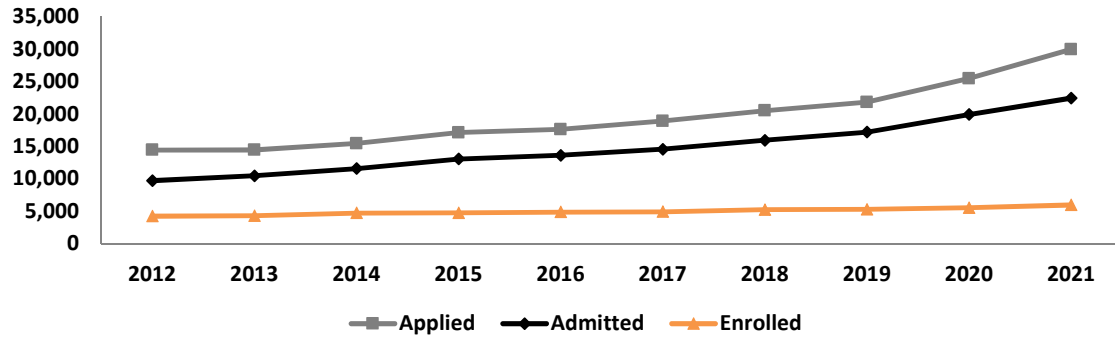

10 Year Trend of First-Time Freshmen Applied, Admitted, and Enrolled Fall 2012-2021



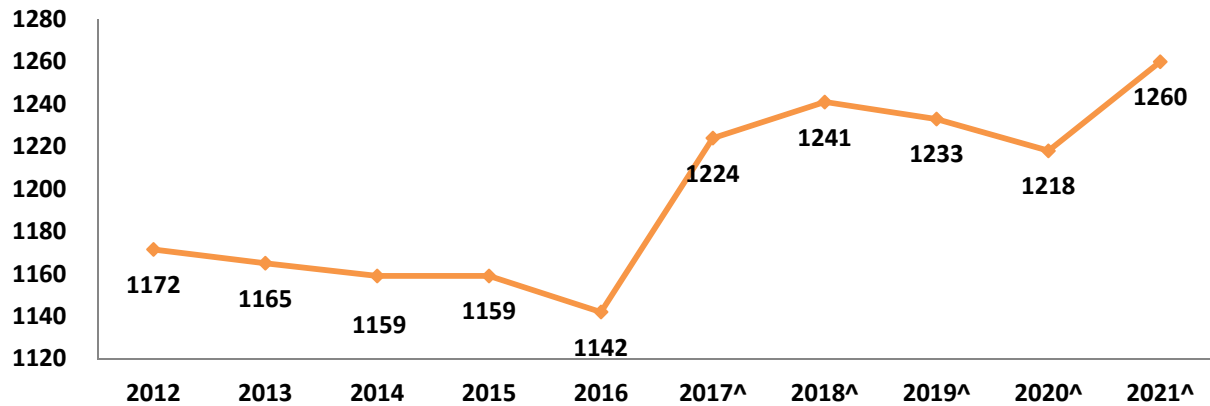

10 Year Trend of First-Time Freshmen Average SAT Scores Fall 2012-2021



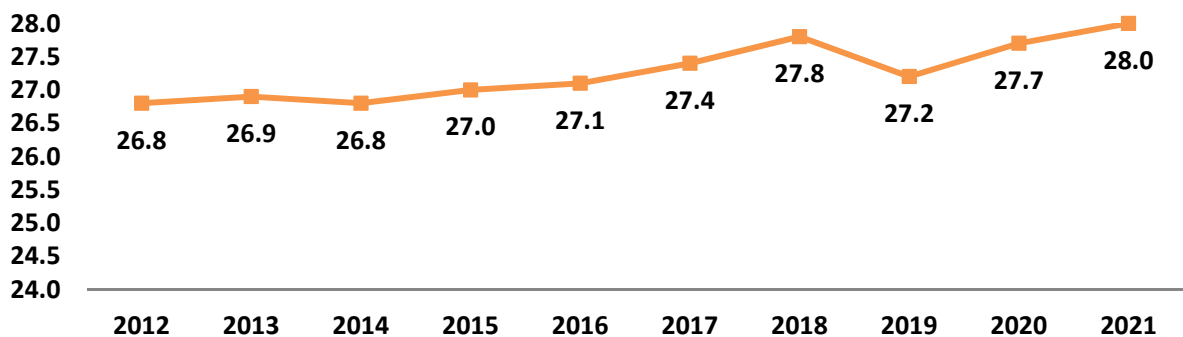

