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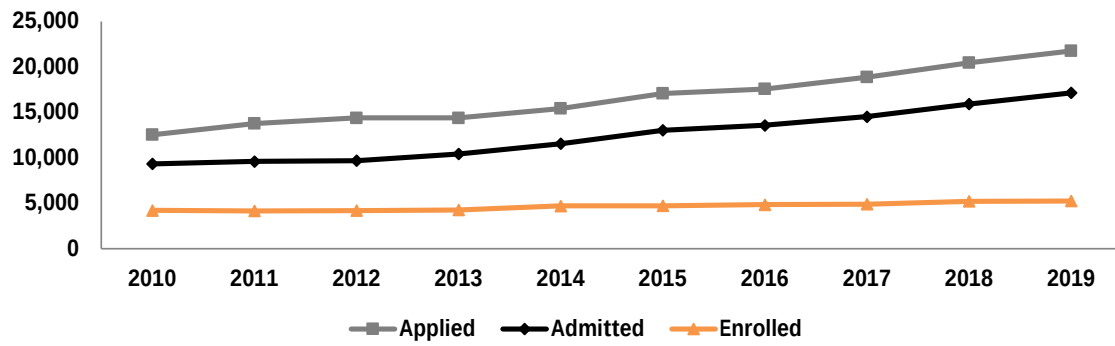
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10 Year Trend of First-Time Freshmen Applied, Admitted, and Enrolled Fall 2010-2019

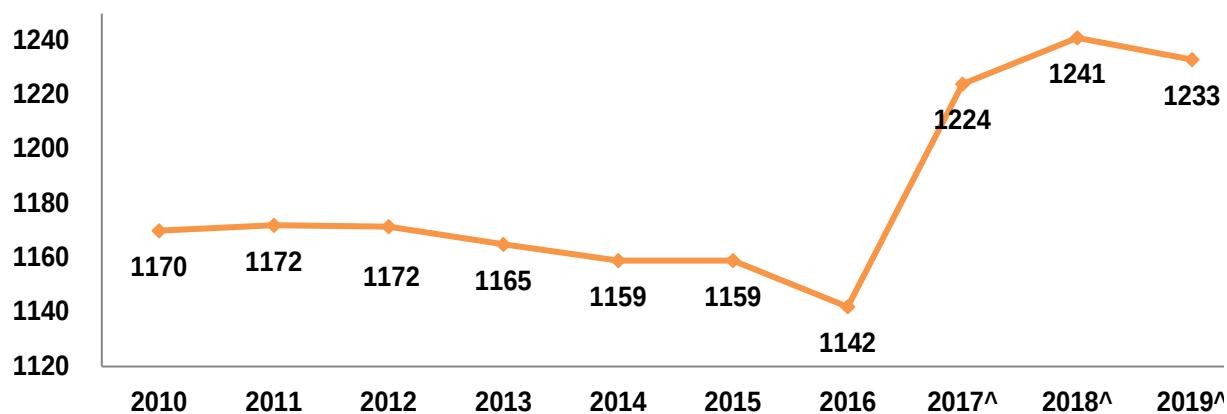

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10 Year Trend of First-Time Freshmen Average SAT Scores Fall 2010-2019



