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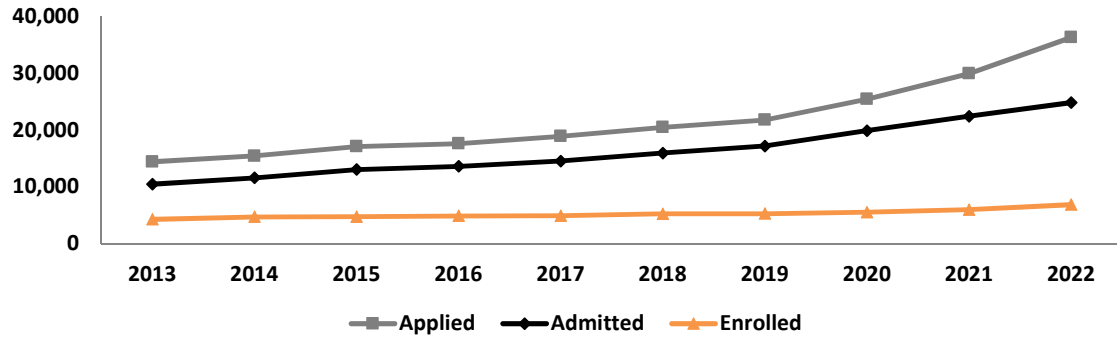