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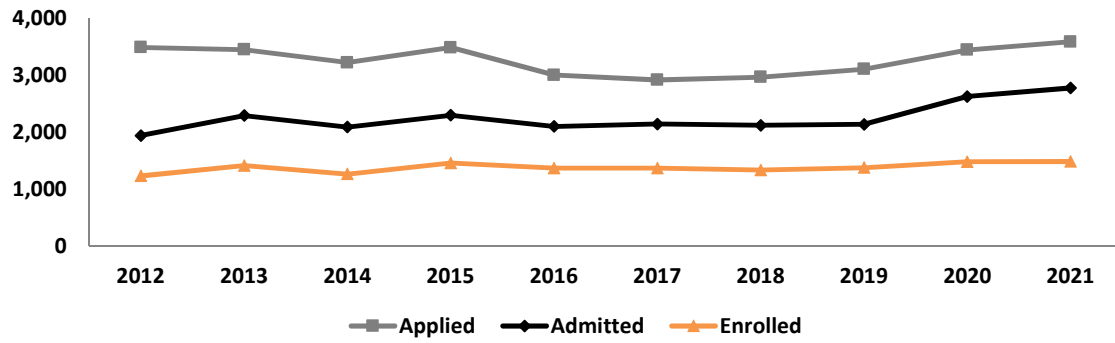

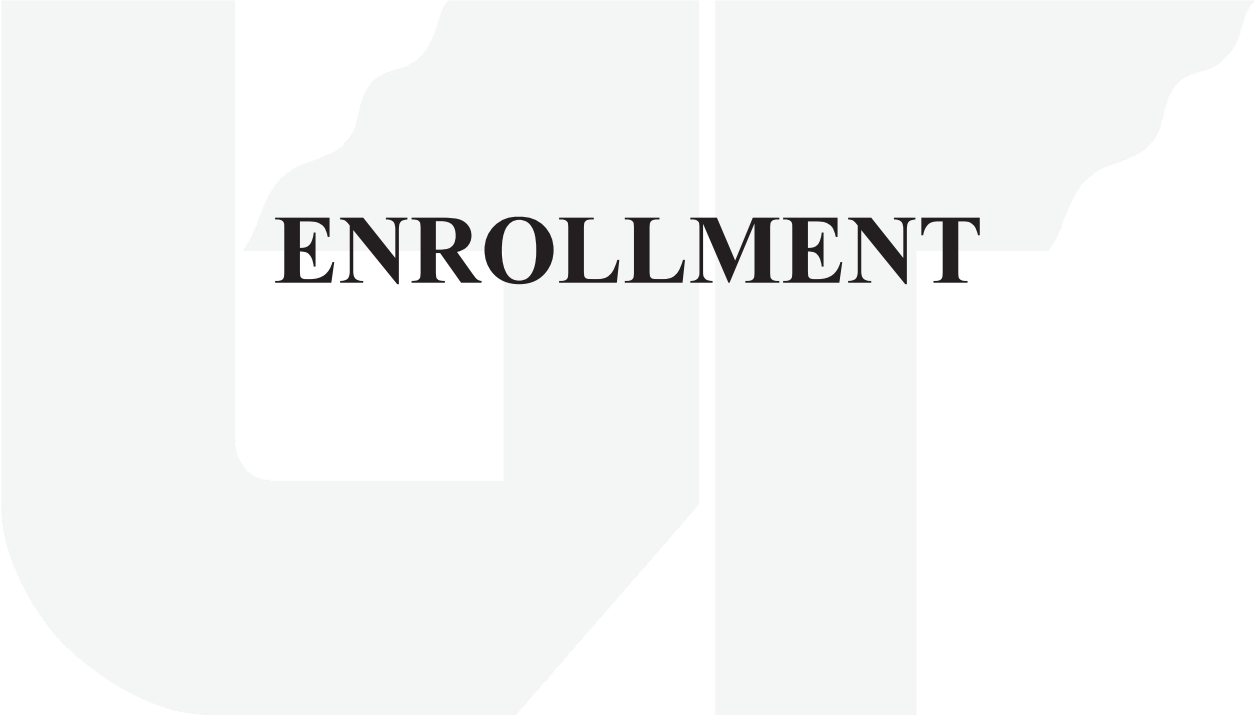

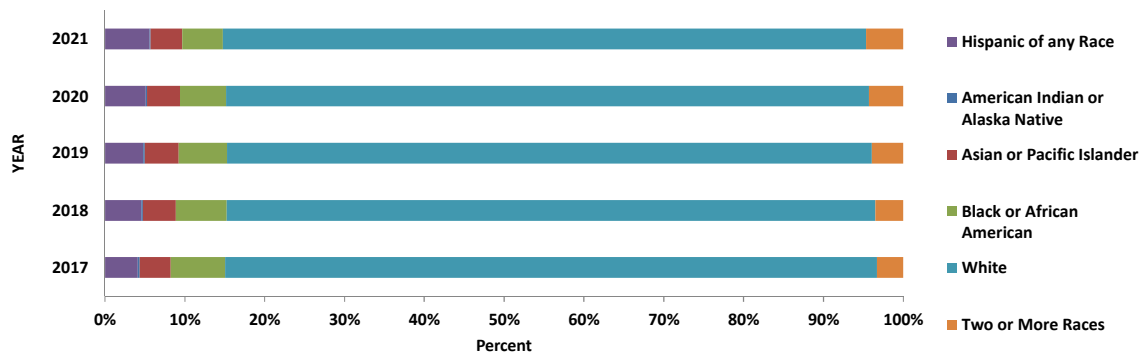

5 Year Trend of Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment By Race/Ethnicity (Excludes International) Fall 2017-2021