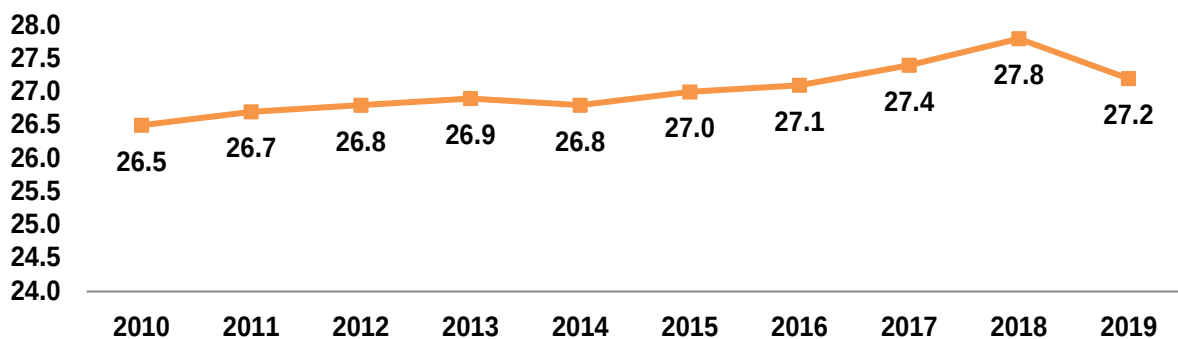

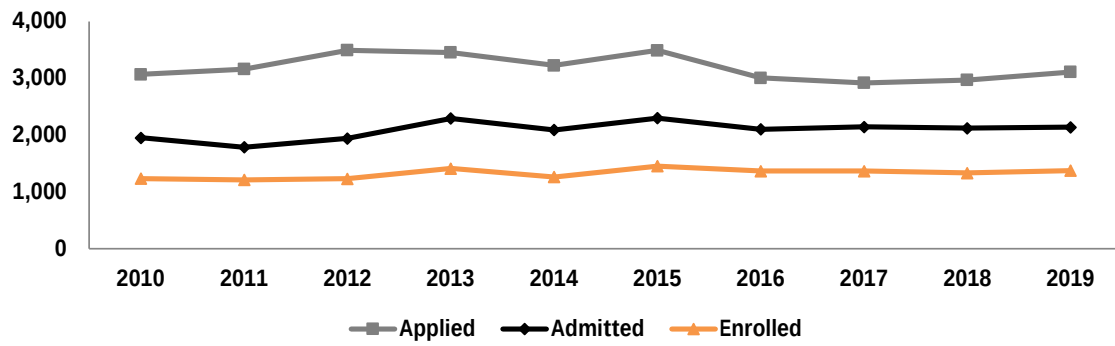

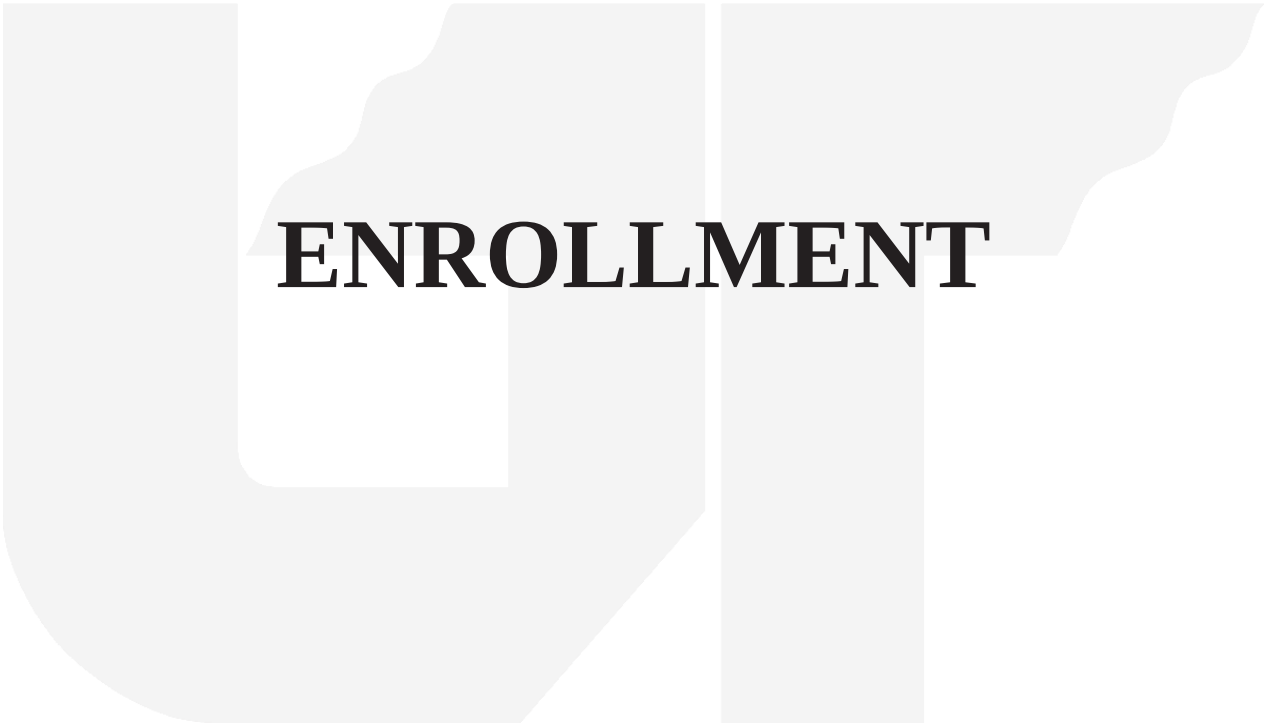

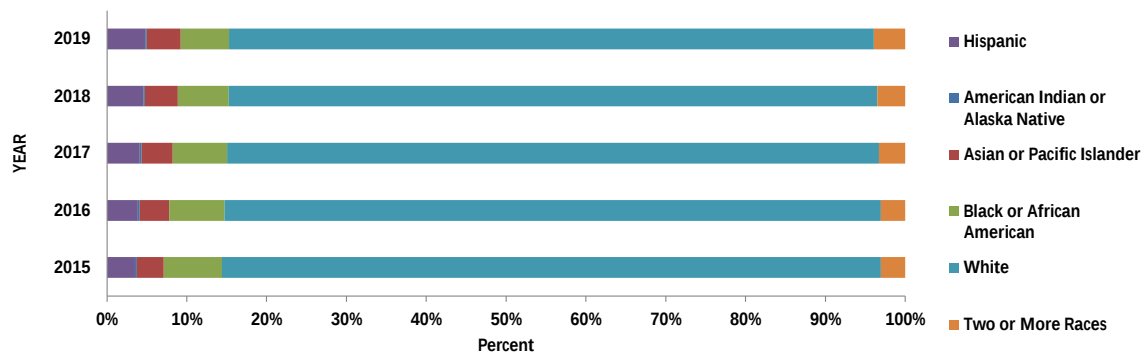

5 Year Trend of Undergraduate Headcount