10 Year Trend of First-Time Freshmen Applied, Admitted, and Enrolled Fall 2013-2022



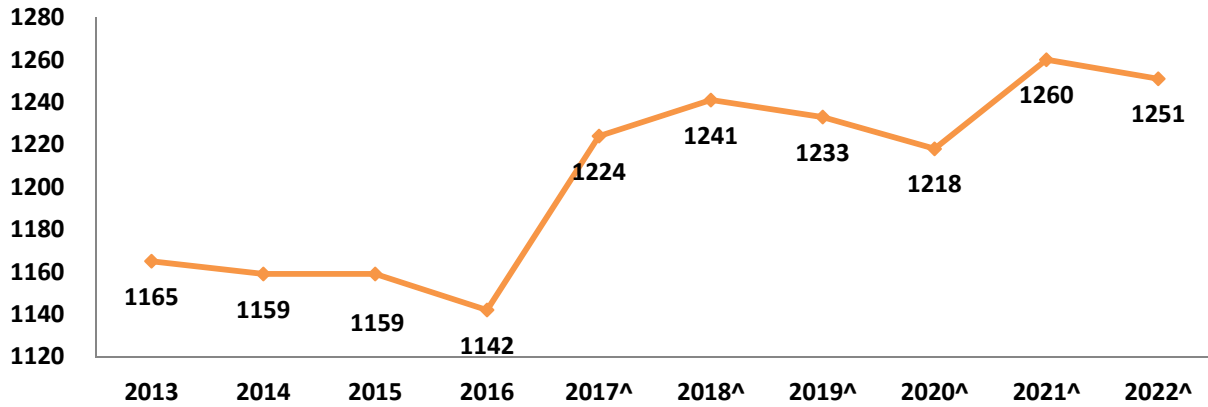

10 Year Trend of First-Time Freshmen Average SAT Scores Fall 2013-2022



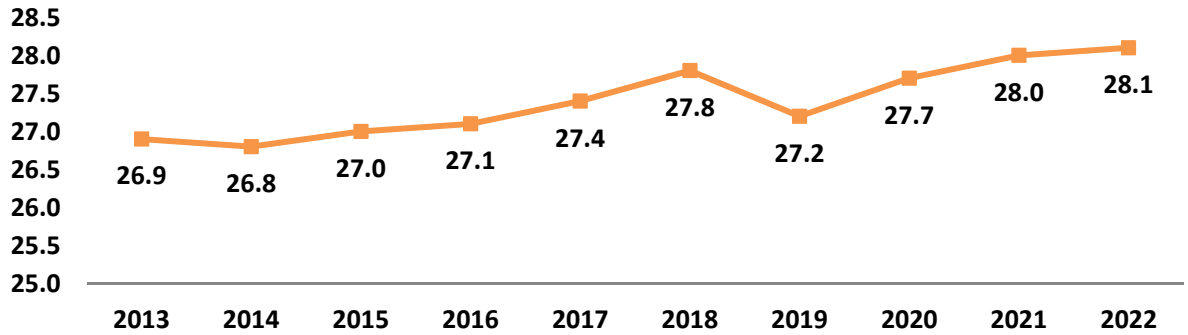

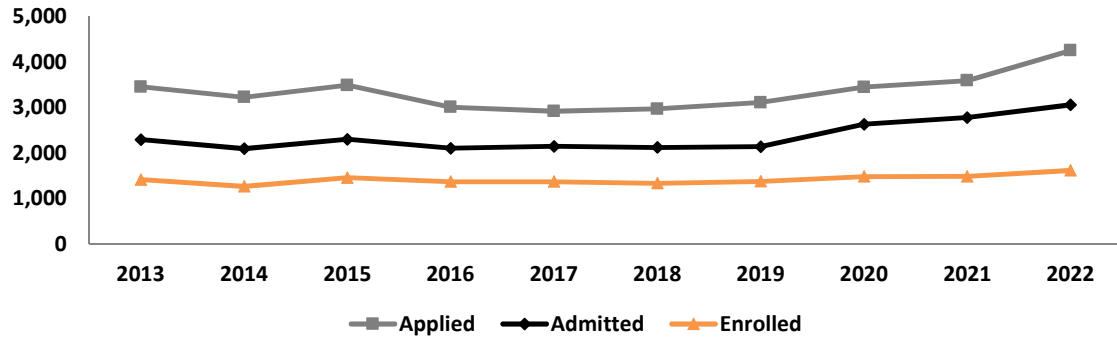

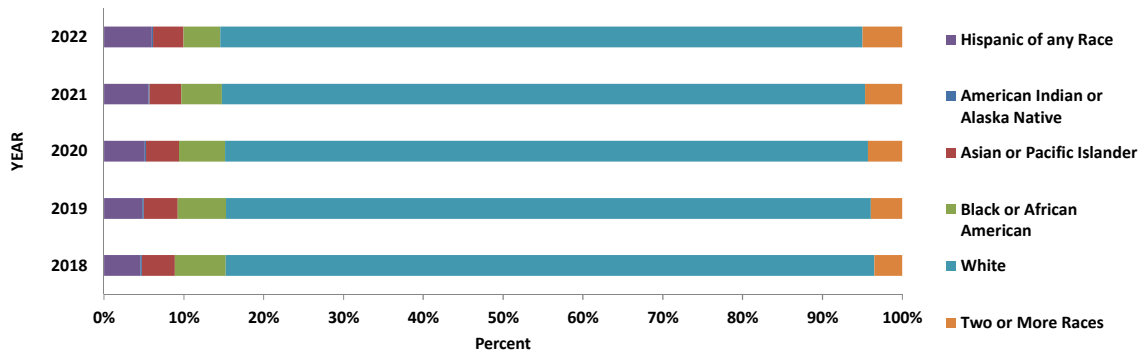

5 Year Trend of Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment By Race/Ethnicity (Excludes International) Fall 2018-2022

