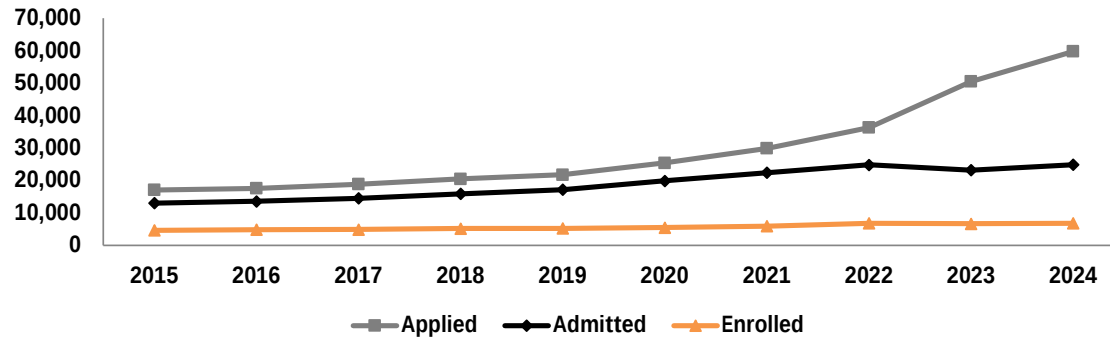

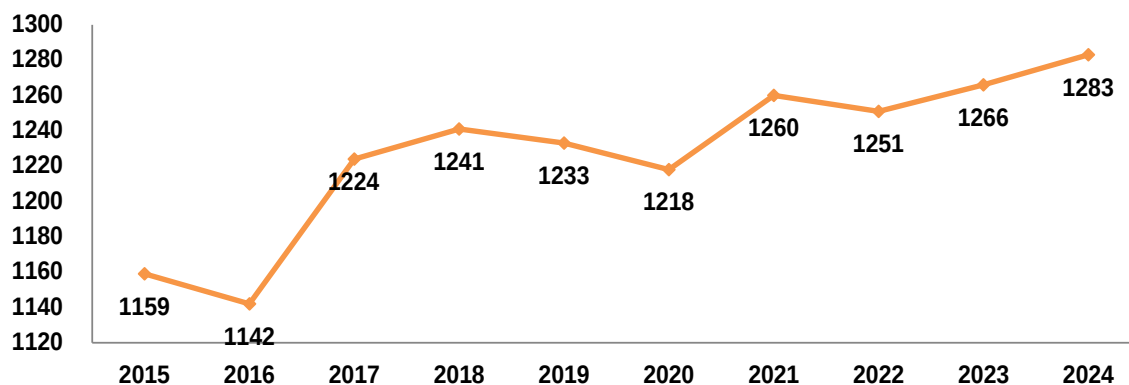

10 Year Trend of First-Time Freshmen Average SAT