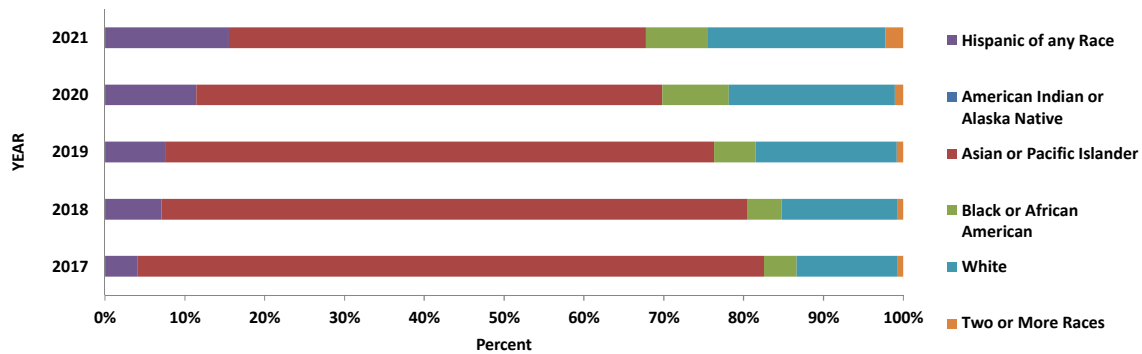

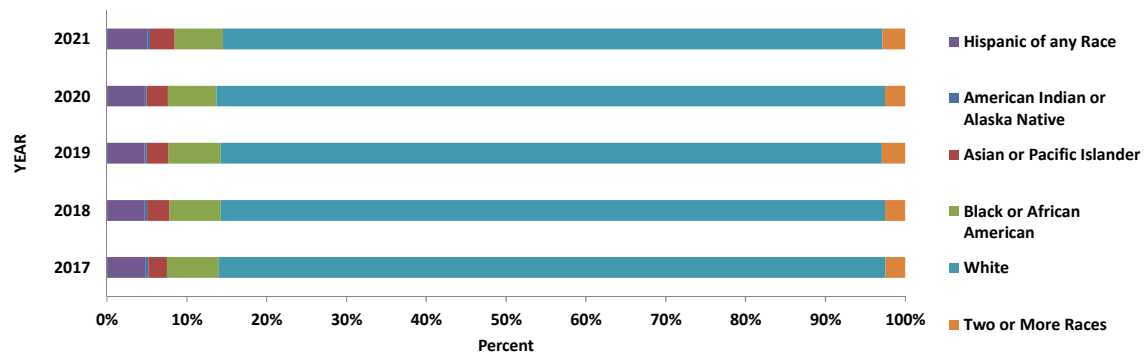

5 Year Trend of Graduate/Professional Headcount Enrollment By Race/Ethnicity (Excludes International) Fall 2017-2021



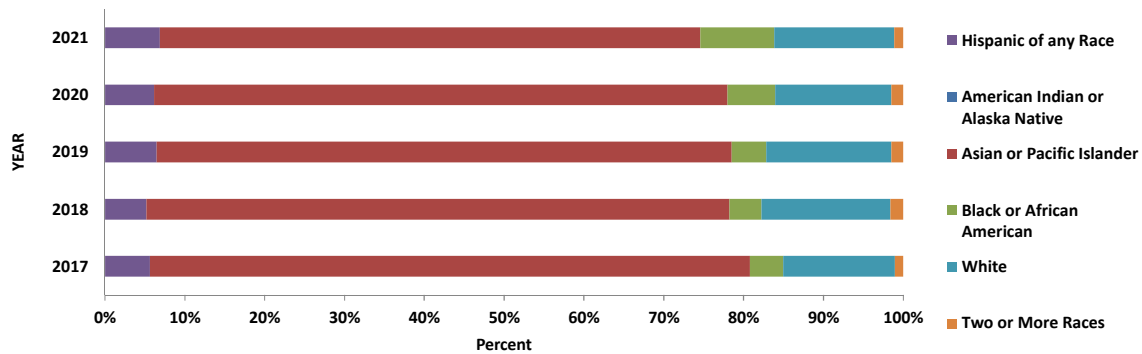