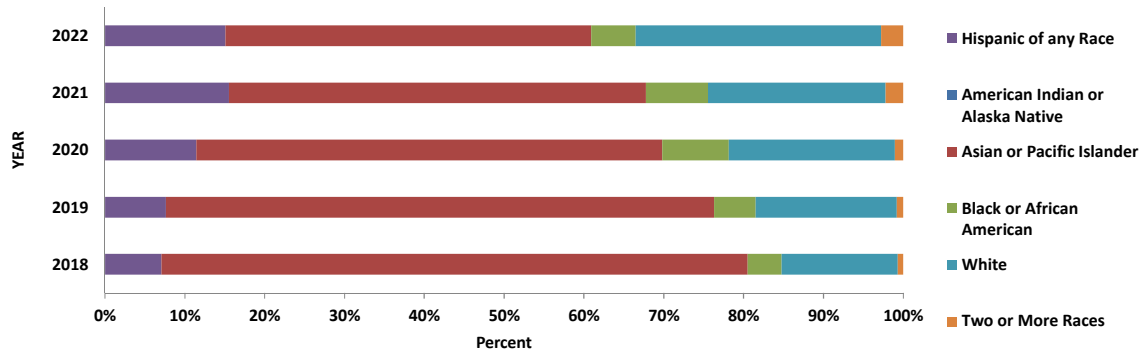

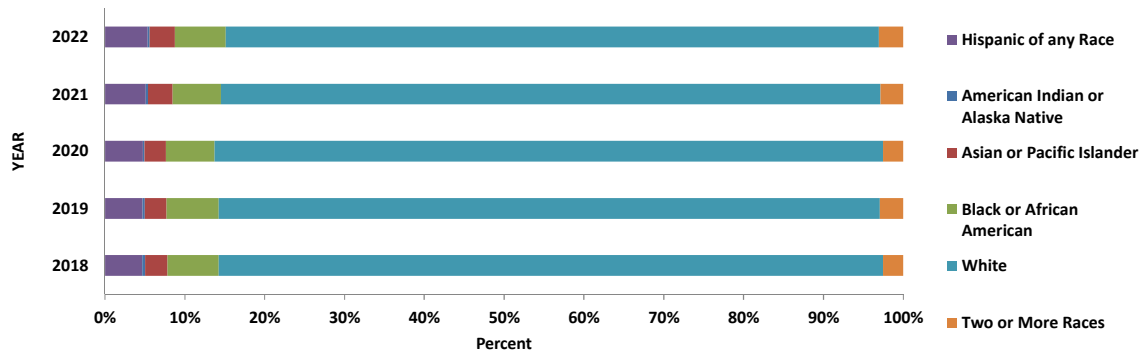

5 Year Trend of Graduate/Professional Headcount Enrollment By Race/Ethnicity (Excludes International) Fall 2018-2022

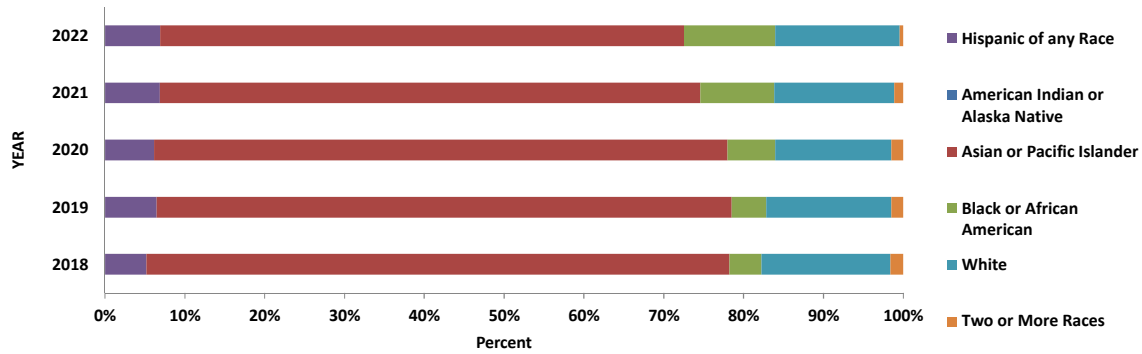

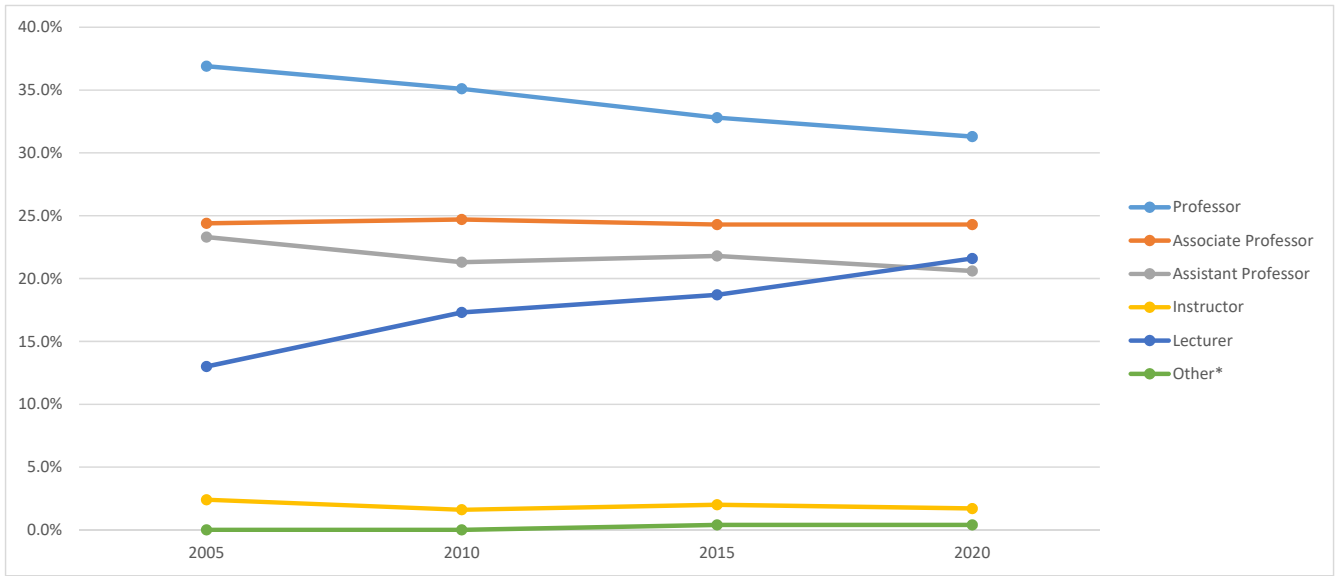

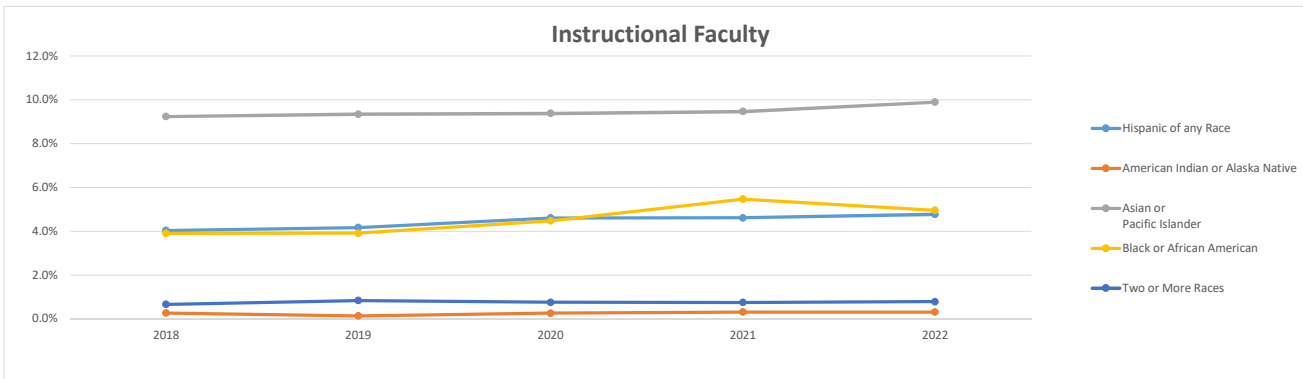

5 Year Trend of Full-time Instructional Faculty By Race/Ethnicity (Excludes International) Fall 2018-2022



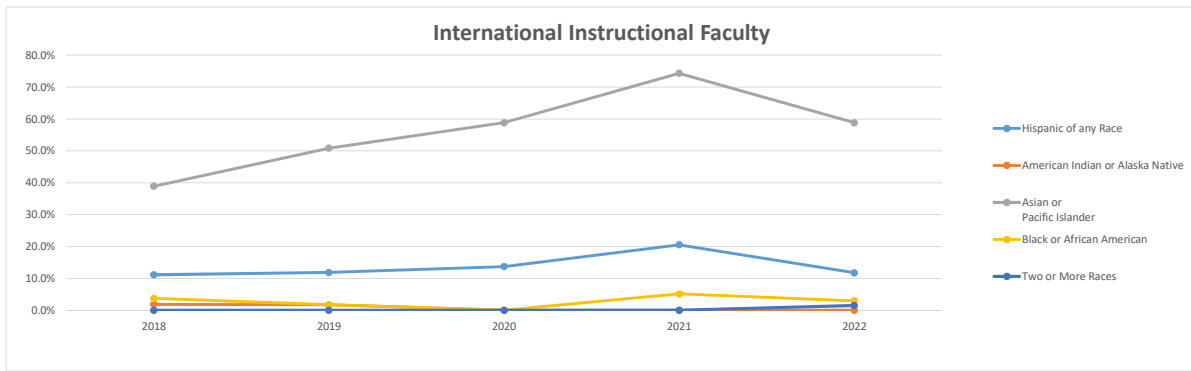