Scores Fall 2015-2024



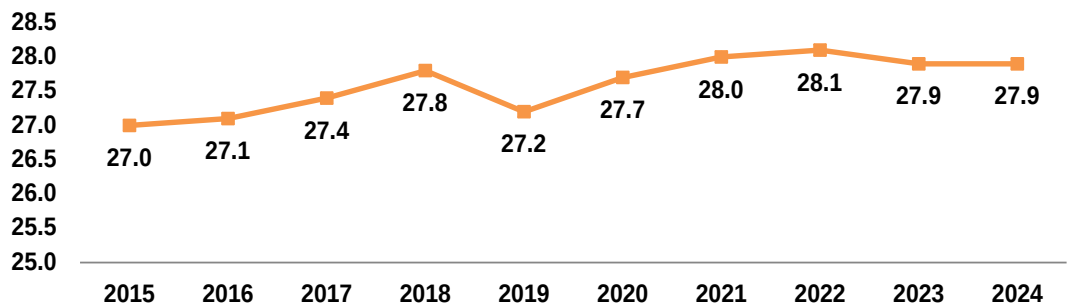

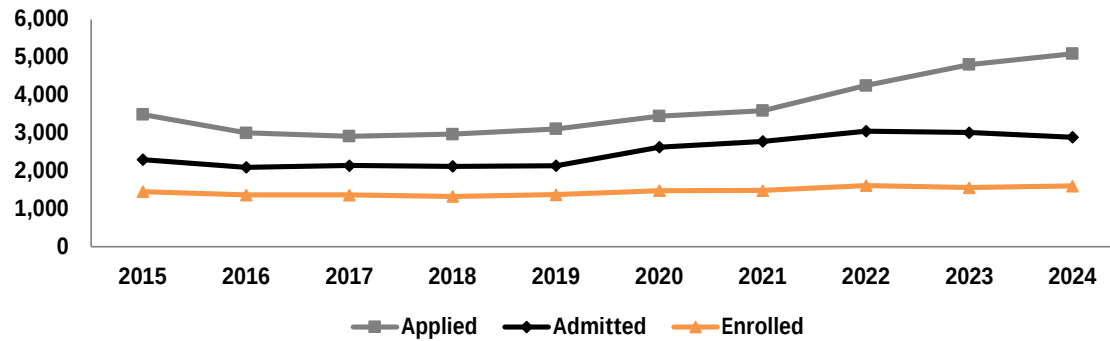

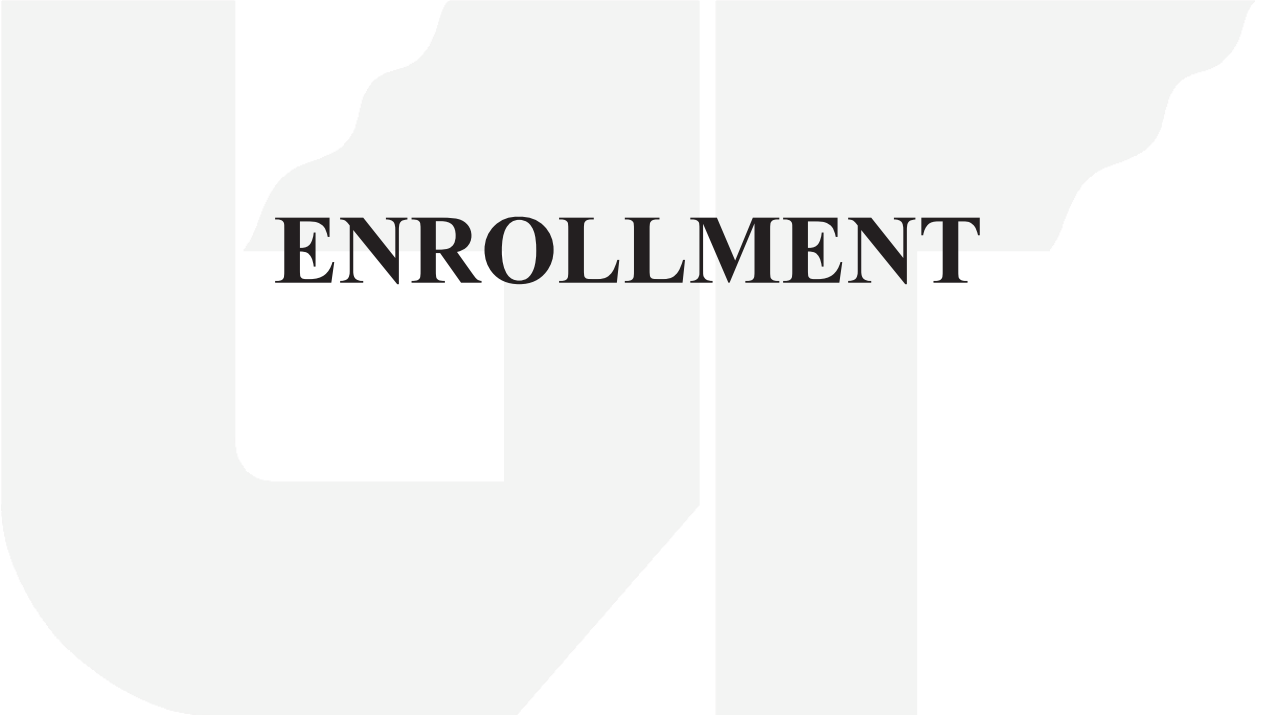