Enrollment By Race/Ethnicity (Excludes Nonresident Aliens) Fall 2015-2019

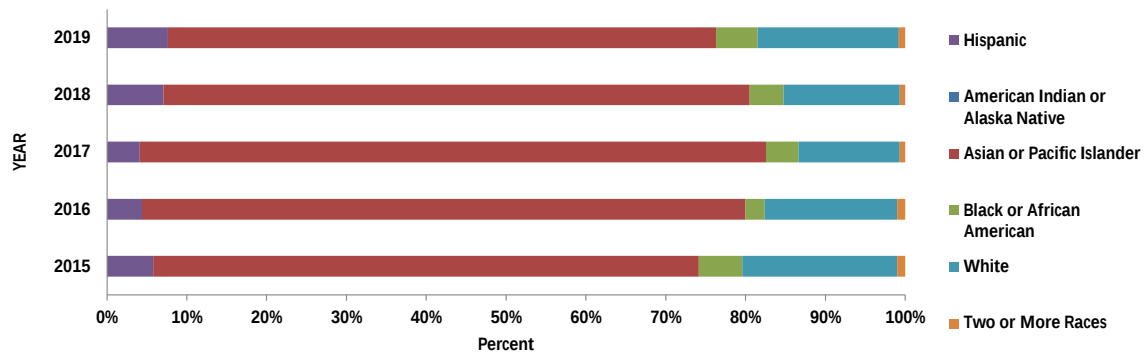

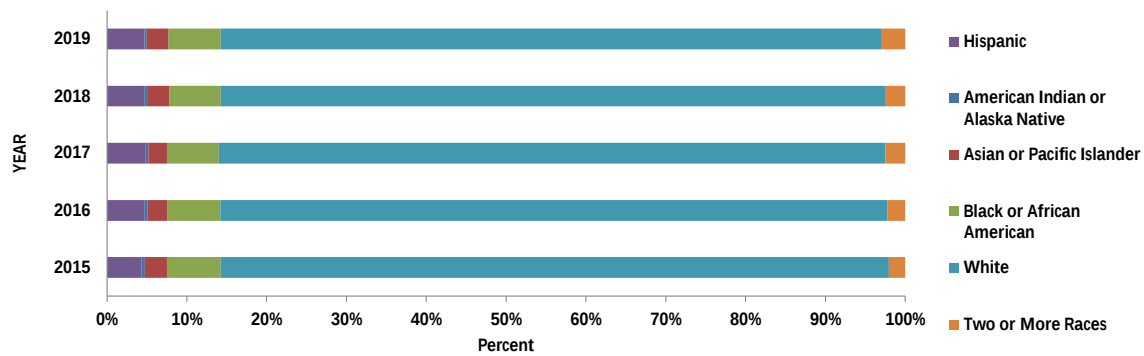

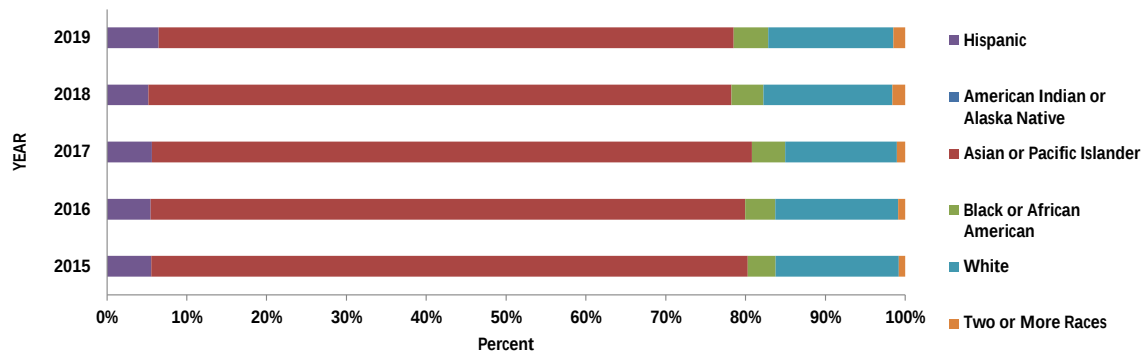