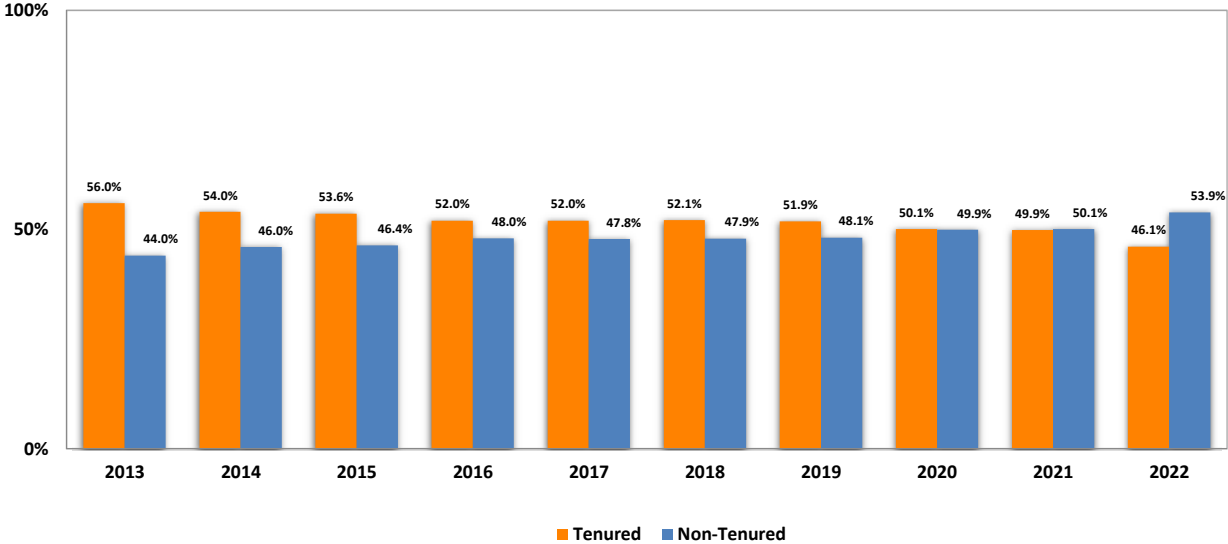

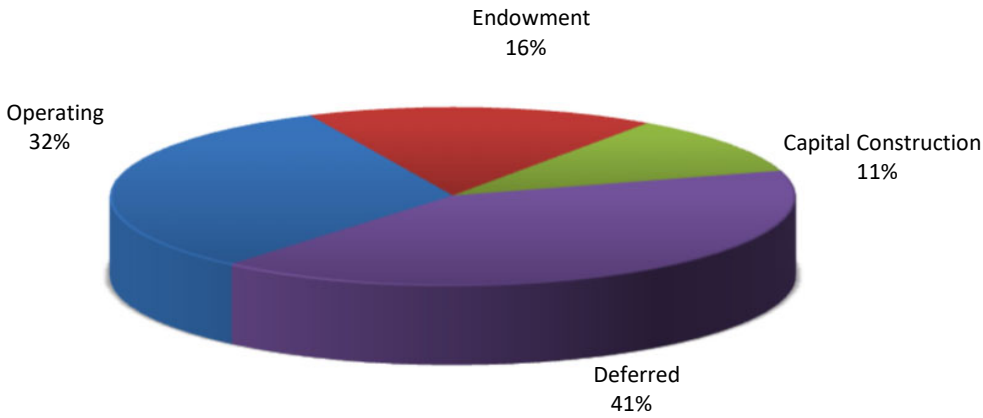


UT Knoxville Analysis by Purpose

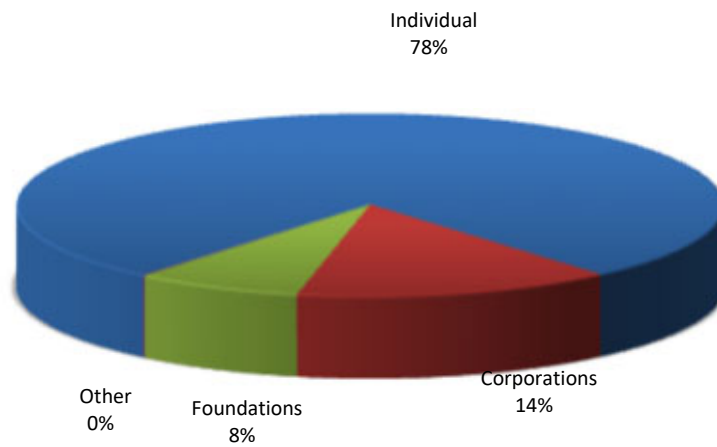


UT Knoxville Analysis By Source

Second Fall Continuation Rates of First Time, Full Time Freshman by Race/ Ethnicity and Gender for Fall Cohorts 2012-2021

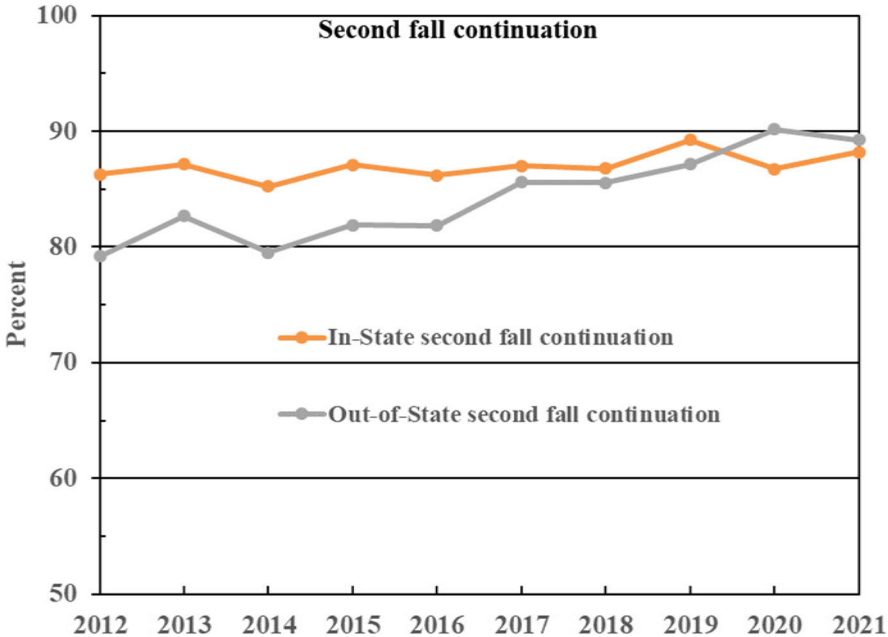


Graduation within six years for First Time, Full Time Freshman by Race/Ethnicity and Gender for Fall Cohorts 2012-2016.