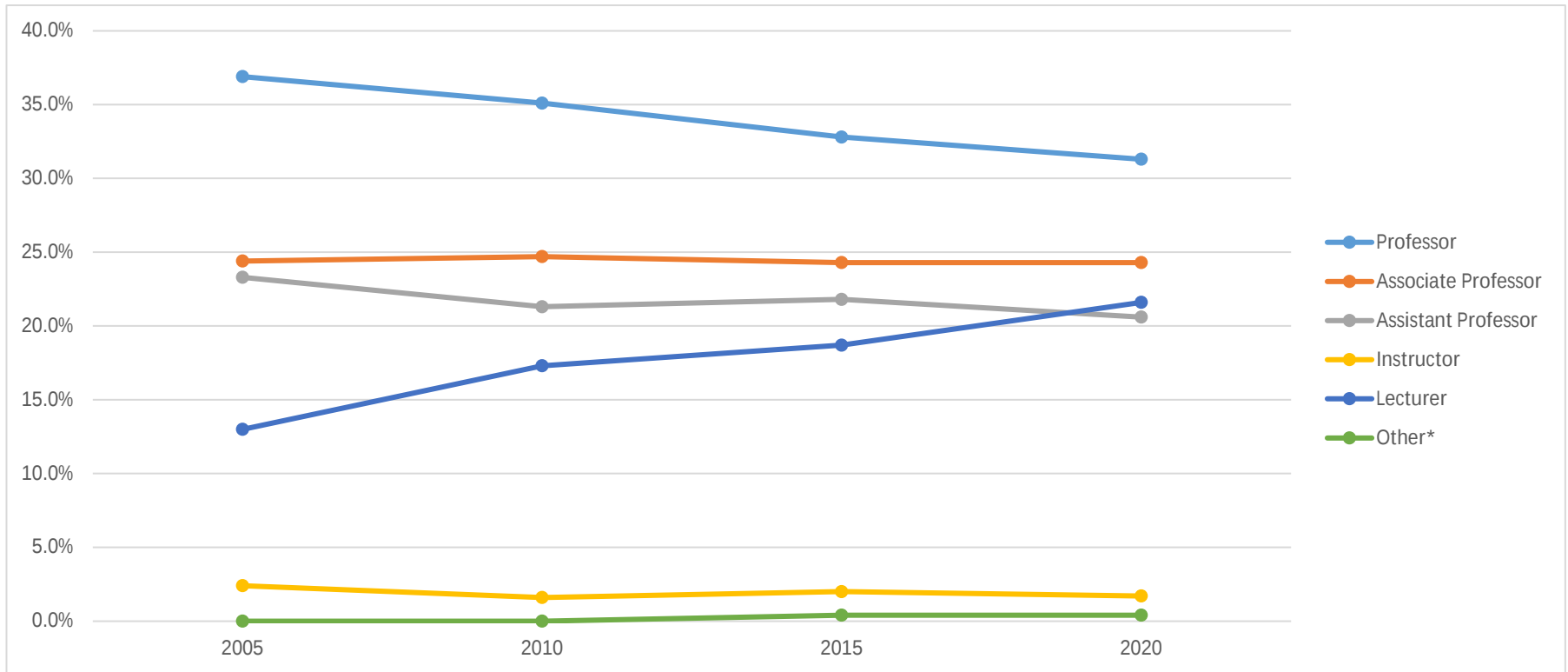

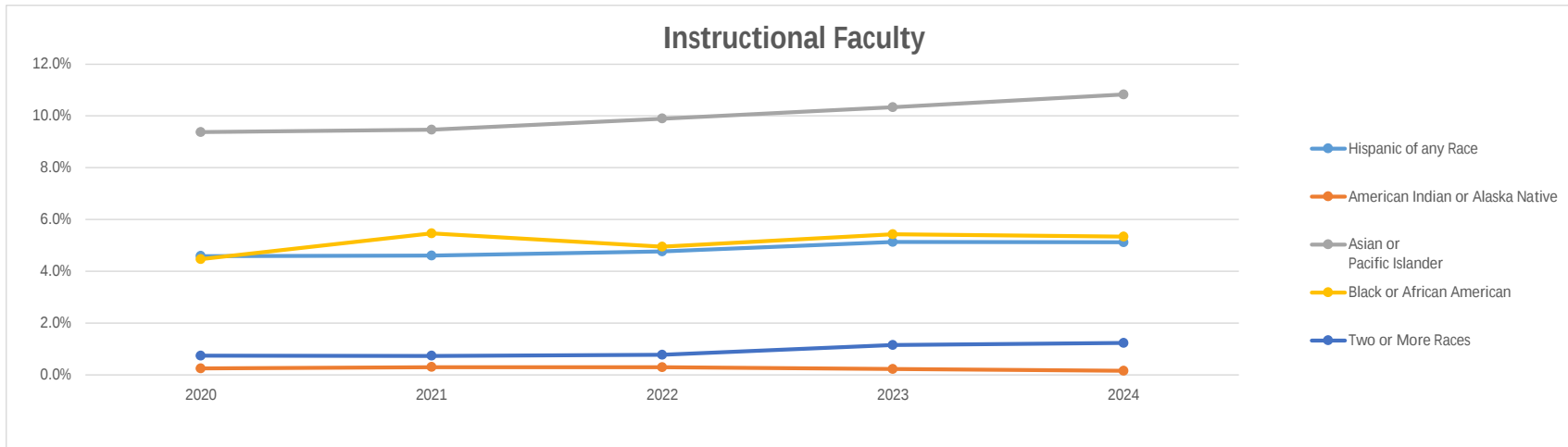

5 Year Trend of Full-time Instructional