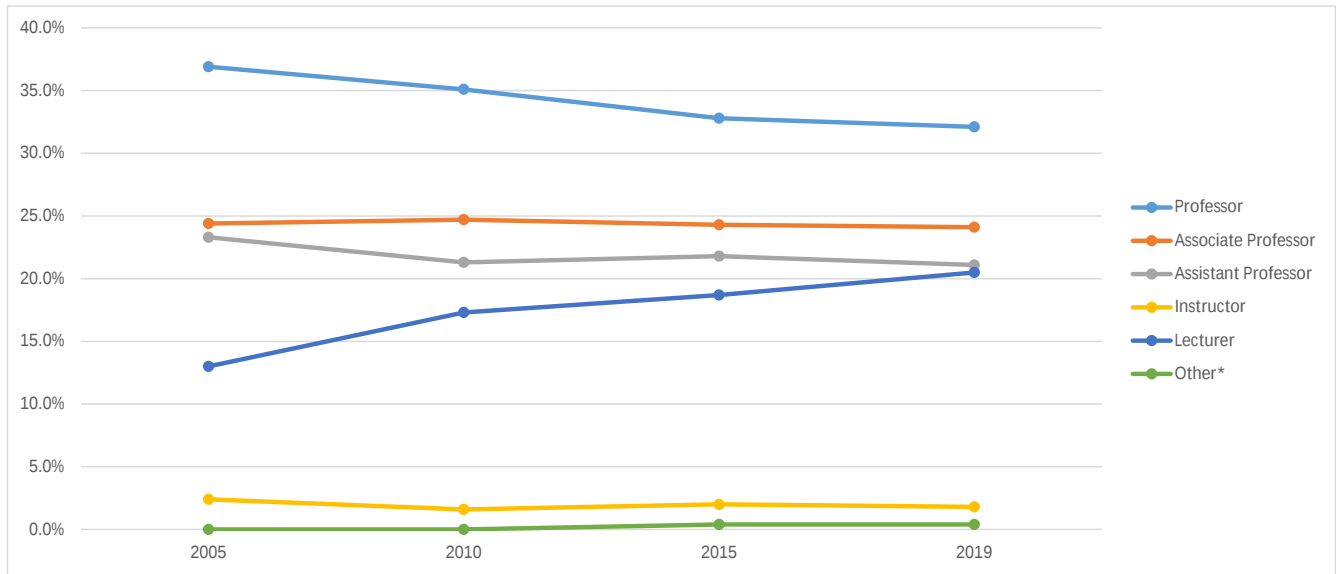

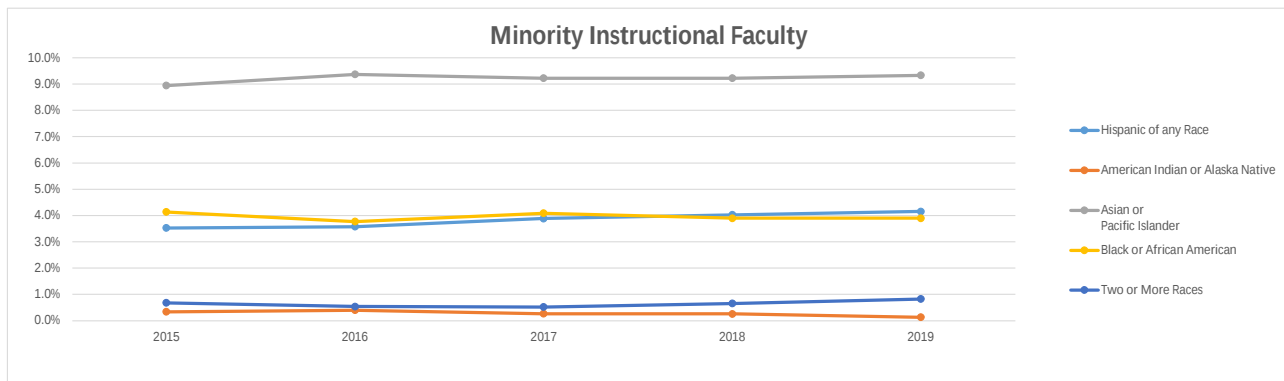

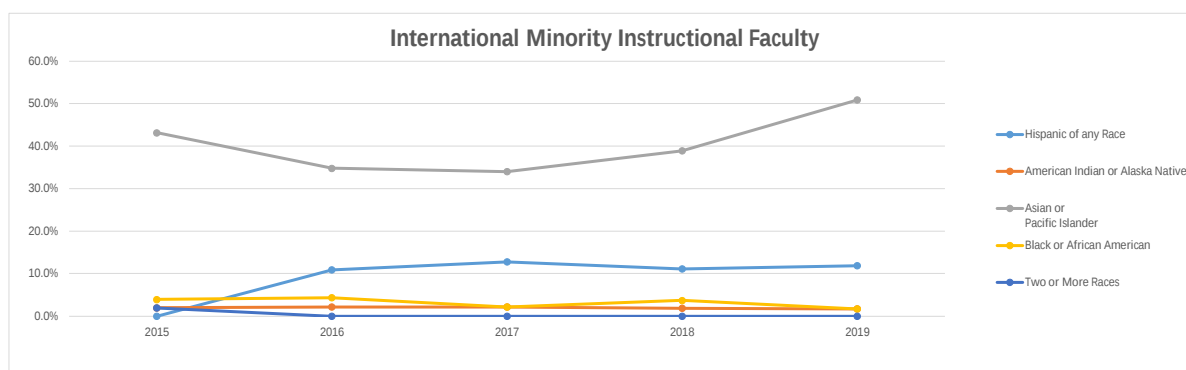

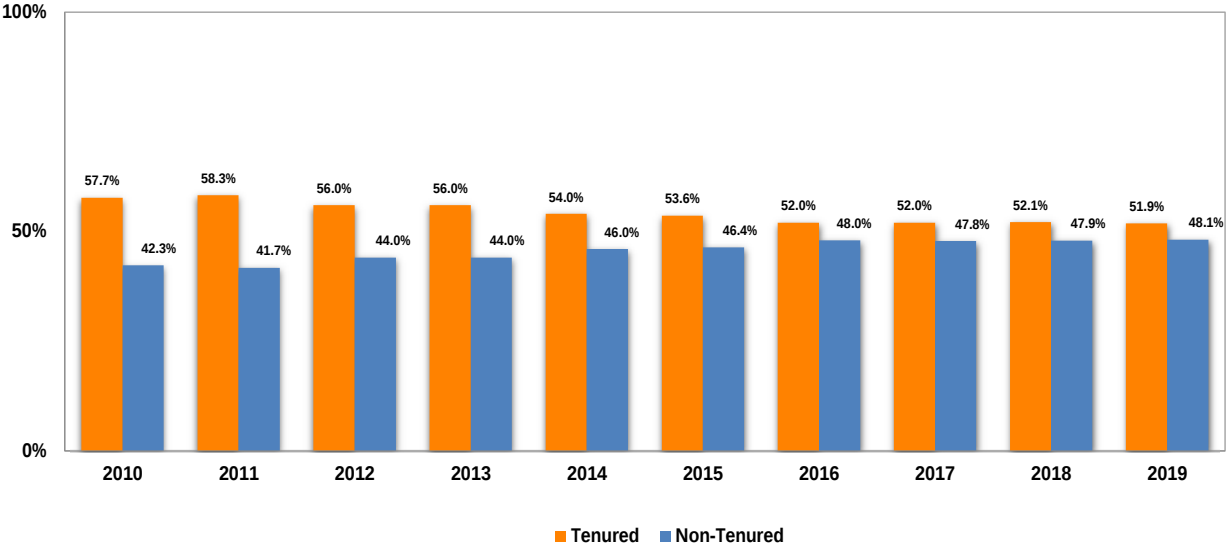

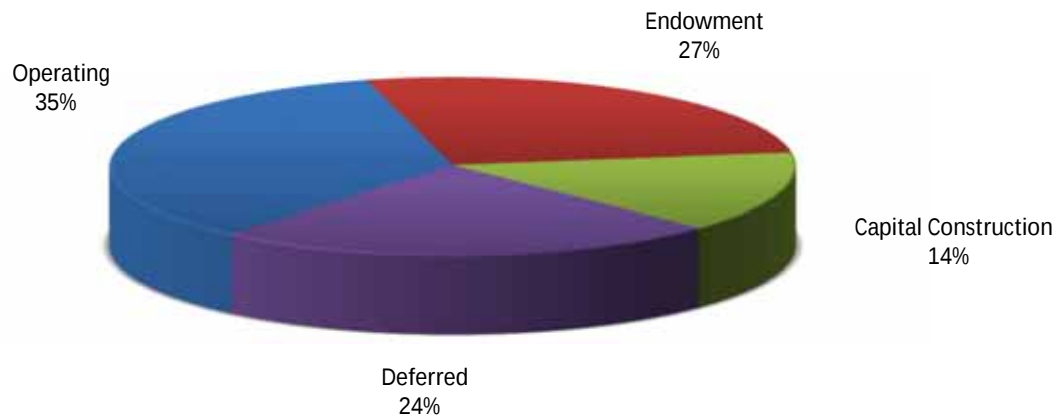