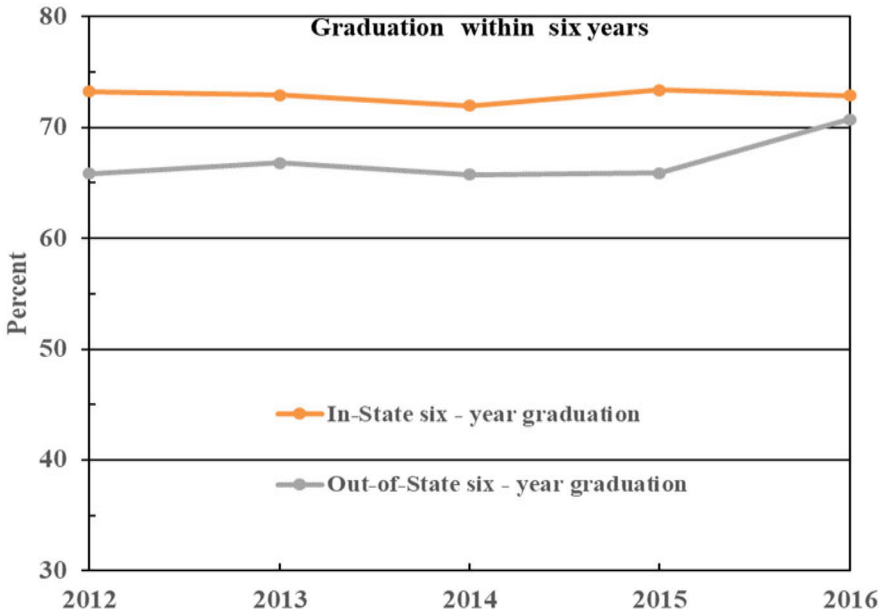


Full Time, First Time Freshman Retention and Graduation by Residence

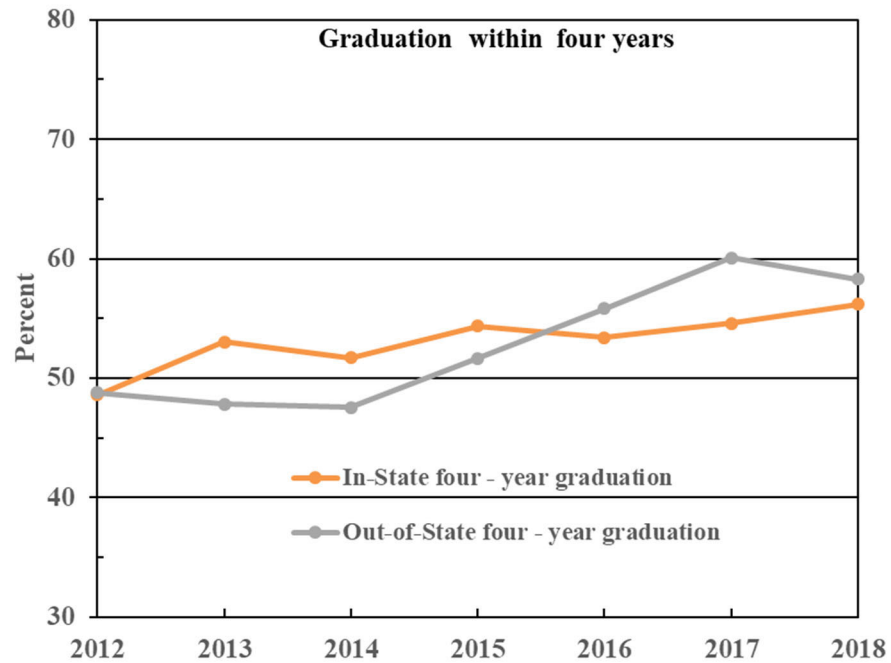
Second fall continuation by residency for first-time full-time freshman, fall cohorts 2012-2021.



Graduation within six and four years by residency for first-time full-time freshman, fall cohorts 2012-2021.