Faculty By Race/Ethnicity (Excludes International) Fall 2020-2024

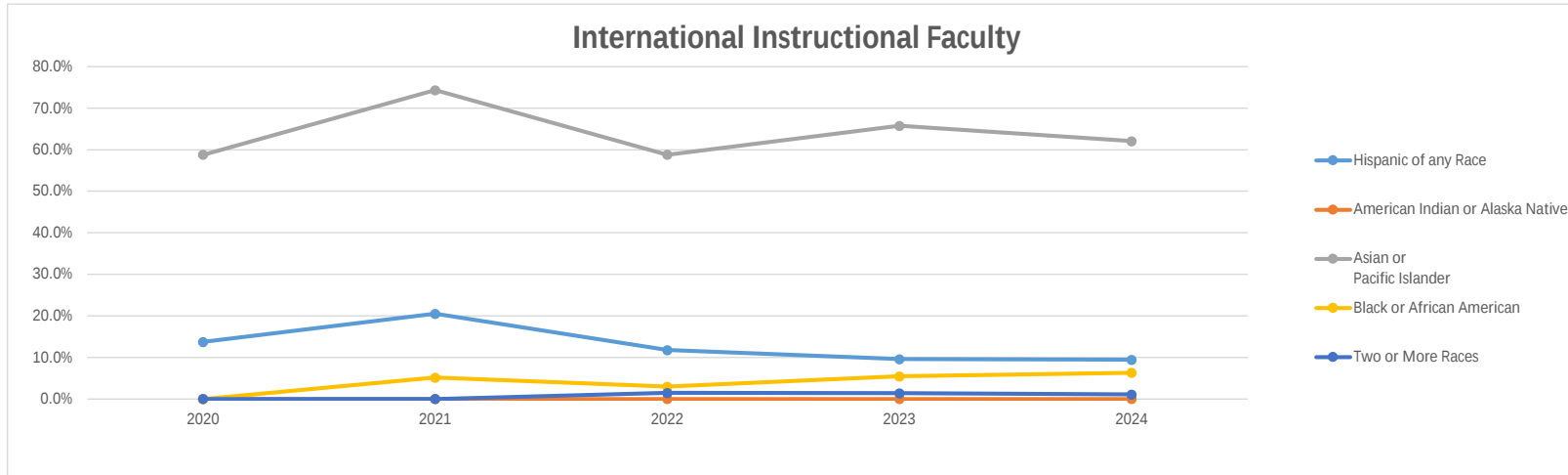