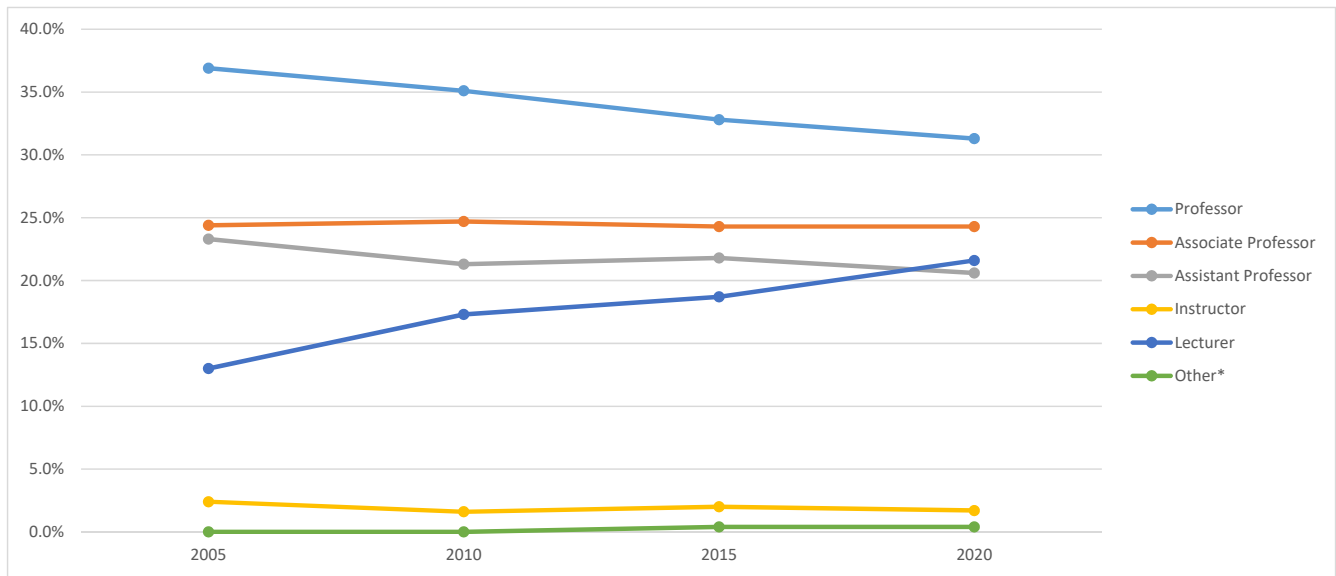

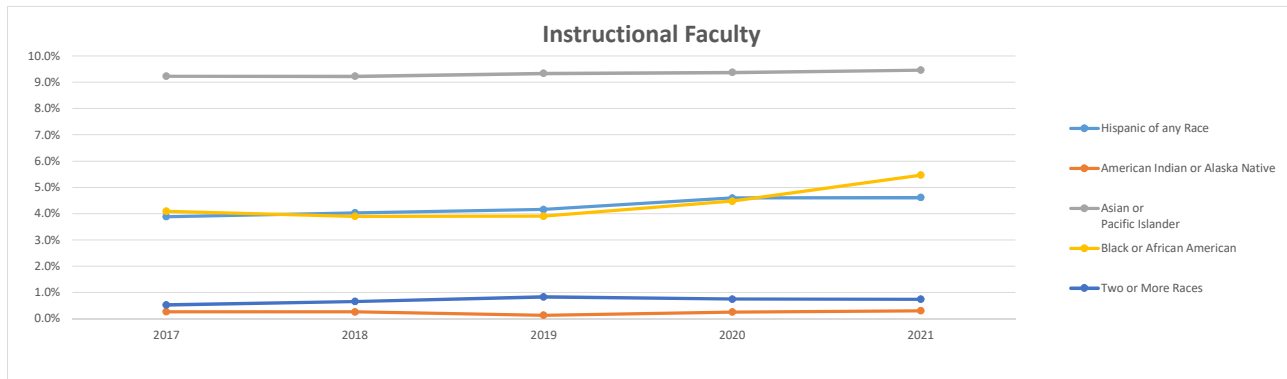

5 Year Trend of Full-time Instructional Faculty By Race/Ethnicity (Excludes International) Fall 2017-2021



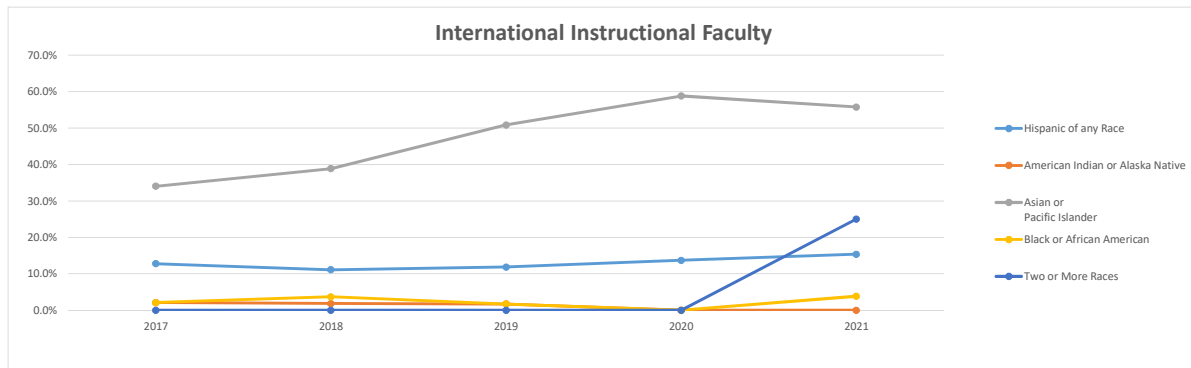