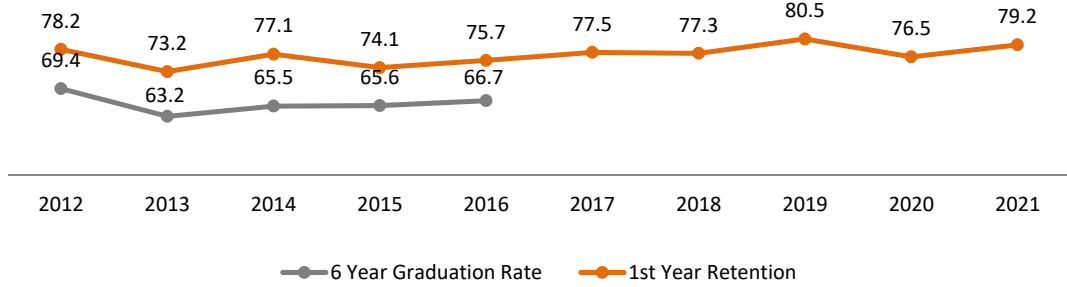


Full Time, First Time Freshman Retention and Graduation by Residence



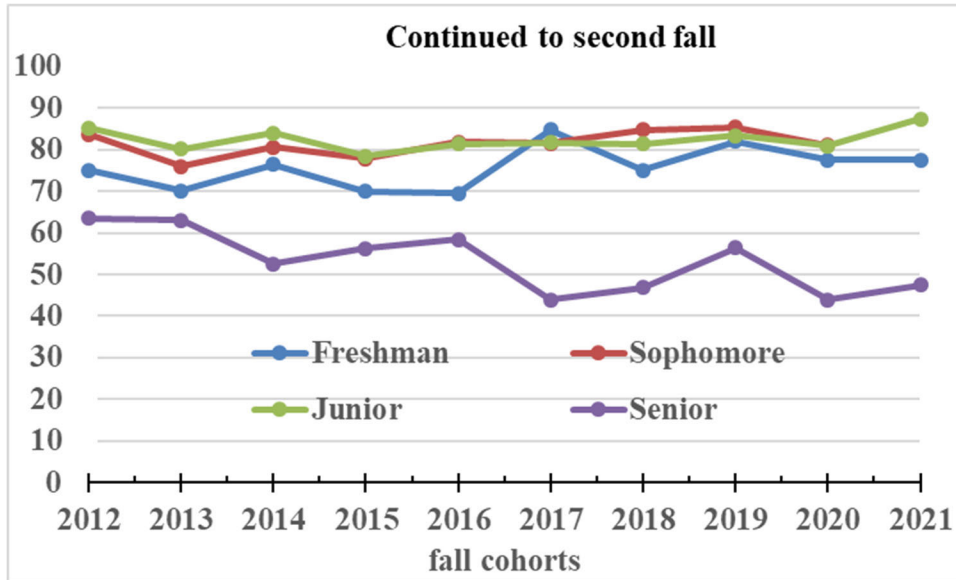

10 Year Trend of Retention and Graduation Rates First-time Transfer Students Fall Cohorts 2012-2021

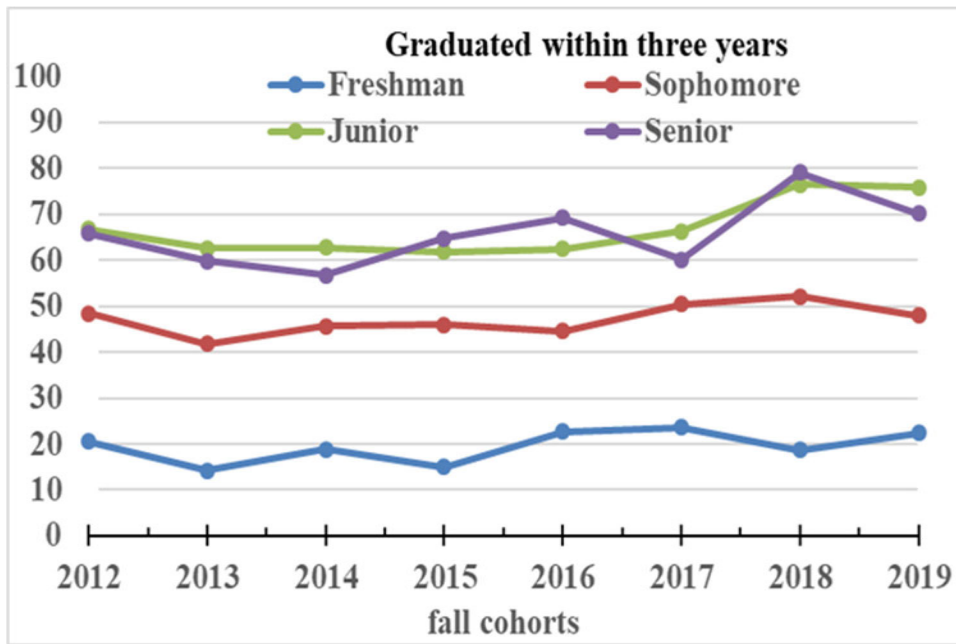


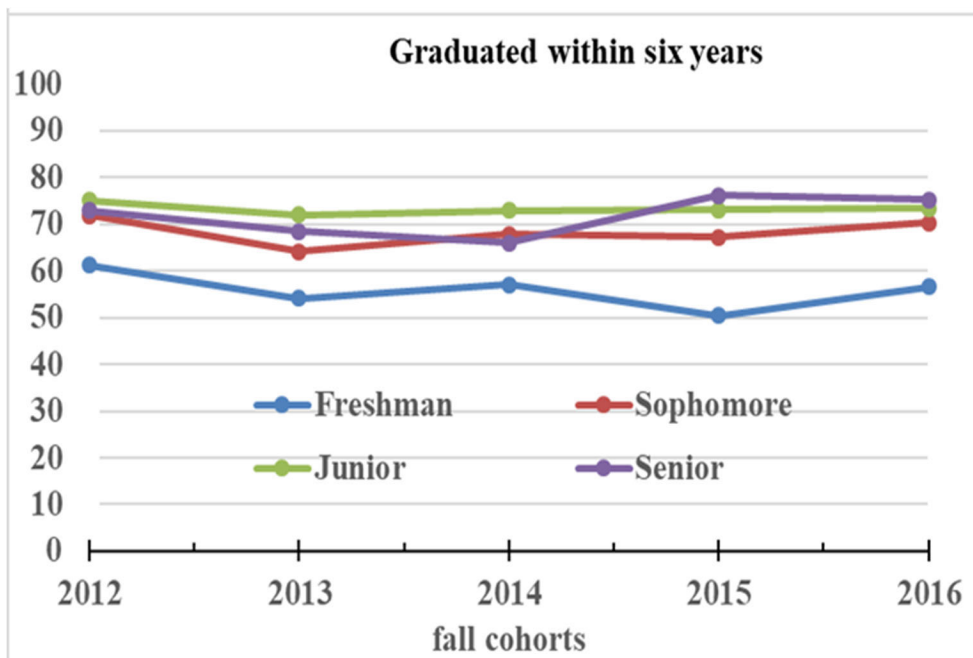
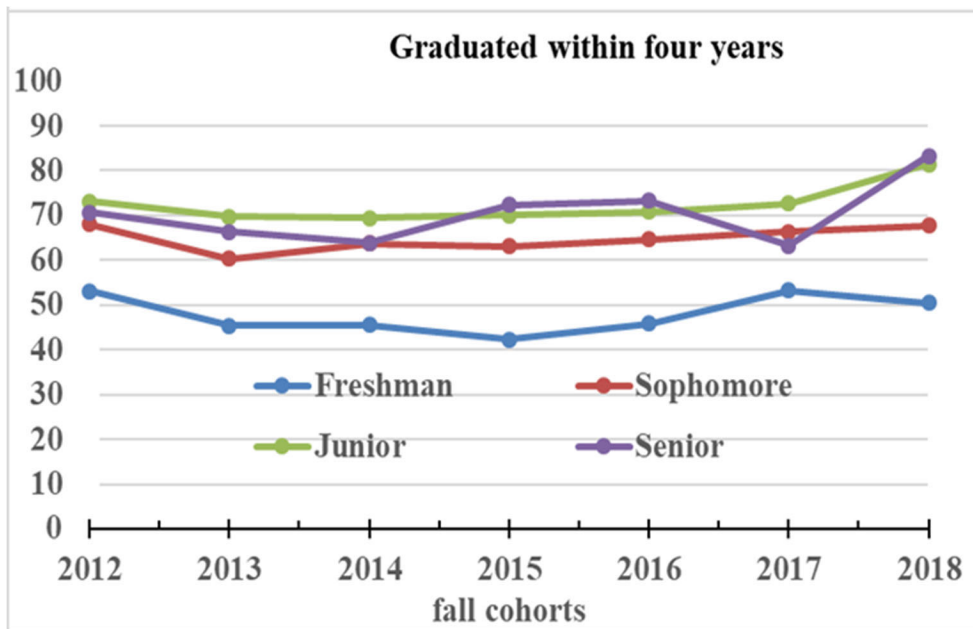

First Time, Full Time Transfer continuation to second fall by Student Level, fall cohorts 2012-2019.