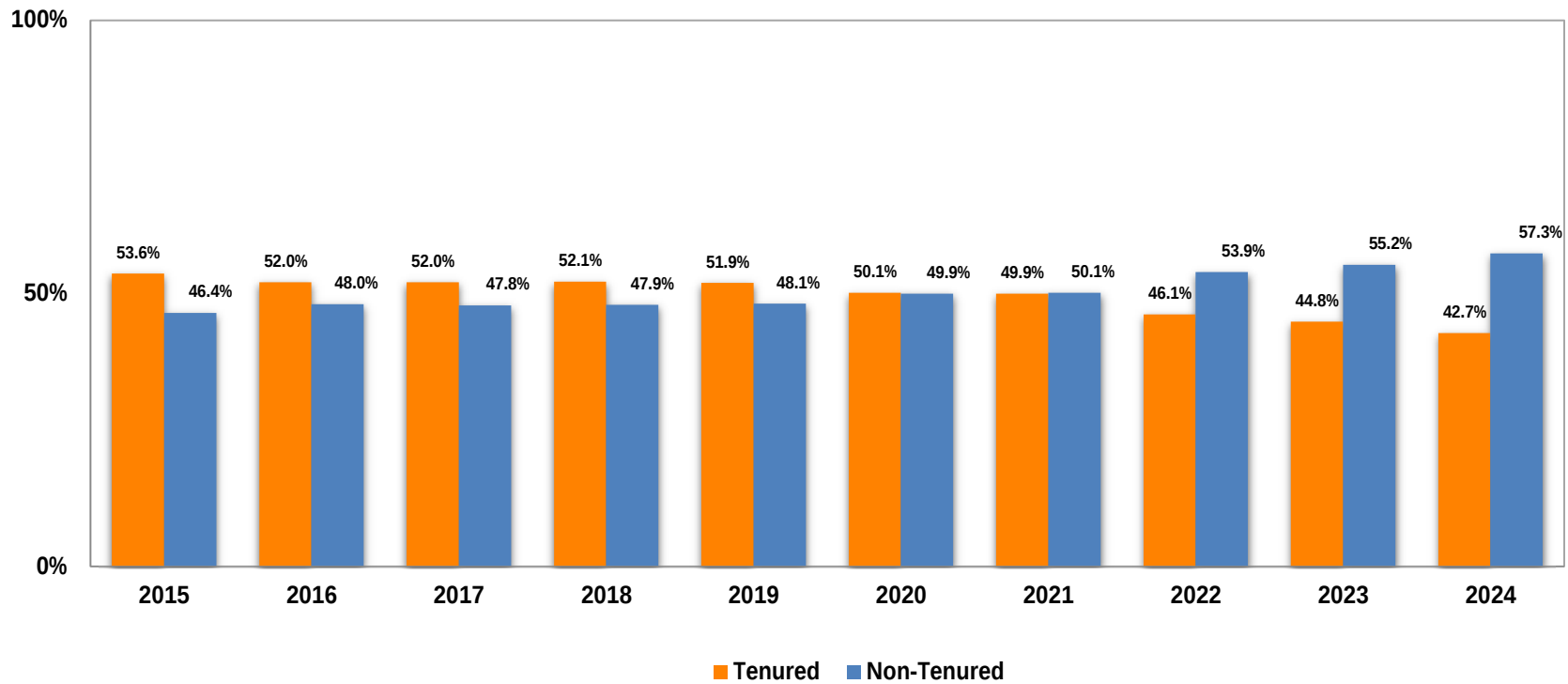

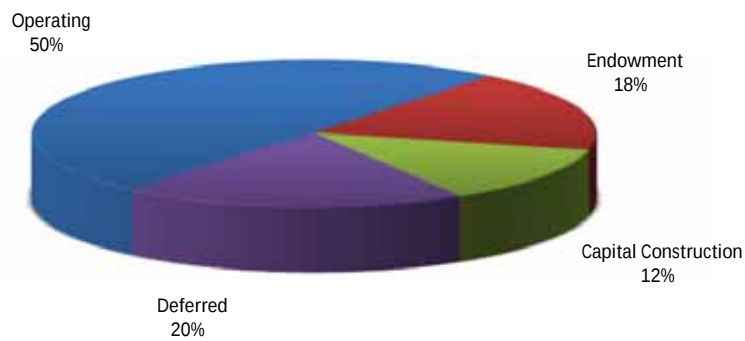


UT Knoxville Analysis by Purpose

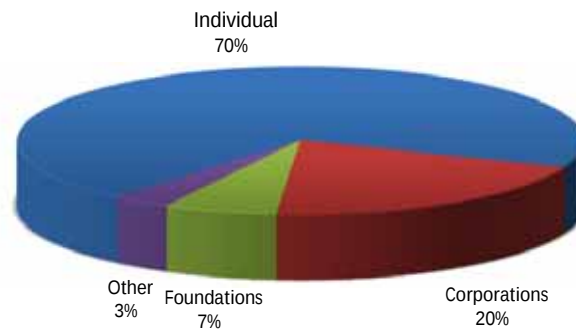