UT Knoxville Analysis by Purpose

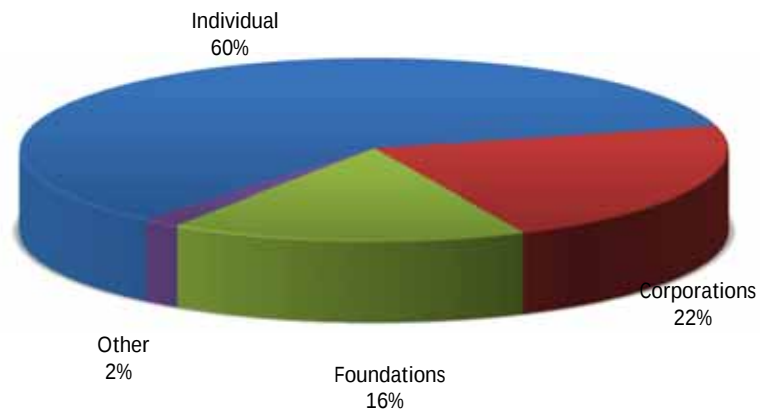


UT Knoxville Analysis By Source

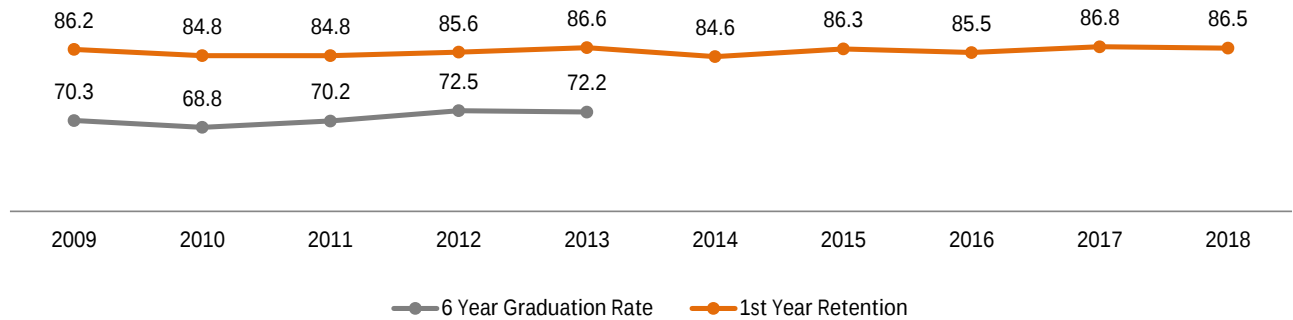

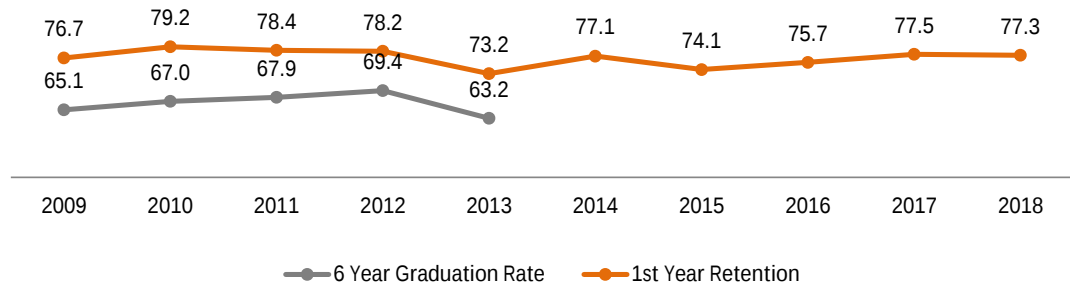