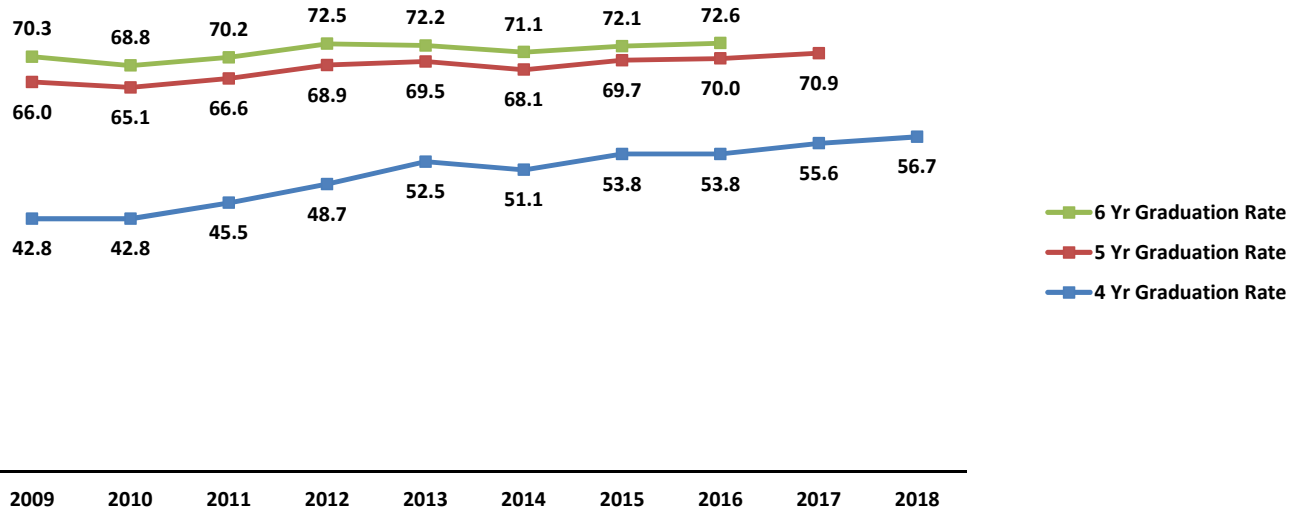


First Time, Full Time Transfer Graduation by Student Level, fall cohorts 2012-2019