UT Knoxville Analysis By Source

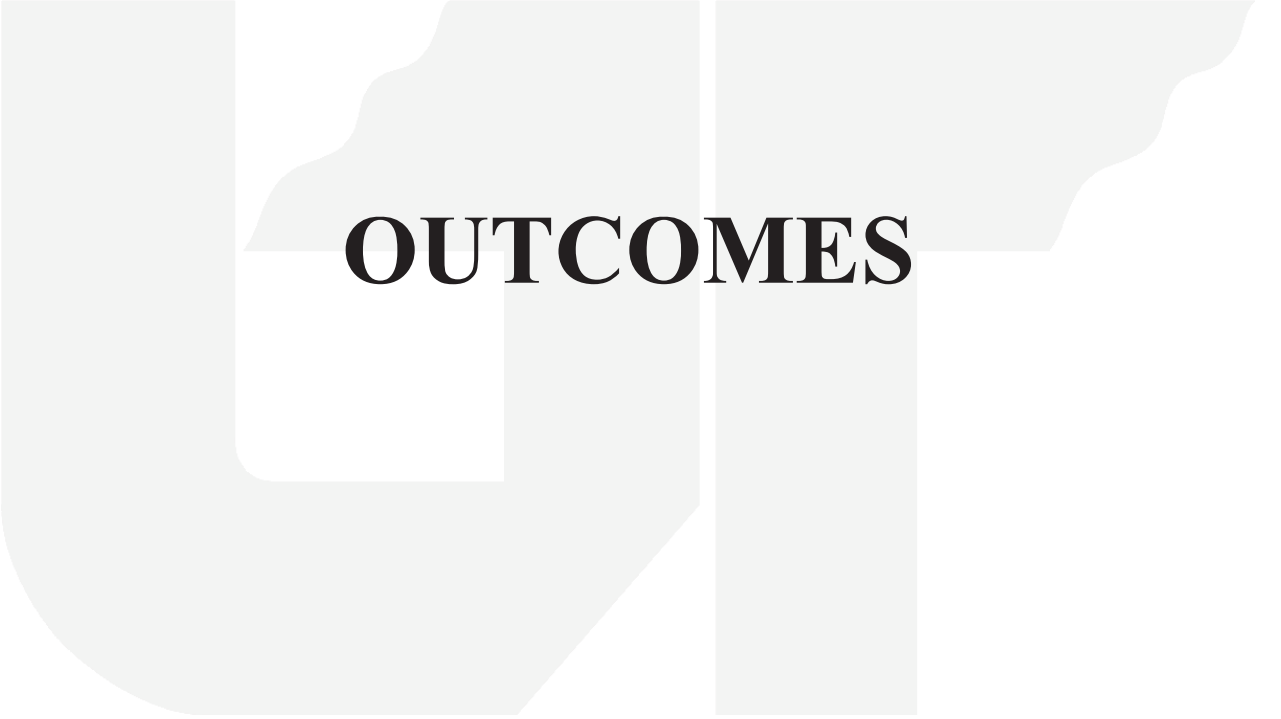

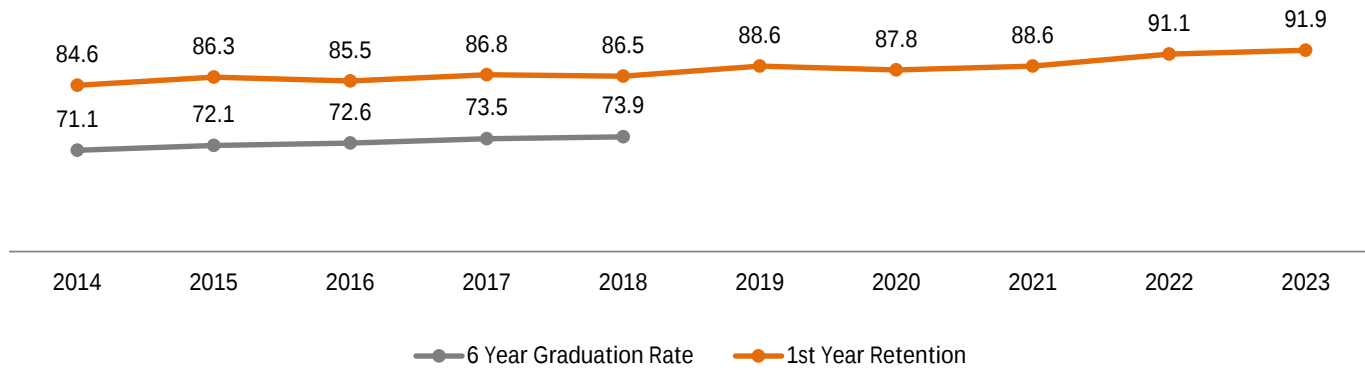