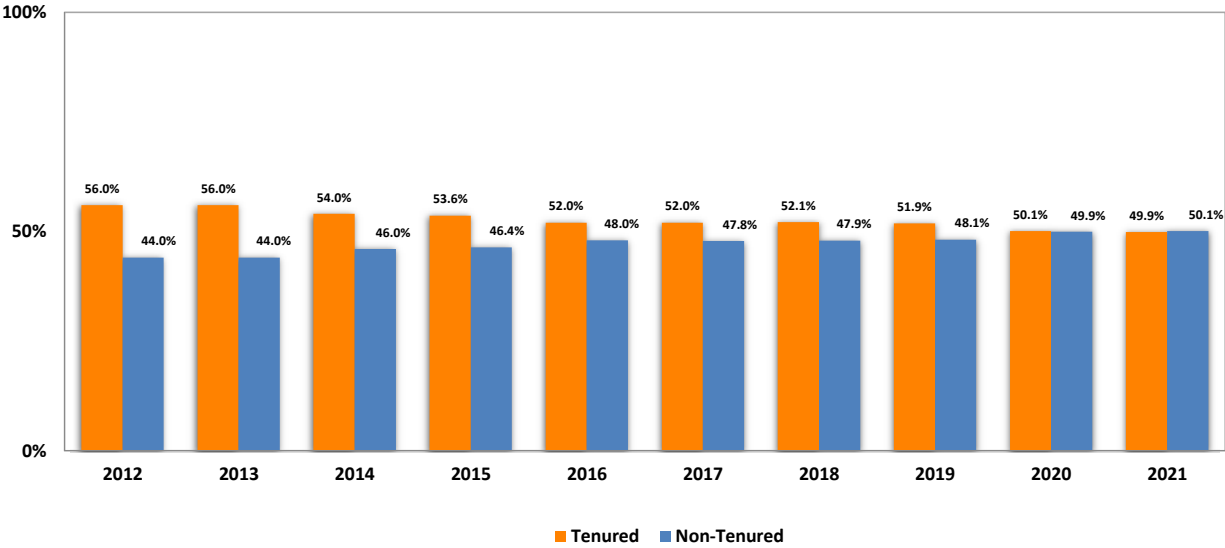

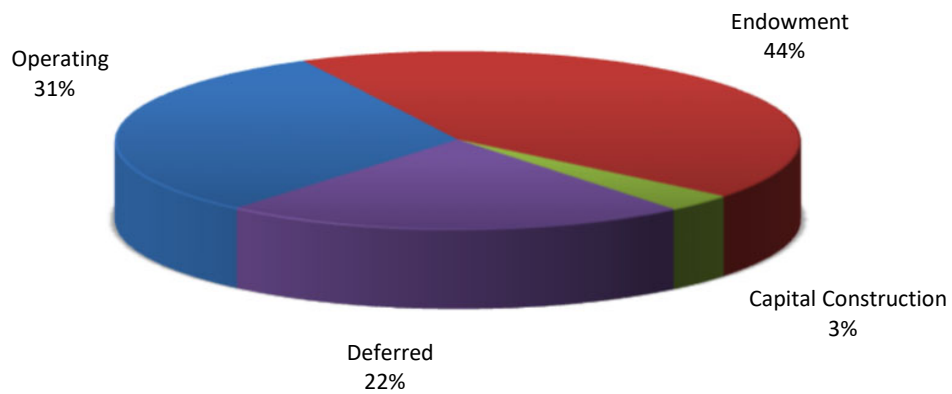


UT Knoxville Analysis by Purpose

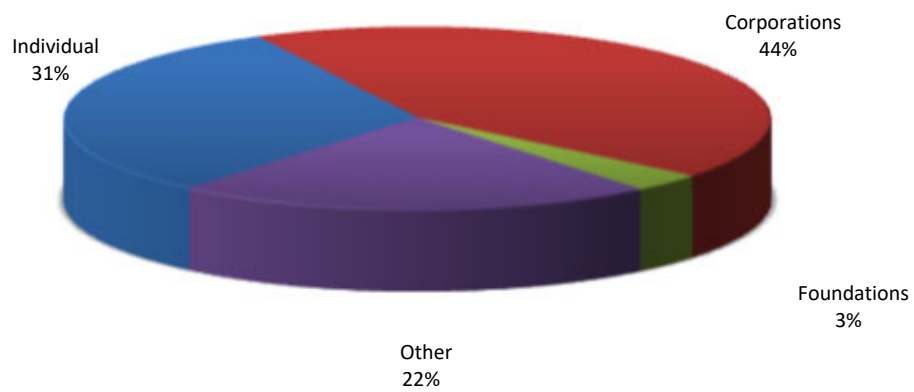

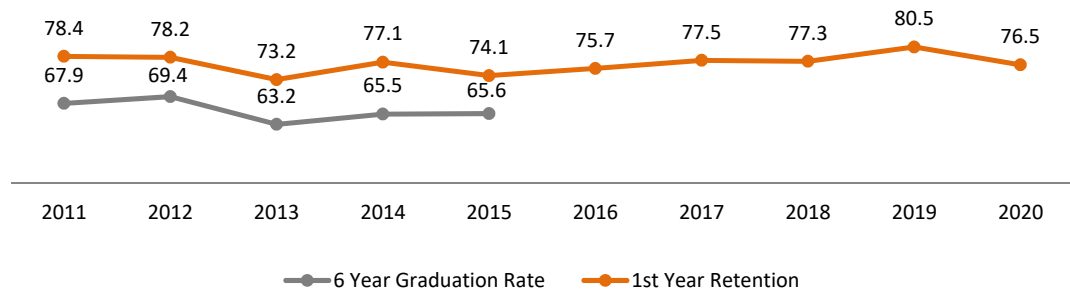

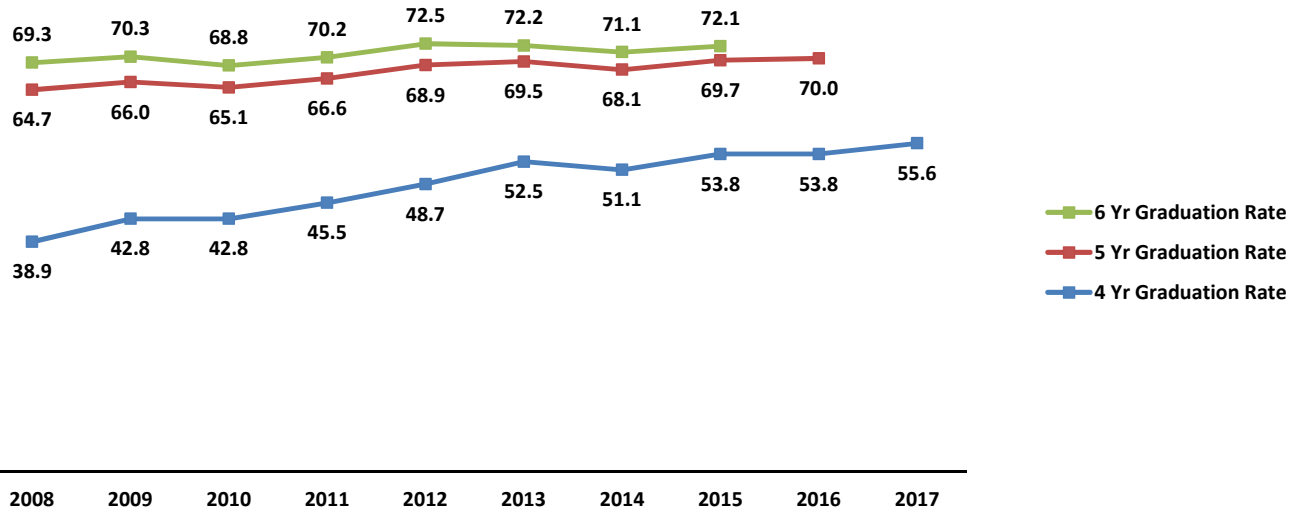