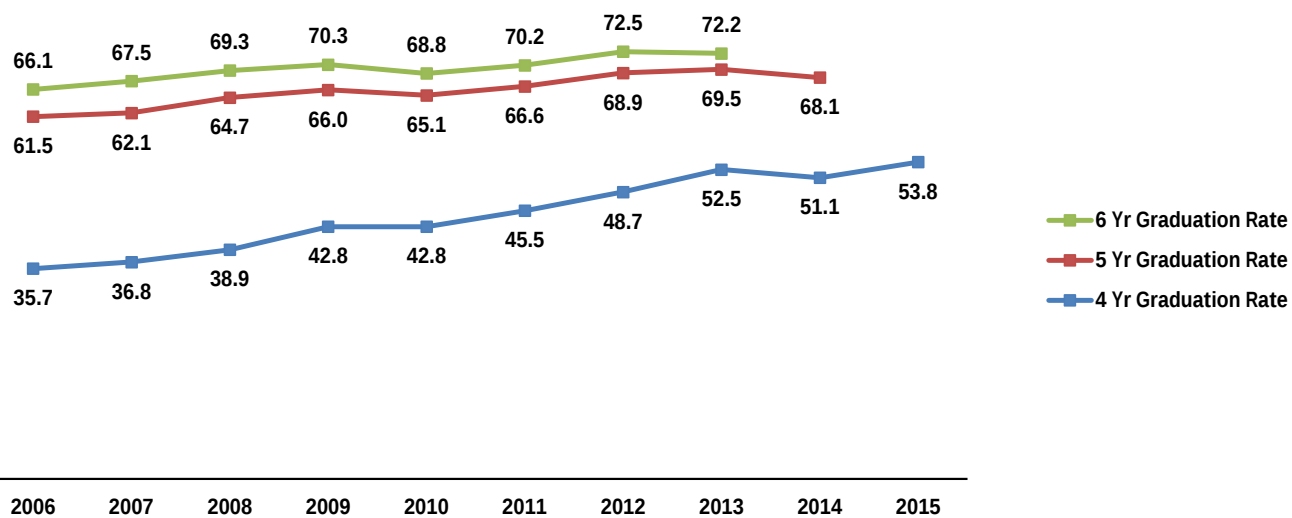

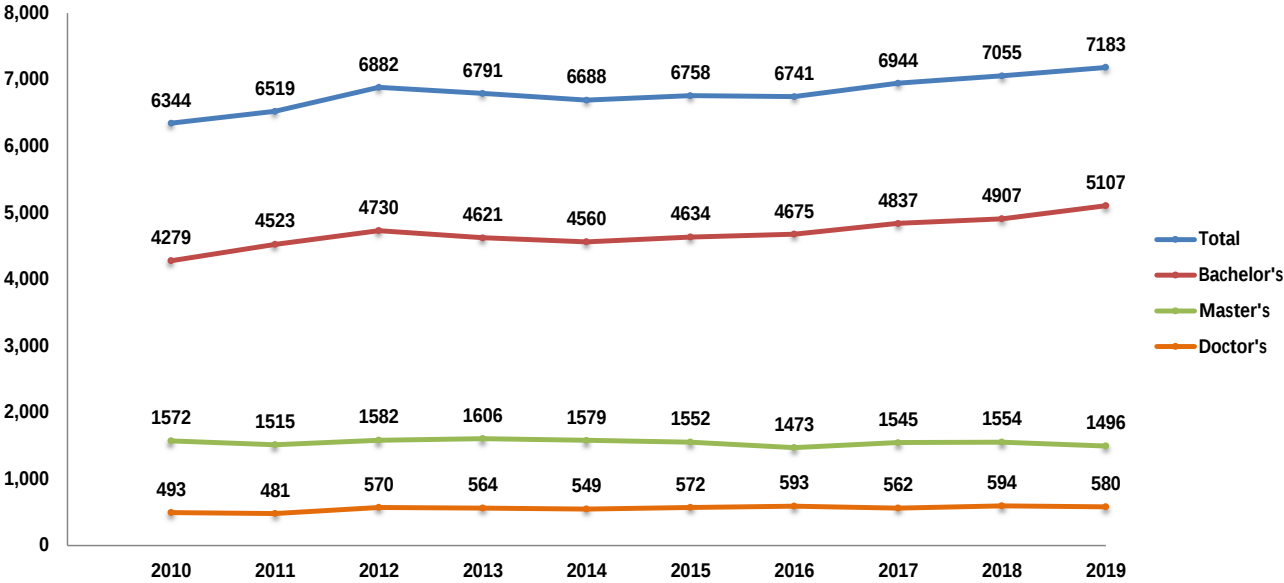

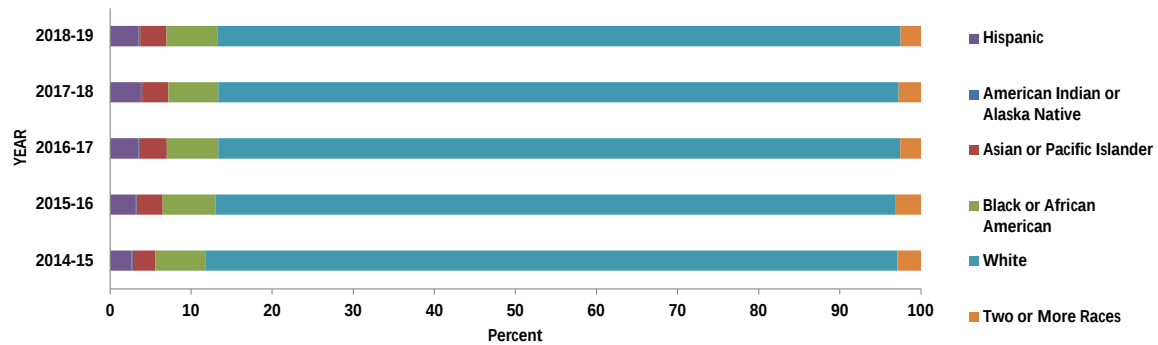

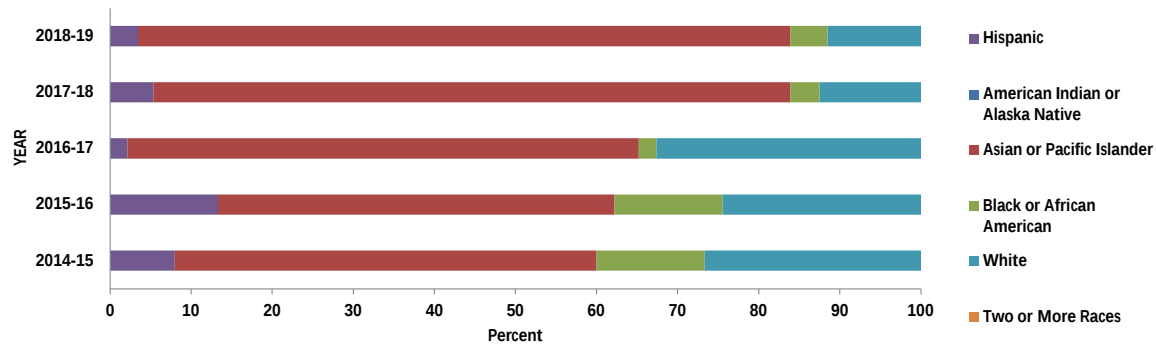
5 Year Trend of Bachelor's Degrees By Race/Ethnicity (Excludes Nonresident Aliens) Academic Year 2014-2018

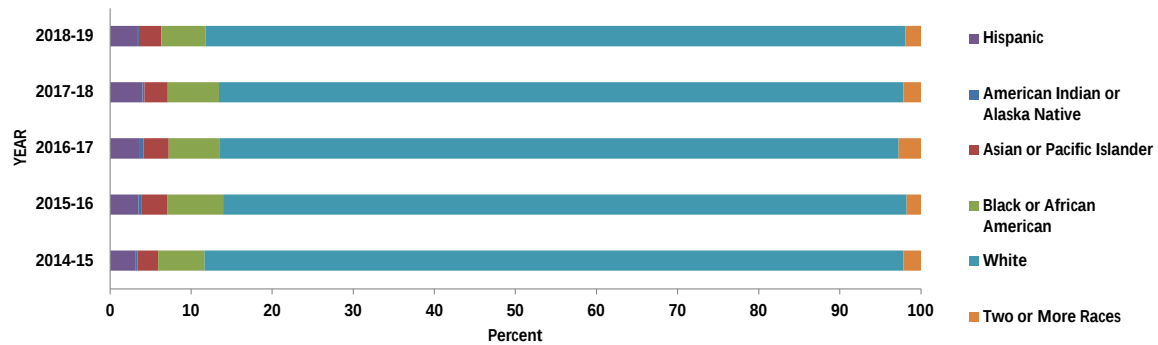
5 Year Trend of Bachelor's Degrees of Nonresident Aliens (International) By Race/Ethnicity Academic Year 2014-2018