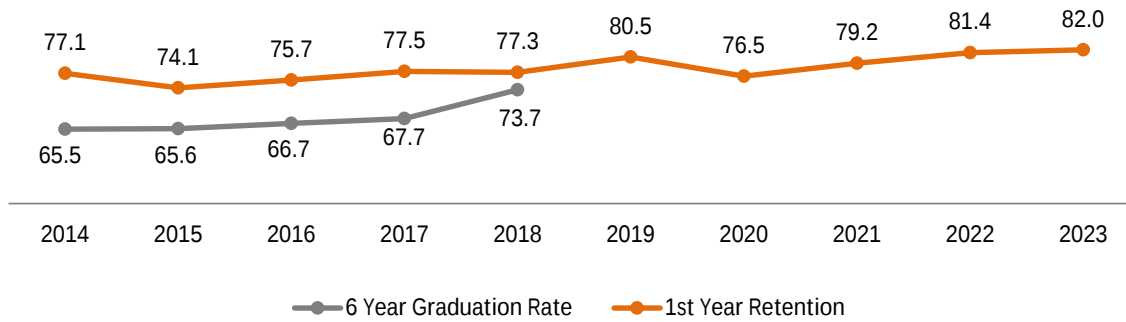
10 Year Trend of Retention and Graduation Rates First-time Full-time Freshman Fall Cohorts 2014-2023