10 Year Trend of Retention and Graduation Rates First-time Transfer Students Fall Cohorts 2011-2020

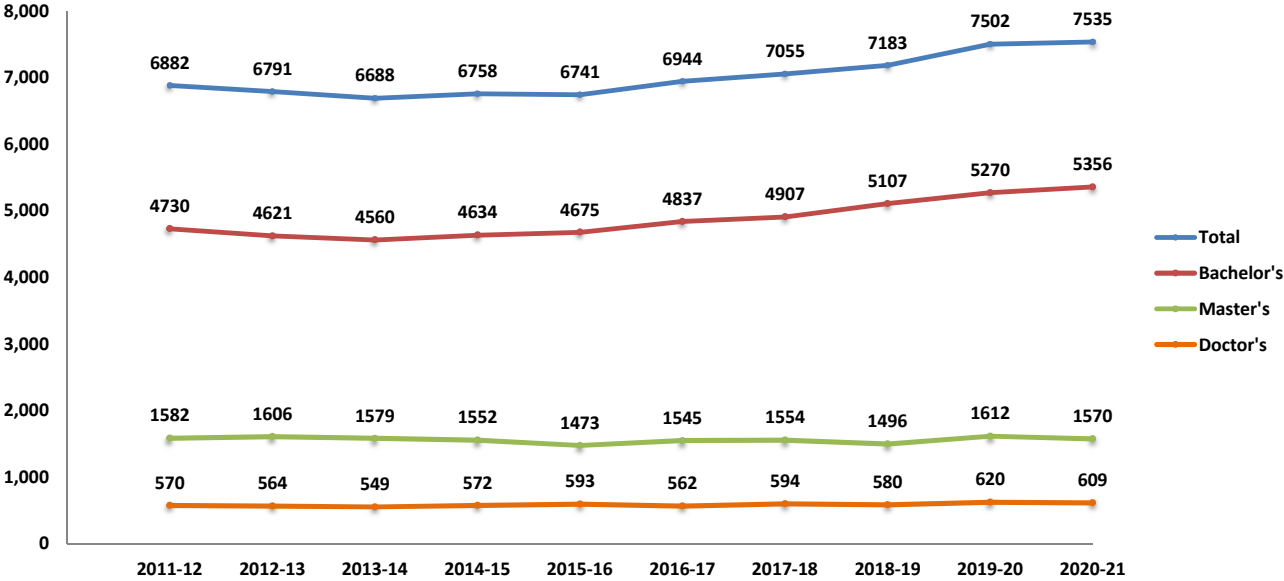

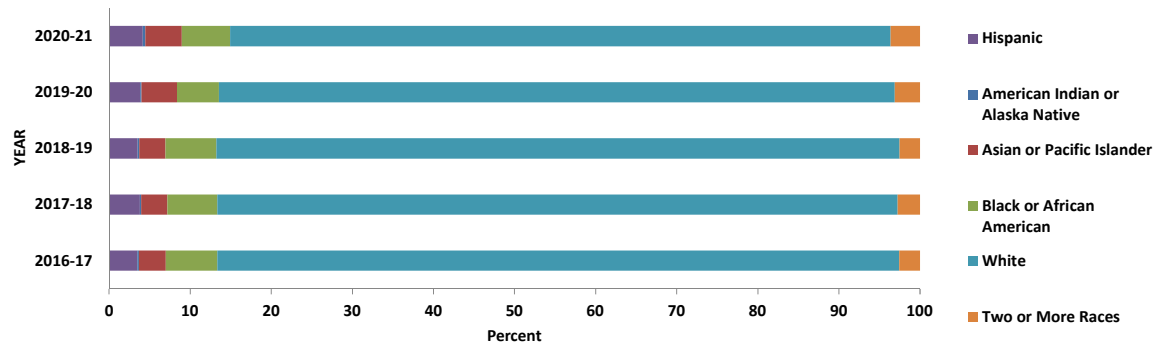

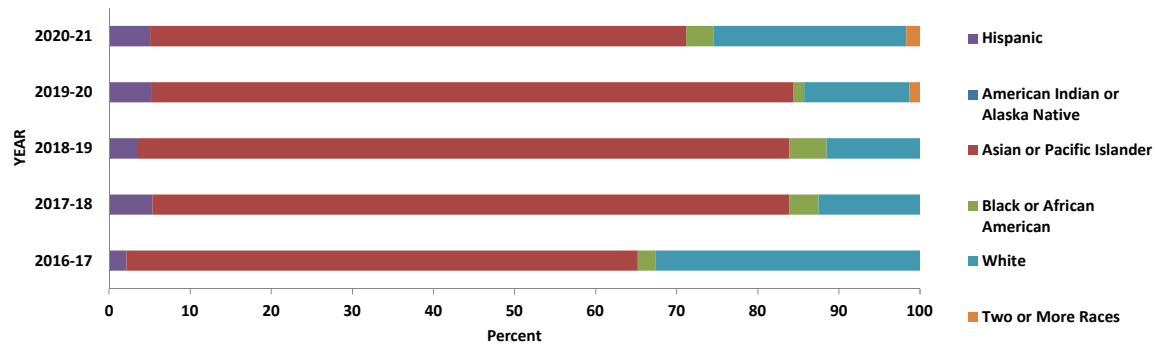