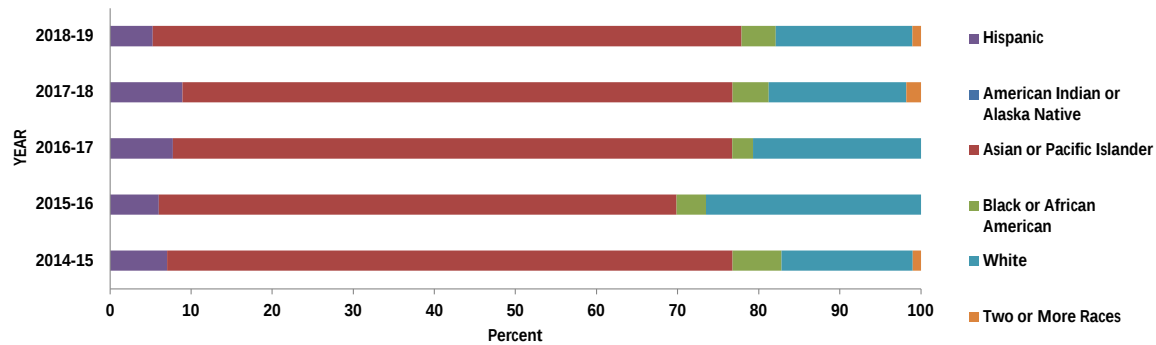

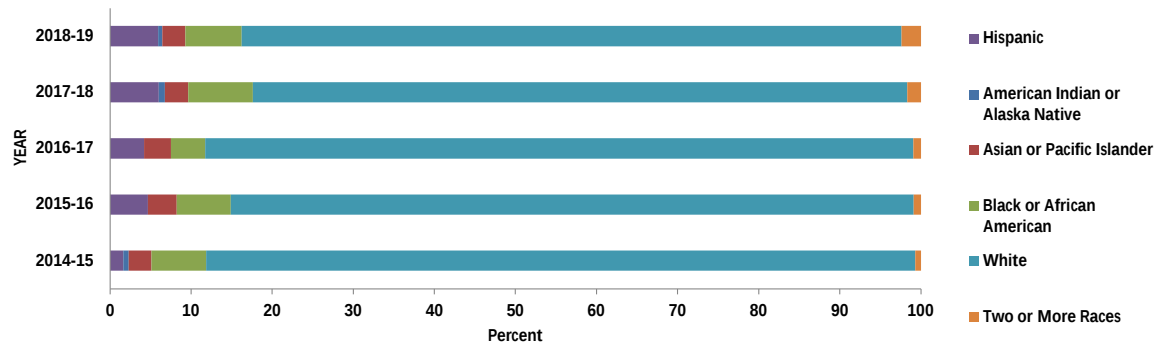
5 Year Trend of Master's Degrees of Nonresident Aliens (International) Enrollment By Race/Ethnicity Academic Year 2014-2018

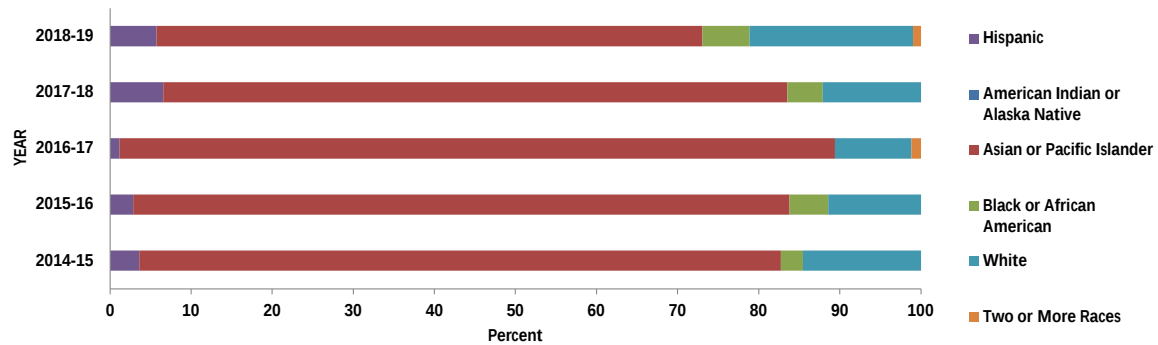
5 Year Trend of Doctor's Degrees By Race/Ethnicity (Excludes Nonresident Aliens) Academic Year 2014-2018