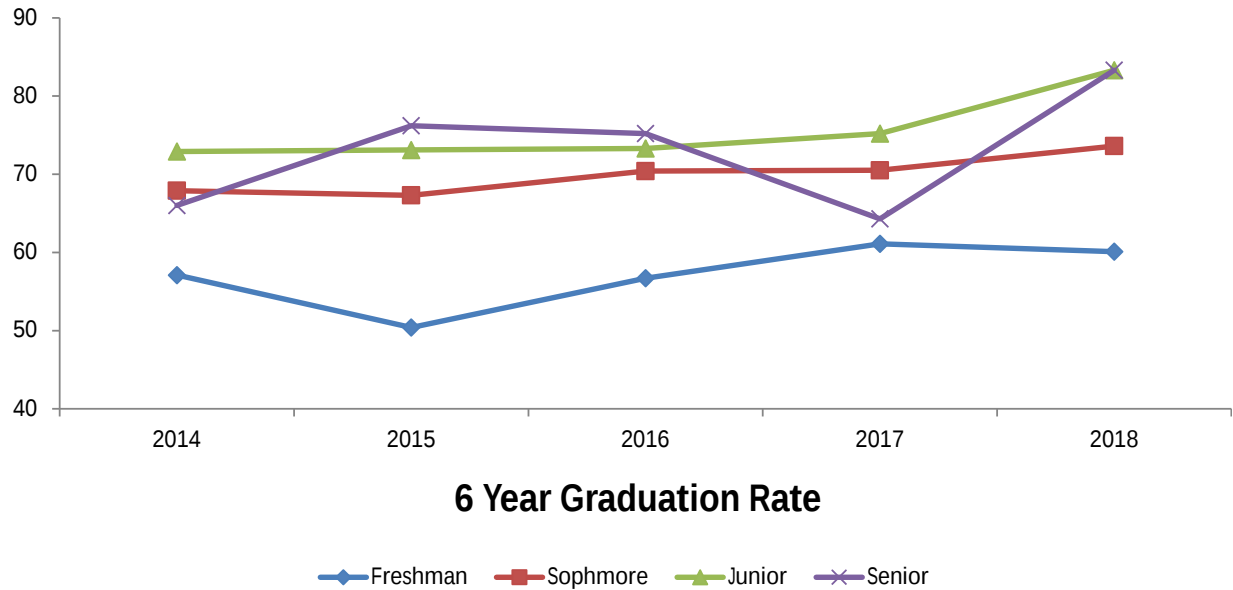

10 Year Trend of Retention and Graduation Rates **First-time Transfer Students** **Fall Cohorts 2014-2023**



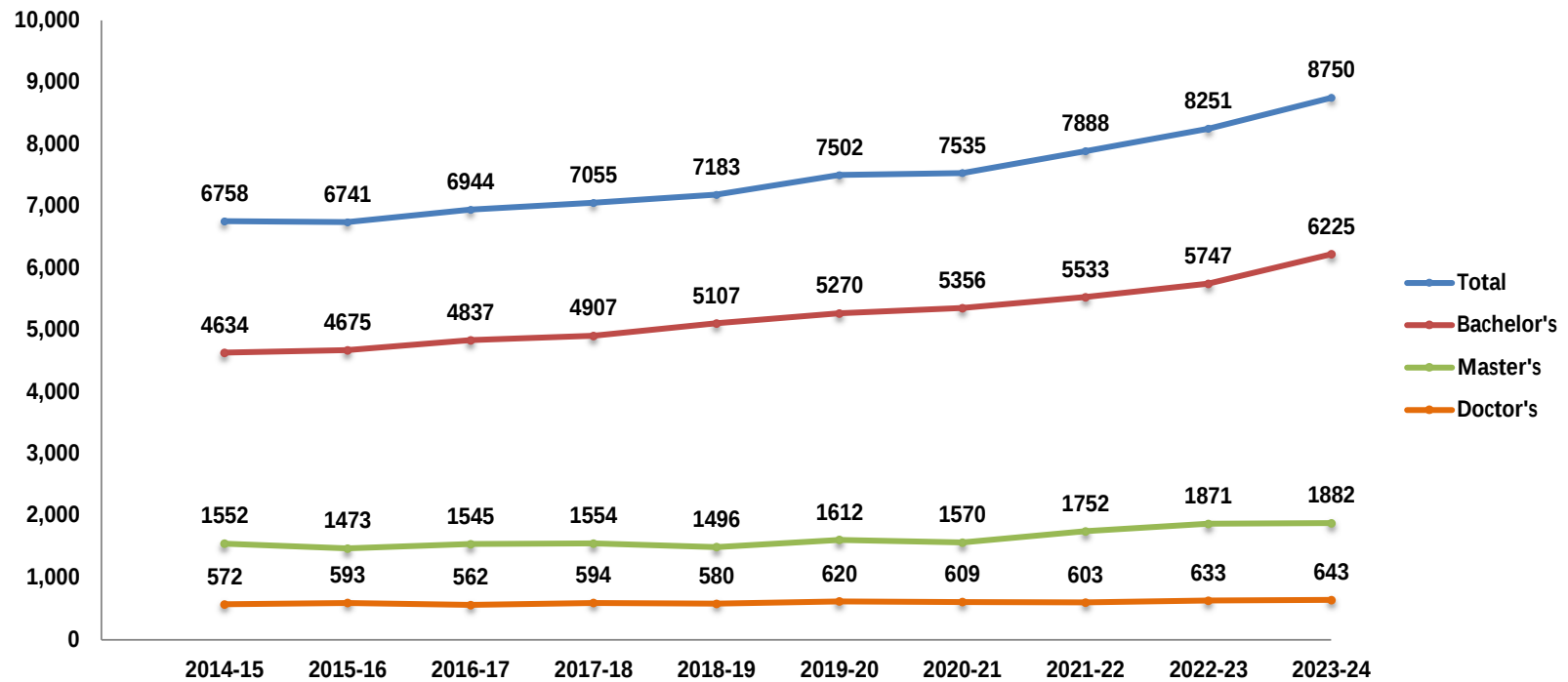