5 Year Trend of Bachelor's Degrees By Race/Ethnicity (Excludes International) Academic Year 2016-2020

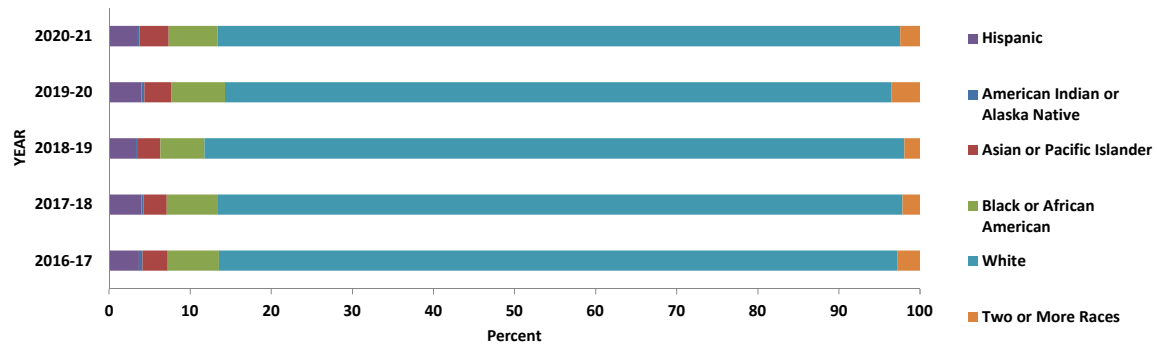
5 Year Trend of Bachelor's Degrees of International Enrollment By Race/Ethnicity Academic Year 2016-2020