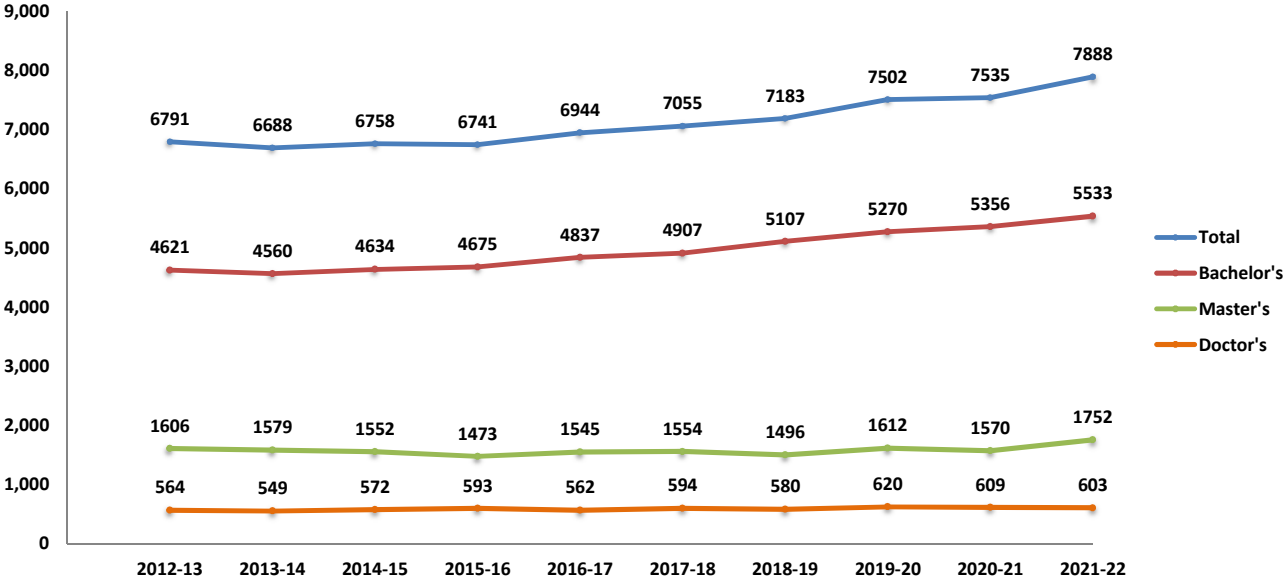




10 Year Trend of Fall Term Graduation Rates First-Time Full-Time Freshman

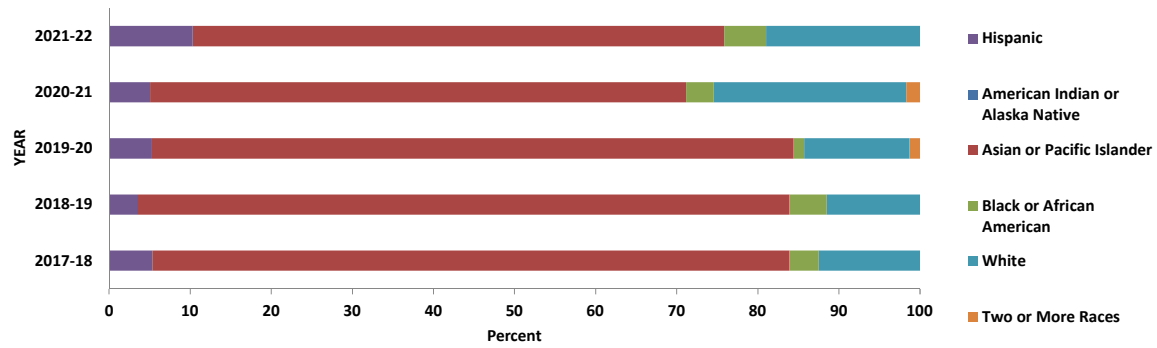

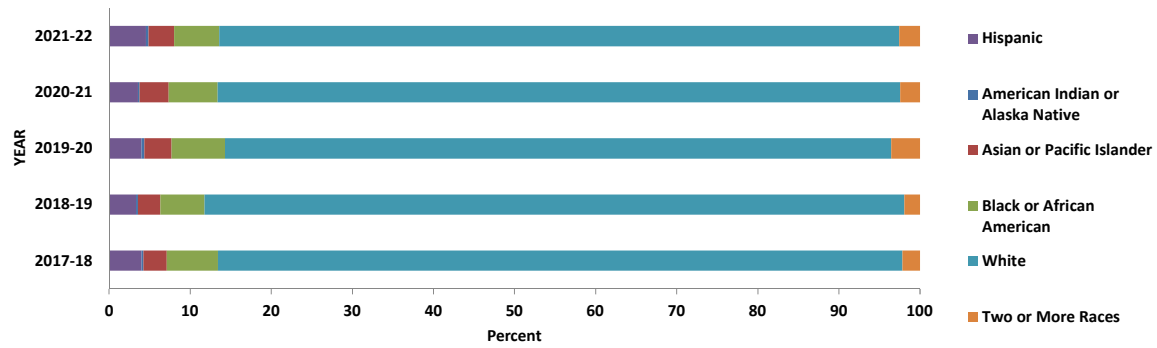

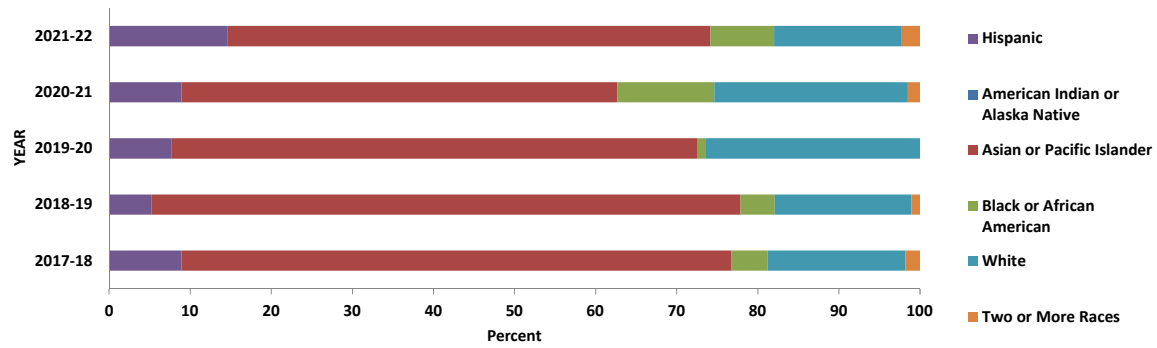

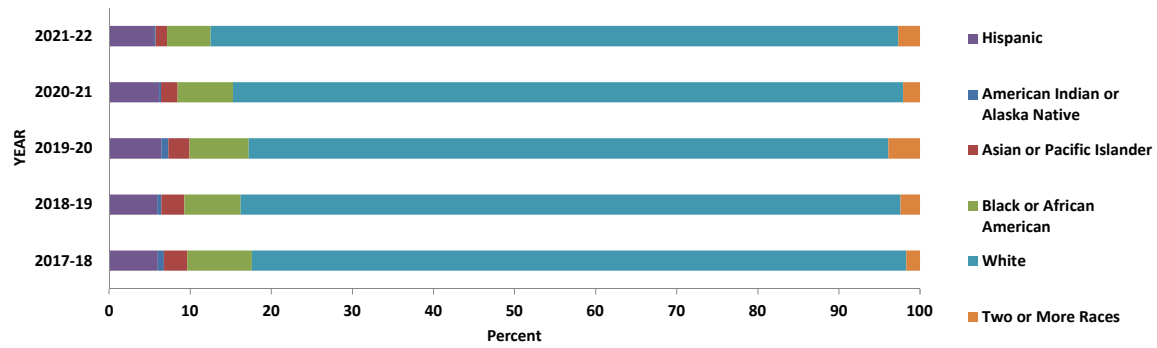

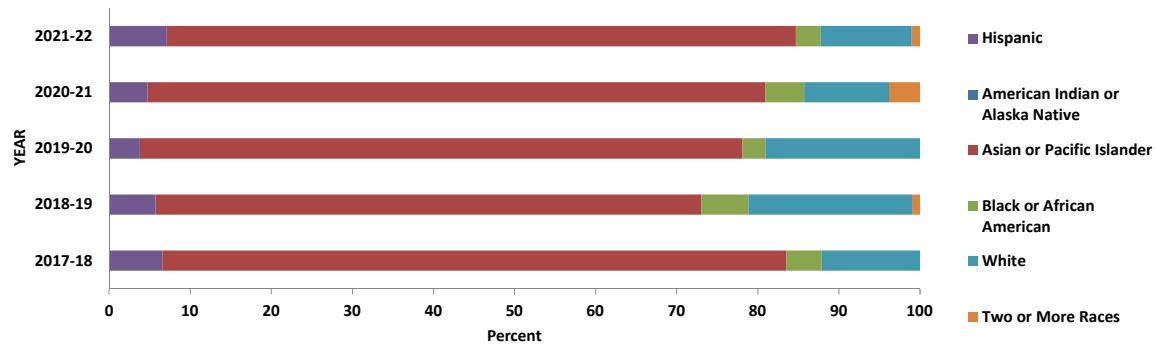