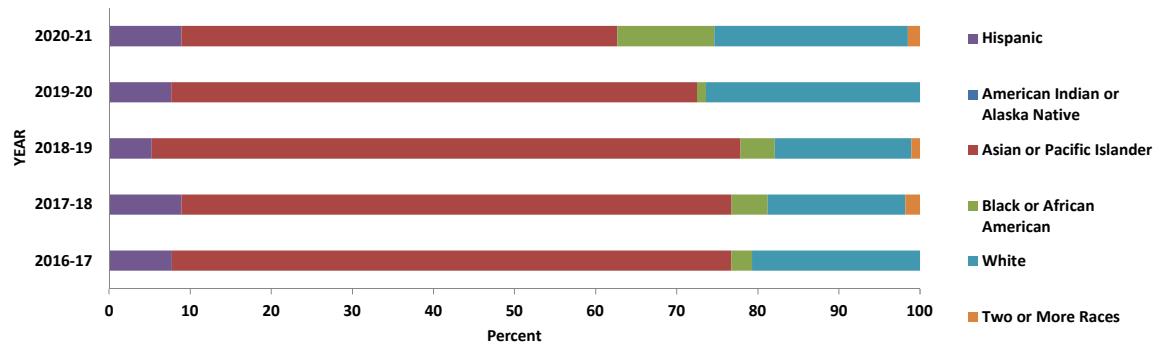

5 Year Trend of Master's Degrees of International Enrollment By Race/Ethnicity Academic Year 2016-2020

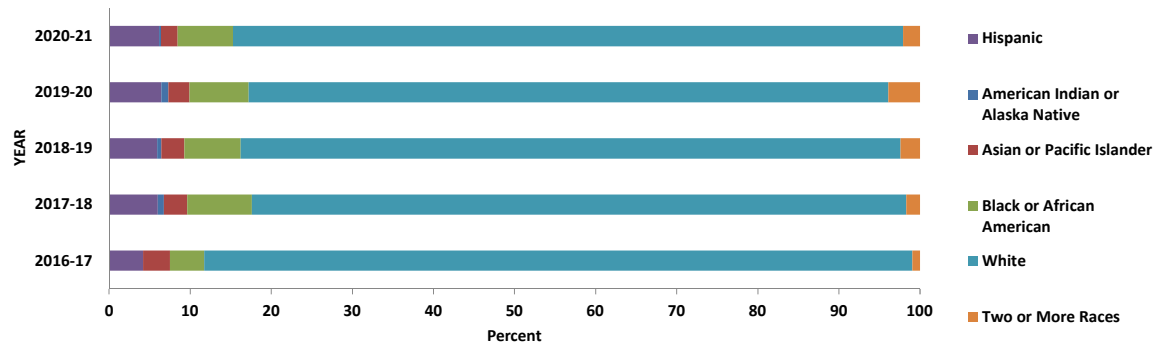

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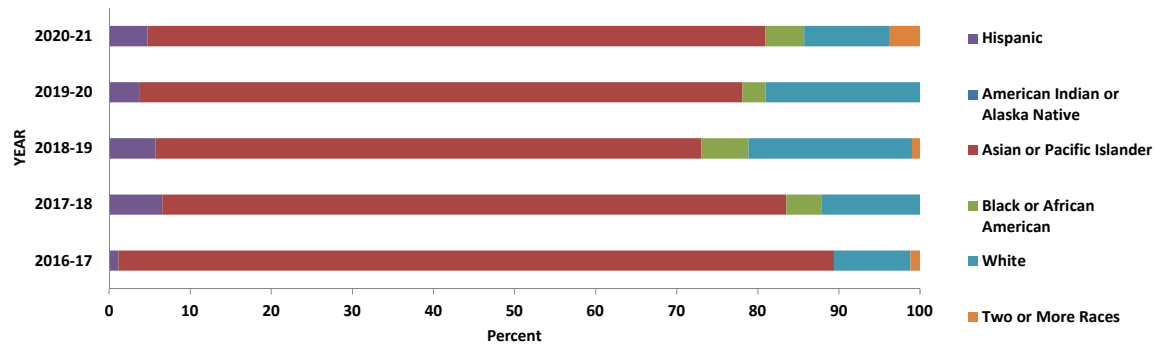
5 Year Trend of Doctor's Degrees By Race/Ethnicity (Excludes International) Academic Year 2016-2020
